10 INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT SNOW:

- 1. The world's largest snowflake was reported to be 15 inches across and 8 inches thick. The Guinness Book of World Records states that this giant snowflake was found at Fort Keogh, Montana on January 28, 1887.
- 2. Snow is Not White: Snow is actually clear and colorless
- 3. The most snow ever recorded in a 24 hour period in the USA occurred at Silver Lake. Colorado in 1921 and was 76 inches of snow.
- 4. World Record Snowfall: Mt. Baker ski area in Washington State has the world record for snowfall at 1,140 inches of snow in the 1998/1999 winter season. Mt. Baker ski area is located near but not on the real 10,781' Mt. Baker. You can just imagine what the snow totals were on the real Mount Baker that year!
- 5. Earth's Fresh Water is Frozen: 80% of all the freshwater on earth is frozen as ice or snow. This accounts for 12% of the earth's surface.
- 6. What is a Blizzard? A blizzard occurs when you can't see for 1/4 mile. The winds are always 35 miles an hour or more. The storm must last at least 3 hours to be classed as a blizzard. If any of these conditions are less, it is only a snowstorm.
- 7. The USA averages 105 snow producing storms per year. A typical storm will have a 2-5 day lifetime and drop snow in multiple states.
- 8. All snowflakes have six sides. Period.

8 Interesting Facts About Abraham Lincoln

- 8. Lincoln has no heirs. Although he had four sons, there are no living descendants today. Edward died at the age of 4, Willie at 12 and Tad at 18. Robert was the only child to live to adulthood and his last known descendant died in 1985.
- 7. Lincoln's son was saved by his assassin's brother. Robert Lincoln was at a train station where he fell between the platform and the train as it began to move. He was pulled to safety by an actor, Edwin Booth- the brother of John Wilkes Booth.
- 6. Lincoln fought in the Civil War...sort of. He felt as the leader of the nation's military, the president should be fighting in the Civil War but obviously couldn't because of his duties. When J. Summerfield Staples heard this, he volunteered to fight as a substitute for Lincoln.



- 5. Lincoln was the first president to sport a beard while serving in office.
- 4. Lincoln was an inventor. He was the first and only president to ever obtain a patent. He was mechanically inclined and liked to take things apart just to see how they worked. In 1849, he got a patent for a device to lift ships over shoals by way of a buoying mechanism. His invention, US Patent No. 6,469 never made it into practical use.
- 3. Lincoln supported women's rights. He was the first major political figure to suggest extending the right to vote to women.
- 2. Lincoln had the first inaugural photograph. Standing close to Lincoln in the photo is his future assassin, John Wilkes Booth.
- 1. Lincoln had a premonition he would be killed. Not long before he was assassinated, Lincoln spoke of a dream where he heard someone weeping in the White House. When he found the room it was coming from, he asked who had died. He was told it was the president. He approached the coffin to peer in and saw his own face.

- Obesity
- Physical inactivity
- Tobacco use
- Family history

- Maintaining a healthy weight
- Limiting sodium
- Avoiding tobacco
- Moderating alcohol consumption

To make women more aware of the danger of heart disease, the National Heart, Lung and Blood Institute (NHLBI) sponsor a national campaign called The Heart Truth®. The campaign's goal is to give women the important message about their risk of heart disease. Since 2002, the "Red Dress®" is a symbol to remind women to take action to protect their heart.

National Wear Red Day is part of the promotion to make the "Red Dress®" a national symbol. Every year, on the first Friday in February, men and women across the country wear red (dress, shirt, tie) or wear the Red Dress pin to promote awareness for heart education.
