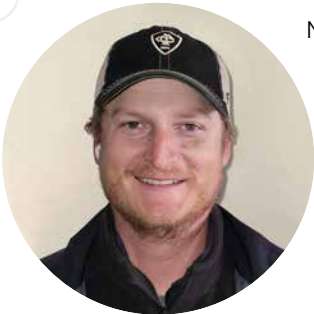
Hello Members,

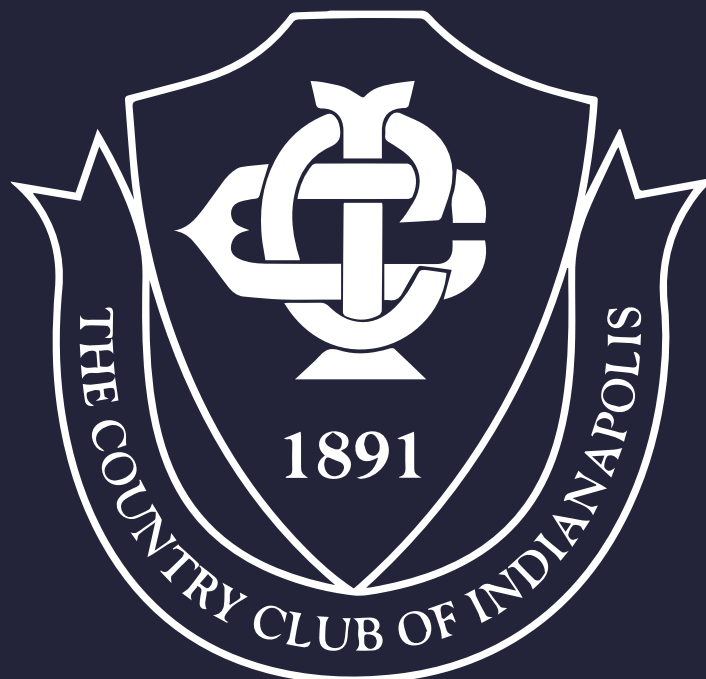

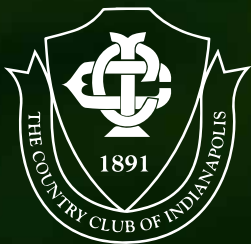
