We are a tax-exempt 501(c)(3) organization providing donors with flexible, efficient, and tax-effective ways to ensure that their charitable giving achieves the greatest possible impact. 

HOW TO APPLY



STUDENTS

MCCF offers scholarships for graduating high school seniors, current college students, and home-schooled students who are seeking a post-secondary education.

PREPARE:

All scholarship applications are online using a Common Application and require the following:



Student contact information



Last four digits of your social security number in order to create your applicant ID number



Your guidance counselor's email address to request your transcript



List of employment, community service, and extracurricular activities



Digital headshot, this will be used in the event you are awarded a scholarship (no selfies)

APPLY:

Access the online application by visiting madisonccf.org



Create an account on the MCCF scholarship portal using a permanent (not school issued) email address



Complete the Universal Application. This will generate a list of scholarships for which you are eligible based on your answers



Complete any required additional supplemental materials, such as essay response, recommendation form, financial need information



Proofread your final work and submit your application online

- 1. Please be sure to read the list of scholarships on the following pages to determine your eligibility and the scholarships' requirements. Each scholarship is listed on pages 6-20 and are categorized by the following: for students graduating from a specific Madison County high school, all/any Madison County high schools, Madison County high school graduates (current or past), college students, and scholarships for home-schooled students. Scholarships are also listed on the MCCF website at https://www.madisonccf.org/scholarships.
- 2. Visit our website at https://www.madisonccf.org/scholarships to access the online application. When you go to the MCCF scholarship portal for the first time, you will be asked to create a new account using your personal email (NO school email addresses!) and a unique password. Please be sure to keep track of your log-in information. You will need it when you want to edit or submit an application.
- 3. Please read all application instructions. The MCCF Universal Application allows students to fill out a single application, saving time as they are matched to scholarships in the Fund Eligibility section of the application.

A scholarship application will only be considered when it has been completed by meeting all the requirements and submitted by the deadline on MARCH 13, 2025 by 11:59 PM.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Who is eligible to apply?

Each scholarship fund has specific eligibility criteria defined by the donor when the fund was established. Please read through the scholarships to see if you are eligible on pages 6-20 of this guidebook.

How do I apply?

Visit our website at <u>www.madisonccf.org/scholarships</u> to access the Universal Application once it becomes available online on January 13, 2025. Information regarding MCCF scholarships will be sent from your guidance office as well.

How are scholarship award amounts determined?

Scholarship grants are generated from the income earned from endowed (permanent) funds administered by MCCF and are based on a percentage of income earned. Scholarship amounts vary with a minimum of \$1,000 being awarded.

Can I apply for scholarships if I am a 21st Century Scholar?
Yes, however MCCF scholarships can only be used for tuition and required fees. In many cases, tuition and fees are completely covered by your 21st Century Scholarship.

Is it required that I share my financial information?

You must fill out all sections to submit the Universal Application, but applicants have the ability to opt out of applying for financial-need based scholarships if you do not wish to share financial information.

Can I receive more than one scholarship?

Yes. It is possible to receive more than one scholarship.

Can I use my scholarship at any school?

No. Some scholarships have specific requirements about which universities recipient must attend to be eligible. Each scholarship gives details about requirements they have regarding what schools they can be used at.

When will I be notified?

High school recipients will be notified via email in late April. Recipients will be acknowledged during Senior Award Programs at their schools.

What are my responsibilities if I receive a scholarship?

You will receive an email with instructions and information required to accept your scholarship. This will include your college student ID #, college email address, and a thank you note to the scholarship fund representative. Payment will not be sent to your school until all required information has been submitted.

If I am awarded a scholarship, how is the money dispersed? Award checks are made payable to the institution before the beginning of the fall semester. Payments will be made at the beginning of the fall semester. Unspent funds should be returned to MCCF.

What kinds of costs can my scholarship cover?

All MCCF-administered scholarships must be used for tuition and required fees, unless otherwise outlined in the scholarship description.

What if I have additional questions?

You can always check the status of your application and whether your third-party requests have been submitted by logging in to your scholarship portal. If you are a current high school student and still have questions after checking your portal, first contact your school counselor or Kari Sisk, MCCF Vice President of Programs at ksisk@madisonccf.org

MCCF Scholarship Program

Every aspect of the MCCF Scholarship Program is carefully executed to ensure the donor's charitable wishes are fulfilled, recipients are impartially selected, and timely payments are made.



