#### Tips for a Safe Thanksqiving

Safety in the kitchen is essential, especially on Thanksqiving Day, when there are a lot of activities and people at home. Fires while cooking is the #1 cause of home fires and injuries. Some things to remember, including:



- Make sure your smoke alarms are working. Test them by pushing the test button.
- Remain in the kitchen while you are boiling, grilling or frying food. If you leave the kitchen for even a short period, turn off the stove.
- If you are baking, simmering or roasting food, make sure to check it regularly. You should remain in the home while cooking and use a timer to make sure you do not forget you are cooking.
- Keep anything that can catch fire oven mitts, wooden utensils, food packaging, towels or curtains - away from your stove top.
- For a stove top fire, smother flames by sliding a lid over the pan then turn off the burner. Just leave the pan covered until it is completely cooled.
- For oven fires, turn off the heat and do not open the oven door.
- If you are not sure about fighting a small fire, just get out! Make sure to close the door behind you when you leave to help contain the fire. Once outside, be sure to call 911.

#### What is the most popular official state bird?

Move over, western meadowlark — the bright red northern cardinal sings its way to number one as the most popular state bird. Officially selected by seven states, the species can be found mainly in the Eastern United States. It is the official bird of Illinois (the first one to select it in 1929), Indiana, Ohio, West Virginia, Virginia, Kentucky and North Carolina. The northern cardinal is so popular that many major league and college teams use it as their mascot, including the St. Louis Cardinals baseball team



and the Arizona Cardinals football team. But for those who want to keep a northern cardinal as a pet, you are out of luck: It is illegal to do so in all fifty states. The western meadowlark is the second most popular bird; six states have selected it.
