



Gibson County, located in the southwestern part of Indiana, boasts a rich history that reflects the broader narratives of American settlement, industry, and community development. Established in 1813, the county was named after General John Gibson, a soldier in the American Revolutionary War and the War of 1812. Its history is marked by the influence of Native American cultures, European settlers, and significant industrial growth.

The first wave of settlers arrived during the early 1800s, drawn by the promise of rich soil and economic opportunity. Many were from the eastern United States, seeking new beginnings in the frontier. The construction of roads and waterways facilitated migration and trade, allowing communities to flourish. By 1813, Gibson County was officially formed, and Princeton, the county seat, quickly became a central hub for commerce and governance.

Princeton was rapidly developing by the year 1850, with many interests which included businesses, schools, post office, court house, churches, lawyers, saloons, licensed taverns, blacksmith shop, gun and silversmith, distillery, newspapers, doctors and many more.

The county also saw the establishment of several towns, including Fort Branch and Oakland City, which developed their own identities and economic bases. These towns served as centers for trade, education, and community life, shaping the social fabric of the area.

Gibson County was also growing. King Station, south of Princeton, came into existence with the building of the Evansville & Terre Haute railroad in 1851 and 1852. Dongola, another Gibson county town of the past, was on the Patoka River near the Pike county line and was laid out in 1851 with a public square. The Wabash and Erie Canal promised to make it a real city, but it died with the canal. The village plat was laid out for Francisco in Center Township on January 6, 1851.

Throughout the 19th century, Gibson County experienced significant growth. Agriculture emerged as the dominant industry, with farmers cultivating corn, wheat, and tobacco. The arrival of the railroad in the mid-1800s further accelerated economic development, connecting the county to larger markets and enabling the transport of goods and resources.

Interests in agriculture began to develop in Indiana and especially throughout the out lying areas of Princeton and Gibson County. This interest created a demand for a county fair.

The population being mainly agricultural the general interest centered in the production of the soil. It became a friendly rivalry among the agriculturalists as to who could excel in these products.

A JOURNEY THROUGH HISTORY AND HERITAGE

The movement begins in the 1840's toward a county fair, but did not reach definite results until 1851. The credit of the first fair belongs to one man, Dr. George Graff who came to Princeton in 1843.

Mr. Graff was at all times interested in the growth and welfare of Gibson county and when he projected the idea of holding a county fair, he secured the support of the leading citizens of Princeton and the surrounding county which included such gentlemen as Rev. John McMaster, William Kurtz, John Hargrove, Dr. Wm. W. Blair, Dr. Andrew Lewis, Dr. Joseph Neeley and others whose names were closely linked with the history of the later organized fair association.

As the 20th century approached, Gibson County began to diversify its economy. The coal mining industry took hold, attracting workers and contributing to the county's growth. The discovery of natural gas in the early 1900s provided another economic boon, leading to the establishment of factories and industrial sites.

Manufacturing became increasingly important, with companies producing a variety of goods, including machinery and textiles. The industrialization of the county not only created jobs but also spurred the development of infrastructure, including schools, hospitals, and transportation networks.

The mid-20th century brought challenges and changes. The decline of the coal and manufacturing industries led to economic shifts, as many residents sought opportunities elsewhere. However, Gibson County adapted, focusing on diversification and revitalization efforts. Agriculture remained a cornerstone of the economy, with advancements in technology and sustainable practices shaping modern farming.

In recent years, the county has embraced tourism, highlighting its historical sites, parks, and natural beauty. Attractions such as the historic downtown areas, local festivals, and natural resources have drawn visitors and fostered community pride.

Today, Gibson County stands as a testament to resilience and adaptation. Its history, marked by its struggles and triumphs, continues to shape its identity. As the county moves forward, it carries with it a legacy that honors its past while embracing the opportunities of the future. From its early Native American roots to its vibrant modern community, Gibson County remains a vital part of Indiana's historical tapestry.







What Gibson County has to offer when looking for your dream home.

Gibson County has a diverse housing market. We have predominately single family homes, multi family apartment buildings, duplexes and condominiums mixed in. We have a rural community with many homes outside of the cities with acreage and pole buildings. There are some newer subdivisions in the area and some more established neighborhoods that have been here for many years. With our huge manufacturing base most neighborhoods have working class type of homes and most are very affordable. In fact, the average price of a home in the county, in 2024 was \$185,000. This is in the lower percentile price of homes in the state. The demand is high in the area with several available good paying jobs. When you mix the available jobs and the lower price range of homes, we have a very affordable area to live and work. Most homes that have been on the market have sold within 1 -2 months. The average list to sale price ratio is 98%. In 2024 there was less than a two month supply of homes available in Gibson County and 70% of the homes sold are in the \$150 to \$290,000 price range.