Each donor establishes their own criteria at the time the fund is created. It is the job of MCCF to ensure that the donor's criteria is met by each applicant being evaluated.



Visit madisonccf.org/scholarships to access the scholarship portal. Create an account and complete the universal application to see the scholarships for which you are eligible.



Complete the supplemental requirements such as: essay, financial documentation, recommendation forms, etc.



All information must be received by the deadline to submit your application.



You will be notified via email if you've been selected as a recipient. You will be honored at your senior awards program. Payments will be sent directly to schools in July.





Alexander Character in Athletics Scholarship



Description: This scholarship recognizes athletes who demonstrate strength of character in sports, classroom, and life. For scholarship purposes, character is defined to include moral and ethical strength, integrity, dedication, perseverance, honor and leadership by example.

Qualifications: (1) Have been a Madison County Resident for 12 months prior to application. (2) Are graduating seniors who will attend a four year accredited college, junior college, or technical school. (3) Are current scholarship recipients and wish to renew.

Selection Criteria: Selection will be based on athletics, extracurricular activities, and academic excellence. *Preference will be shown for sports that receive less public recognition but which require significant physical conditioning and personal commitment. Examples would be swimming, cross-country, soccer, wrestling and track.*

Scholarship Amount: \$1,129; 1 recipient

Gladys Susan Allen Scholarship



Description: The Gladys Susan Allen Memorial Scholarship was established to encourage and assist qualified individuals in pursuing advanced educational opportunities.

Qualifications: (1) Have been a Madison County Resident for 12 months prior to application. (2) Graduating seniors from Elwood Community High School. (3) Will pursue a major in nursing or mathematics. (4) Are current scholarship recipients and wish to renew

Selection Criteria: Selection will be based on academic excellence as well as community service.

Scholarship Amount: \$2,316; 1 recipient

Alternatives Inc., Mary Jo Lee Scholarship



Description: The Mary Jo Lee Alternatives Inc. Scholarship honors Mary Jo Lee who served as Chief Executive Officer of Alternatives Incorporated for over two decades and devoted her life to serving domestic and sexual violence victims. Mary Jo paved the way for victims' access to services and bringing communities together to raise awareness of domestic violence. The scholarship is intended to provide support for anyone impacted by domestic and/or sexual violence as they further their education.

Qualifications: (1) Must be a resident of Hamilton, Hancock, Henry, Madison, or Tipton County. (2) Have been impacted by domestic and/or sexual violence. (3) Plan to pursue or currently pursuing any type of post-secondary education credential.

Selection Criteria: Recipient selection will be based on an essay response as well as preference for domestic violence or sexual violence impact.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000 minimum; multiple recipients

Anderson XI Chapter of Kappa Kappa Scholarship




Description: This scholarship was established to support graduating students who highlight general excellence, but with a focus on academic performance as well as responsibility and a commitment to community service and volunteerism.

Qualifications: Have been a Madison County Resident for 12 months prior to application. (1) Are graduating seniors from one of the following high schools: Anderson High School, Liberty Christian School, Lapel High School, Frankton High School, Indiana Christian Academy, Anderson Preparatory Academy, or those who have been home schooled. (2) Have a cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher. (3) Intend to pursue a degree from an accredited Indiana institution. (4) Are current scholarship recipients and wish to renew.

Selection Criteria: Recipient selection will be based on community service, academic excellence, and financial need.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,500; 2 recipients

Alice Baldwin Memorial Nursing Scholarship



Qualifications: (1) Have been a Madison County Resident for 12 months prior to application. (2) Graduating from a Madison County high school. (3) Must be female (4) Plan to enroll in nursing education classes or programs.

Selection Criteria: Selection will be based on academic excellence as well as an essay response.

Scholarship Amount: \$4,317; 1 recipient

Ed Bollman Scholarship



Description: The Ed Bollman Scholarship was established by his wife, Belinda and son, Hunter, to provide educational support to a graduating student from Lapel High School. Ed had a 15-year career as an Indiana Conservation Officer and was an avid outdoorsman.

