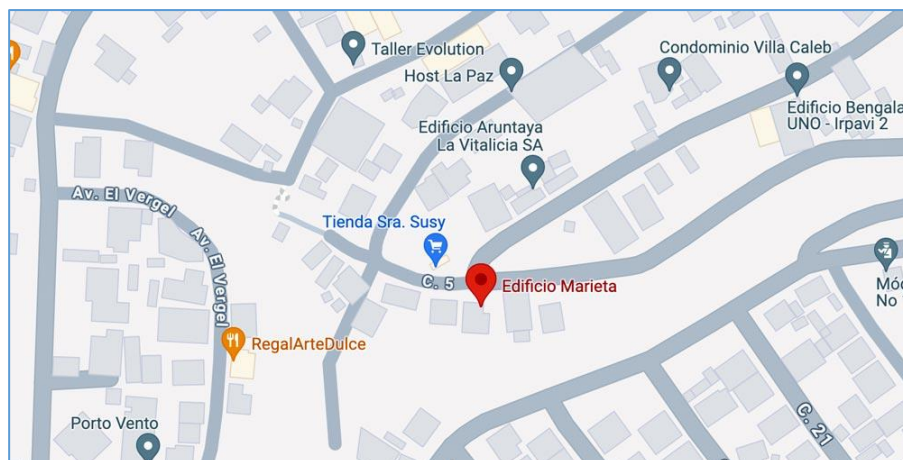


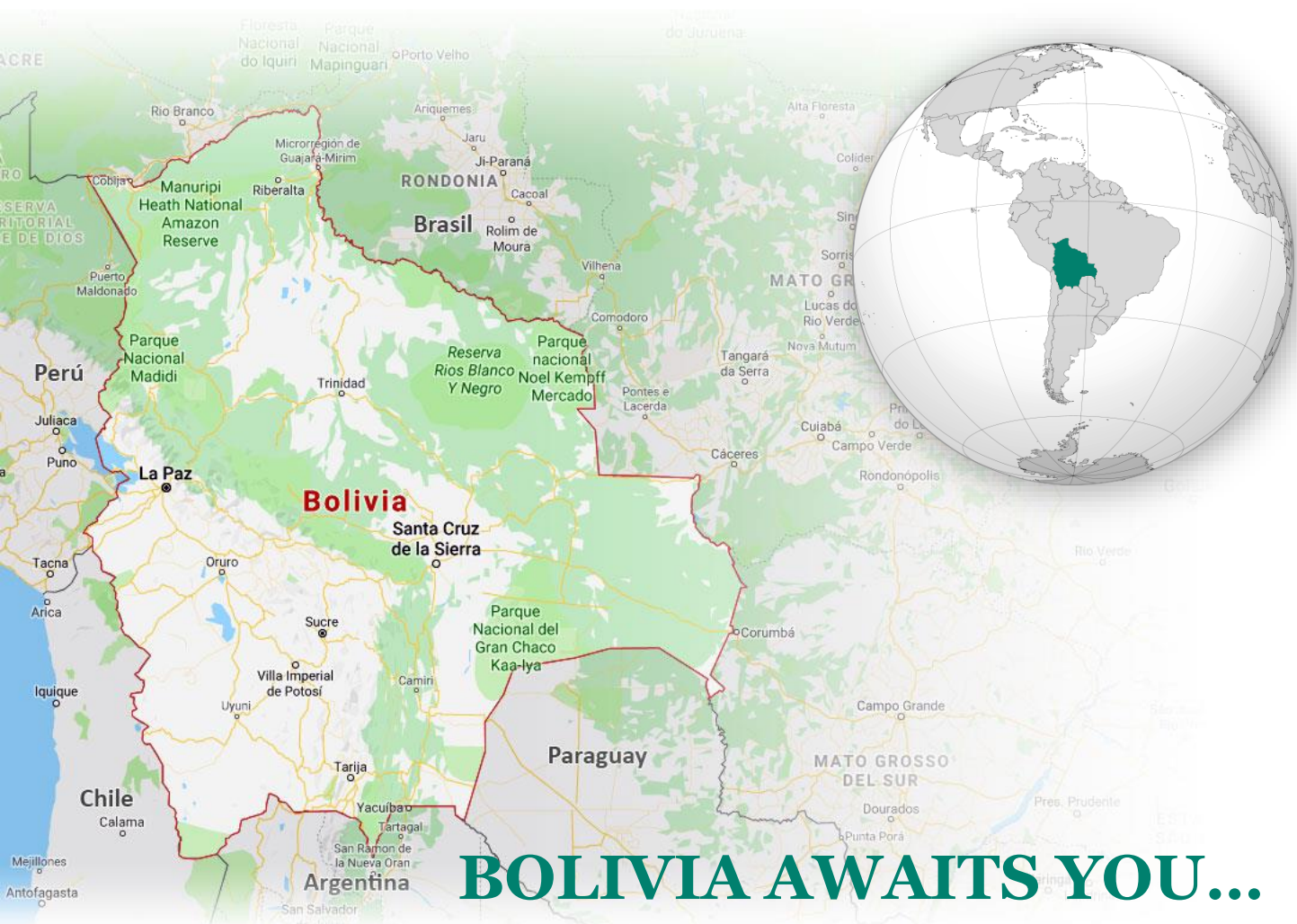

So, as our favorite part of the day slowly comes, you'll be able to witness a **majestic sunset**, that will change your perspective of the planet itself, many photographs have become internet staples, but they don't manage to show what your own eyes can see, and the sunset will prove to be that much of a bigger deal.