3 HOME SEARCH

7 INSPECTIONS AND APPRAISAL

At this time an inspector will be hired to inspect every component of the home and the appraiser will evaluate the agreed upon price of the home.

8 DUE DILIGENCE DEADLINE

The period it takes for the inspection, appraisal, lender underwriting is called the due diligence period.

9 CLOSING

Once all items are complete and everyone is satisfied a closing will take place .



LABOR FORCE




BACK TO OUR ROOTS

Gibson County, Indiana, with a population of 32,993 as of the 2022 Census, is a vibrant community deeply rooted in agriculture. The county's vast and fertile lands have made it a hub of agricultural activity, contributing significantly to the local economy and shaping the region's way of life. From expansive crop production to livestock farming, agriculture is the backbone of Gibson County, influencing its economic prosperity and enhancing the quality of life for its residents.

Economic Impact

Agriculture is a cornerstone of Gibson County's economy, with the sector generating \$220.5 million in total income in 2021. The average farm in the county covers 379 acres, reflecting both the scale and efficiency of agricultural operations in the region. The value of agricultural products sold per farm averages \$97,826, underscoring the economic importance of farming to the local economy.

Crop production is particularly significant in Gibson County, with \$176.1 million in crop receipts in 2021, ranking the county 10th in the state. The county's fertile soil supports a diverse array of crops, with 90,500 acres dedicated to corn production, yielding 17.8 million bushels, and 103,600 acres for soybeans, producing 6.4 million bushels. These figures place Gibson County 11th in the state for corn production and 6th for soybeans, highlighting the county's critical role in Indiana's agricultural landscape.

In addition to staple crops, Gibson County farmers also cultivate wheat, with 19,020 acres harvested, as well as smaller-scale production of vegetables and orchards, which further diversify the agricultural output. While vegetables cover 706 acres and orchards span 7 acres, these operations add valuable variety to the county's agricultural portfolio.

Livestock farming also plays a vital role in the county's agricultural economy, contributing \$26.4 million in 2021. Livestock, poultry, and their products account for 18.71% of the total market value of agricultural products sold. The county is home to 4,600 head of cattle,



including 1,400 beef cows and 1,400 milk cows, making dairy farming an essential component of the agricultural sector. Additionally, the county's hog population stood at 21,032 in 2017, further contributing to the diversity and strength of the agricultural economy.

Job Creation

The agricultural sector is a major source of employment in Gibson County, with 513 farms supporting a wide range of jobs both on and off the farm. The majority of these farms—84.20%—are operated by families or individuals, reflecting the deep-rooted tradition of family farming in the county. The average age of principal farm operators is 53 years, indicating a community of experienced farmers who have dedicated their lives to sustaining this vital industry.

Agriculture in Gibson County is not only about farming; it also supports a variety of related industries, including equipment suppliers, food processing, and logistics. The average market value of all machinery and equipment per farm is \$123,734, highlighting the significant investments made by local farmers in maintaining and upgrading their operations.

Quality of Life

Agriculture enhances the quality of life in Gibson County by providing fresh, locally grown food and preserving the county's rural character. The county's agricultural landscape is dominated by harvested cropland, which accounts for 84.73% of all land in farms. This extensive cropland supports a wide variety of crops, contributing to the county's food security and the health and well-being of its residents.

The agricultural sector also helps to maintain the county's open spaces and natural beauty. With 9,804 acres of woodland and 3,315 acres of pastureland, agriculture plays a key role in preserving the county's scenic landscapes and promoting biodiversity. Although only 0.58% of the cropland is irrigated, the county's farmers have adapted to natural rainfall patterns to sustain their operations effectively.





Community events like the Gibson County Fair celebrate the region's agricultural heritage, bringing residents together to enjoy the fruits of their labor and strengthening the bonds within the community. These events, along with the widespread presence of family farms, foster a strong sense of community and contribute to the overall quality of life in the county.

Sustainability and Future Growth

As agriculture in Gibson County continues to evolve, there is a growing emphasis on sustainability and innovation. Farmers are adopting new technologies and practices to enhance productivity while minimizing environmental impact. The average value of crops sold per acre for harvested cropland is \$247.75, reflecting the efficiency and profitability of modern farming practices in the county.

Looking ahead, Gibson County's agricultural sector is well-positioned for future growth. With its rich agricultural heritage, strong community support, and commitment to sustainability, the county is poised to remain a leader in Indiana's agricultural industry for generations to come.