Qualifications: (1) Have been a Madison County Resident for 12 months prior to application. (2) Are graduating seniors from Lapel High School and/or a Madison County High School. (3) Have maintained a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher. (4) Plan to pursue any type of post-secondary education credential.

Selection Criteria: Selection will be based on and essay response as well as extracurricular activities.

Scholarship Amount: \$4,000; \$1,000/year for 4 years, 2 recipients



Qualifications: (1) Have been a Madison County Resident for 12 months prior to application. (2) Are graduating from a Madison County High School. (3) Have maintained a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA. (4) Intend to pursue a baccalaureate degree in Engineering at an accredited college or university. (5) Are current scholarship recipients and wish to renew.

Selection Criteria: Selection will be based on an essay response, financial need, and community service. **Scholarship Amount:** \$1,515; 1 recipient

Earle Selkirk & Olevia Bourke Cascadden Scholarship



Description: The Earle Selkirk and Olevia Bourke Cascadden Scholarship was established to provide educational support to graduating students from Lapel High School. This scholarship is payable over 4 years.

Qualifications: (1) Have been a Madison County Resident for 12 months prior to application. (2) Are graduating from Lapel High School. (3) Have maintained a minimum cumulative 3.5 GPA. (4) Intend to pursue a post-secondary education credential at an accredited college or university.

Selection Criteria: Selection will be based on an essay response, financial need, and community service.

Scholarship Amount: \$25,000 paid equally over 4 years; 2 recipients

George A. and Valena Cunningham Memorial Scholarship



Description: The George A. and Valena Cunningham Memorial Scholarship was established by their son, Randy, to provide educational support to graduating students from Frankton High School. The Cunningham's were very active in the Frankton community and the Frankton school system.

Qualifications: (1) Have been a Madison County Resident for 12 months prior to application. (2) Are graduating seniors from Frankton High School. (3) Have maintained a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. (4) Plan to pursue a two or four year post-secondary education credential.

Selection Criteria: Selection will be based on community service, an essay response and financial need. **Scholarship Amount:** \$1,000; 1 recipient

Dickmann Youth Community Service Award



Description: The Charles H. and Hazel Dickmann Youth Community Service Award honors Seniors from Madison County schools who have exhibited outstanding contributions of time, talent, and energy to charitable community endeavors. The Dickmann's have provided funds for not just the student who receives the Award, but an equal amount will be granted to the nonprofit organization of the student's choice.

Qualifications: (1) Have been a Madison County Resident for 12 months prior to application. (2) Are graduating seniors attending a Madison County High School. (3) Have participated in community service work. (4) Plan to pursue a two or four year post-secondary education credential.

Selection Criteria: Selection will be based on an essay response as well as community impact.

Scholarship Amount: \$4,000; 1 recipient/\$1,000 to non-profit of recipients choice

Georgia F. Edgell Scholarship



Description: Mrs. Georgia F. Edgell was a long time secretary at Alexandria-Monroe high school who established a fund at the Madison County Community Foundation to assist Alexandria-Monroe graduates in their pursuit of higher education.

Qualifications: (1) Have been a Madison County Resident for 12 months prior to application. (2) Are graduating students from Alexandria-Monroe High School.

Selection Criteria: Selection will be based on academic excellence, involvement in extracurricular activities, and an essay response.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,268; 1 recipient

Elwood Alumni Association Scholarship



Description: The Elwood Community High School Alumni Association Scholarship supports graduating Elwood High School students who show financial need as well as involvement within the Elwood community.

Oualifications: (1) Have been a Madison County Resident for 12 months prior to application. (2) Are graduating students from Elwood Community High School. (3) Have maintained a cumulative range of 2.67 to 3.5 GPA. (4) Plan to pursue any type of post-secondary education credential.

Selection Criteria: Selection will be based on character, financial aid, and an essay response.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000; 1 recipient

Bill & Gloria Gaither Arts Scholarship

Description: This scholarship recognizes Alexandria-Monroe High School students seeking further education in the arts, in all its forms, and who demonstrate excellence in their style of art in the classroom and community. Preference will be shown for students that have performed well in the classroom and who have also maintained a high level of community involvement.

Qualifications: (1) Have been a Madison County Resident for 12 months prior to application. (2) Are graduating students from Alexandria-Monroe High School. (3) Have maintained a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. (4) Plan to attend a 4-year college or university with the goal of a major or minor in the Arts Field.

