

**REPETITION** 





Place important focal elements on the foreground.

Overlap elements on different planes to create layers.




Alter color intensity of elements to appear closer of farther away.





# CONTRAST





Place larger elements next to smaller elements to show dominance.

Make smaller elements less significant, or the center of attention.







## NEGATIVE SPACE

Negative space creates drama and tension and provides a visual pause between elements.



Provide breathing room around main elements to bring out local objects.

Create visual drama by having more or less negative space.





# SYMMETRY





Mirror design elements on each side of the composition to maintain balance.


Place focal objects in the middle of the composition to create symmetry.







### DIRECTIONAL CUES






The most straightforward way to direct attention towards a focal point is to draw a line or arrow to it.

Place objects in the direction you want the viewer's eyes to go.





#### REPETITION






Repeat elements using patterns, lines and colors.




Repeat elements in close proximity to one another so they appear to belong to the same group.





## PERSPECTIVE





Use lines to direct perspective, whether it's a one-point or two-point perspective.

Use lighting, colors and angles to enhance the perspective of elements.







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
