In the UK, over 100,000 animals are left homeless each year, with financial problems being a leading cause.

We have seen a significant increase in families needing support in recent years, and without intervention, many pets face uncertain futures.

Our **Community Outreach Programme** seeks to address this crisis through targeted support and education.

## Programme objectives and expected impact.

The **Programme** aims to:

- 1. Reduce the number of pets needing rehoming by supporting owners with essential resources, education, and targeted support.
- 2. **Promote responsible pet ownership** through workshops, training, and community engagement, including partnerships with local schools.
- 3. **Alleviate financial barriers to pet care**, ensuring animals receive the food, vaccinations, and medical treatment they need.
- 4. **Promote a culture** of empathy, commitment, and care for animals in the wider community.

We expect to reduce pet abandonment rates by at least 30% in our area each year, while improving the health and well-being of hundreds of animals and their families.



## How we will use your funding

 Develop our pet food and essential items bank to support families and pets most in need.

#### 2. Expand Veterinary assistance:

 Offer targeted assistance to struggling pet owners for urgent medical treatments.

- Organise community workshops on responsible pet ownership, covering topics like health, nutrition, and pet care.
- Launch school outreach programmes to foster compassion and responsibility in future generations.

#### 4. Offer free dog training and microchipping:

- Group dog training sessions to address common behavioural issues and promote pet welfare.
- Expand our microchipping initiative.