Selection Criteria: Selection will be based on community service and academic excellence.

Scholarship Amount: \$2,500; 1 recipient

Ralph and Lova Garriott Scholarship

Description: Lova Garriott established the Garriott Scholarship Fund with the Madison County Community Foundation in 1997 as part of the estate plan for herself and her late husband, Ralph. The Garriotts were long time Anderson residents who cherished the arts, literacy, travel, and the edification of children. Mrs. Garriott, noted for her refined, articulate demeanor, asked that the Garriott Scholarship be awarded to Madison County students who, while accomplished, might not be considered "shining stars."

Qualifications: (1) Have been a Madison County Resident for 12 months prior to application. (2) Are graduating students from Madison County. (3) Plan to pursue a 4 year baccalaureate degree at an accredited college or university. OR (4) Are current recipients wishing to renew.

Selection Criteria: Selection will be based on an essay response and a recommendation form.

Scholarship Amount: \$2,000 minimum; multiple recipients

Stephen Hamer Memorial Scholarship

Description: Stephen Hamer was an 18 year-old young man who lived his life as a community volunteer and servant leader. At the end of Stephen's three-year battle with cancer, the Stephen Hamer Memorial Fund was established to assist and encourage Madison County seniors who have also endured hardships while remaining faithful to servant leadership.


Qualifications: (1) Have been a Madison County Resident for 12 months prior to application. (2) Are graduating students from Madison County. (3) Plan to pursue or currently pursuing any type of postsecondary education credential. OR (4) Are current recipients wishing to renew.

Selection Criteria: Selection will be based on positive mental attitude, community service, servant leadership and an essay response.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000 minimum; multiple recipients



Chris Hatzell Memorial Scholarship



Description: The Chris Hatzell Memorial Scholarship was established by a group of classmates to honor his legacy.

Oualifications: (1) Have been a Madison County Resident for 12 months prior to application. (2) Are graduating from Frankton High School. (3) Have maintained a 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher. (4) Have actively participated in a sport(s) during his/her high school career (including team managers.) (5) Have done a minimum of 10 hours of community service during their senior year.

Selection Criteria: Selection will be based on academic excellence, strength of character, essay response.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000; 1 recipient

George and Nancye Hawes Memorial Scholarship



Description: The George and Nancye Hawes Memorial Scholarship was established by their three children to provide educational support to students from Anderson Community Schools who are unable to secure a post-secondary education due to financial need.

Oualifications: (1) Have been a Madison County Resident for 12 months prior to application. (2) Are graduating from Anderson High School. (3) Who plan to attend a two or four year institution of higher learning. (4) Have maintained a minimum GPA of 2.5.

Selection Criteria: Selection will be based on financial need, community service, and extracurricular activities.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000; 1 recipient

Brent Holland Memorial Scholarship



Description: Brent Holland was a Paramedic/Firefighter for the Anderson Fire Department and a County Councilman for Madison County. To honor Brent, this scholarship has been set up to assist those students graduating from a Madison County school with their post high school endeavors, and are seeking degrees in the field of Paramedic Science, Fire Science or Public Administration.

Qualifications: (1) Have been a Madison County Resident for 12 months prior to application. (2) Are current graduating seniors or past graduates of a Madison County High School. (3) Have maintained a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. (4) Plan to pursue a post-secondary education credential in one of the following fields: Fire Science, Paramedic Science, or Public Administration.

Selection Criteria: Selection will be based on an essay response as well as academic excellence.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000; 1 recipient

Hometown Heroes Scholarship



Description: This will provide scholarship support for Madison County graduating seniors who plan to pursue a post-secondary education credential at Anderson University or Ivy Tech Community College. **Qualifications**: (1) Have been a Madison County Resident for 12 months prior to application. (2) Are graduating from a Madison County high school. (3) Who plan to attend Anderson University or Ivy Tech Community College. (4) Have maintained a minimum GPA of 3.0. (5) Plan to pursue any type of post-secondary education credential.

Selection Criteria: Selection will be based on an academic achievement, leadership, character and community service.

Scholarship Amount: \$4,000 payable of 4 years; 1 recipient

Janice Paige Hughes Scholarship




