

Speaking to thenff.com, Coach Augustine Eguavoen expressed optimism about the team's mood and readiness for the match. "We have 22 players here, with one more to join us tomorrow. The atmosphere in Abidjan has been fantastic, and we're all excited for the first training session ahead of Thursday's game," Eguavoen said.

On Tuesday, 11 players arrived, including Captain William Ekong, AFCON 2023's Player of the Tournament Victor Osimhen, and forward Ademola Lookman. Defenders Bright Osayi-Samuel, Olaoluwa Aina, Victor Collins, and Calvin Bassey also made their way to camp, along with midfielders Alex Iwobi and Alhassan Yusuf Abdullahi, as well as Germany-based forward Victor Boniface. South Africa-based goalkeeper Stanley Nwabali arrived shortly thereafter.

Goalkeeper Maduka Okoye, midfielder Wilfred Ndidi, and forward Kelechi Iheanacho arrived, joining the eight players who were already in camp on Monday: Amas Obasogie (goalkeeper), defenders Gabriel Osho and Bruno Onyemaechi, midfielders Fisayo Dele-Bashiru, Frank Onyeka, and Raphael Onyedika, and forwards Moses Simon and Samuel Chukwueze.



## Joshua's Career Earnings Hit \$200m

nthony Joshua has surpassed the \$200m mark in career earnings, making him one of boxing's highest earners, surpassing heavyweight rival Tyson Fury and rising star Gervonta Davis, The PUNCH reports.


The former two-time heavyweight champion earned \$75m from fights in 2024 alone, placing him second only to Canelo Alvarez in yearly earnings. The Mexican champion matched Joshua's fight purse but edged him in off-field earnings by \$2m.

Fury, 36, collected \$50m in 2024, taking his career earnings to \$150m, significantly behind Joshua's impressive haul.

Meanwhile, Davis, 30, has accumulated \$50m since his professional debut, with his recent bouts against Ryan Garcia and Frank Martin contributing nearly \$20m to his wealth. Garcia himself has emerged as a payper-view star, amassing over \$40m in career earnings.

Joshua's financial ascent began notably with his Saudi Arabia rematch against Andy Ruiz Jr., where he pocketed \$65m. His subsequent battles with Oleksandr Usyk yielded over \$40m for the first two encounters.

Watford-born pugilist's earnings were further boosted by his high-profile clash with Francis Ngannou last year, which added \$50m to his account. Additional paydays include consecutive \$12m purses for fights against Jermaine Franklin and Robert Helenius, plus similar earnings from six spectacular shows at Wembley and the



Principality Stadium.

Currently nursing injuries from his recent loss to Daniel Dubois, Joshua, 35, is eyeing a potential clash with Fury. The two-time world champion is waiting for the outcome of Usyk vs. Fury 2 before making his next move.

With one fight remaining on his Ri-

yadh Season contract, His Excellency Turki Alalshikh is expected to make a lucrative offer for the all-British showdown, should it materialise.

Joshua's promoter Eddie Hearn recently confirmed the boxer will not return to action until at least May 2024, ruling out an immediate rematch with

IBF world heavyweight champion Dubois.

"We got one last chapter in this career that we need to make sure we get 100 per cent spot on," Hearn told Boxing News. "When he comes back in May or June or whenever that's going to be, you have to be physically and mentally 100 per cent ready."

The youthful Edo Queens wasted no time in getting off their mark, pressing numbers forward and forcing errors of the CBE defence.

Their efforts were duly rewarded as early as the fifth minute when the speedy Ljamilusi's brilliant run concluded with a well taken cross that found a well-positioned Essien who showed composure in bringing it down to fire her side into the lead.

CBE tried getting back into the game, but Queens' high pressing kept them at bay.

Coming back from the recess, the Nigerians extended their lead with Ljamilusi doubling the lead after good combination play between her and Esther Moses in the box for Ljamilusi to send



it into the roof of the net in the 54th minute. With the match comfortably in their control, Queens continued enjoying a lion's share of possession, with CBE hardly troubling their defence. The match was eventually put beyond reach for the Ethiopians in the 80th minute when 17-year-old substitute, Chukwuamaka Osigwe controlled a ball from Moses to unleash a left-footed strike that left the keeper with no chance. The commanding win sees Queens top Group B, with FC Masar behind them following their 1-0 win over reigning champions, Mamelodi Sundowns Ladies earlier on the day.

## Rangers Attacked By Plateau United Fans After Draw In Jos.



player of Rangers International Football Club, Daniel Onyia, was fatally injured on the head by one of the big stones throw by pebble throwing fans who laid an ambush for the team along Zaria Road, in front of Jos International Stadium as they made their way back to their hotel after a goalless draw in a match day 11, NPFL fixture.

The Toyota Coasta bus conveying the players had four of its side wind shields shattered with some other players getting hit by the large pebbles thrown by the fans who started showing their resentments as soon as the referee blew the final whistle to end the match.

As the players and official buses made to leave the stadium, there were loud bangs on the bodies of the buses as the drivers made a quick dash towards the exit gate.

On its way to where the team was lodged after making a turn at the Farringada round-about, the fans that laid an ambush in front of the stadium, pelted the players' bus with large stones with one of them catching the young midfielder on the face and beside the left eye.

The bus had to make an emergency stop at the Alherri area near St. Murumba College, Jos, where the team medical personnel administered treatment on the injured player.

Plateau State Football Association chairman, Hon. Suleiman Yahaya Kwande and other officials of the football house visited the scene to assess the situation and commiserate with the team over the attack.

In a swift response to the violent attack, the management of Rangers International F.C ably led by Barr. Amobi Ezeaku, has. submitted a strong petition to the league organisers, NPFL over the incidence demanding a compensation of Fifty Million Naira (50,000,000.00) to take care of medical expenses on the injured players and fix the damages inflicted on the team buses.

The petition sites the inability of Plateau United to provide adequate security before, during and especially, after the match for the visiting team, Rangers, as major reason for the violent incident that brought bodily harm and psychological trauma to players and officials of Rangers as well as destruction of the team bus which negates the true spirit of what the game of football preaches thereby bringing the game to disrepute.

The club called for immediate sanction to be metted out to Plateau United to serve as a deterrent to other clubs in the Nigeria Premier Football League.

In his words: "Olumide Oyedeji advice helped me hundred percent to increase my passion for the slam and dunk game. He admonished me to keep working hard and be focused in order to attain the greater height."

Advancing his club career is also a top priority for Obamakinwa who sees himself landing in the NBA in the future.

He described Phoenix Suns' power forward Kelvin Durant as his idol, due to the American's style of play and his efficacy on the court.

"My ambition o move to the United State of America to further my basketball career in the NBA is still intact which can never be swept under


