Day EN ROUTE FROM U.S.

Day 2 **ARRIVE IN AMSTERDAM, NETHERLANDS – EMBARKATION (R,D)** Upon arriving to Amsterdam Airport Schiphol an Orbridge representative will be waiting to assist with your transfer to the hospitality room. Continue to the Rijksmuseum—the national museum of the Netherlands—before transferring to the ship by canal boat, an iconic experience that captures the essence of Amsterdam. Settle into your stateroom and become acquainted with the ship. This evening gather with fellow travel companions for a special welcome reception and captain's gala dinner.

Day 3 **HELIGOLAND, GERMANY (B,L,D)** Step ashore onto this remote and rugged archipelago in the North Sea about 40 miles off the German coastline. Once a strategic naval base, Heligoland was heavily bombed during World War II. Today the island is a protected nature reserve and a haven for seabirds. During a guided walking tour learn of the area's complex past and witness extraordinary bird colonies within close proximity—as gannets, guillemots and razorbills nest on and soar around the towering sandstone cliffs.

Day 4 **MANDAL, NORWAY (B,L,D)** Become acquainted with past and present life in Norway's southernmost town. Set out on a guided walking tour through Mandal's picturesque Old Town. The town's rich history as a maritime hub and its vibrant artistic community are evident. See one of the largest timber churches in Norway and ascend the charming staircase path to reach the Uranienborg Viewpoint.

Day 5 **STAVANGER (B,L,D)** Disembark in this dynamic city known for charming cobblestone streets and historic landmarks. Take a motor coach ride through Ullandhaug—an area recognized for its reconstructions of Iron Age farms. From here enjoy breathtaking views over Hafsrdjord. Continue to the Sverd i fjell ("Swords in Rock") memorial designed by sculptor Fritz Røed. Take a walking tour of Old Stavanger and visit the iconic Stavanger Cathedral, one of Norway's oldest churches. Enjoy an afternoon at leisure to take advantage of the ship's amenities while cruising towards Olden.



Day 6 **OLDEN (B,L,D)** This picturesque village is nestled at the head of the Nordfjord. A motor coach ride takes you along winding roads surrounded by majestic towering mountains and the still, glacial waters of the fjord. Drive through the village of Stryn arriving to Stryn Lake for photography opportunities. At the village of Loen, journey to the summit of Mount Hoven aboard the Loen Skylift. One of the steepest in the world, this cable car provides an exhilarating ascent from the base station in Loen to the mountain peak, reaching an altitude of more than 3,280 feet in just a few minutes. The spacious gondola's large windows offer stunning panoramic views. At the summit step out onto the viewing platform for 360° views over rugged peaks and pristine valleys. Enjoy leisure time to soak in the panoramic vistas and breathe in the crisp mountain air before the return descent to the base. Before returning to the ship see Olden Church dating back to the 18th century.

OPTIONAL EXCURSIONS

Hike at Leisure: Huaren Hiking Trail is suitable for all skill levels. This approximately five-mile route provides stunning views of Olden, the mountains and the fjord. For a moderately challenging alternative, try Skarsteinsætra—also approximately five miles.

Visit Olden at Leisure: Stroll independently, indulging in the surrounding natural beauty.

Day 7 **GEIRANGER (B,L,D)** After lunch board a motor coach to discover one of the most scenic routes in Europe—The Eagle Road—a remarkable feat of engineering winding through steep mountain terrain with a series of hairpin bends. Stop for photography opportunities at Eagles Bend nearly 2,000 feet above sea level. Continue to Nibbevegen, the road leading to Dalsnibba, considered to be one of the most ambitious road projects in Norwegian history. Arriving at Dalsnibba Skywalk take in the crisp mountaintop air and 360° views of the surrounding UNESCO World Heritage Western Fjords. Afterward return to the ship to relax and unwind before dinner.

OPTIONAL EXCURSIONS

Fjord Safari †: Embark on a guided tour aboard an agile rigid inflatable boat. Hear stories from your guide about the area while admiring the stunning waterways.

Hike at Leisure: For an easy hike try Fossevandring (aka Waterfall Hike)—which is also the starting point to reach longer, more demanding hikes. From there visit the Fjord Center and continue up to the Flydalsjuvet viewpoint. Alternatively from the Fjord Center, set off on the Løsta Trail—a more challenging route with beautiful views over the fjord.

Day 8 **NORDFJORDEID (B,L,D)** Discover the rich cultural heritage and typical daily life in the Norwegian Fjords. A guided walking tour takes you past the classic architecture of the church of Eid, the cultural Opera House and traditional wooden houses. Continue to the Sagstad Viking Center to learn about Norway's Viking history. Explore interactive exhibits showcasing archaeological finds from the region and view the full-scale replica of the largest Viking longship ever discovered—the Myklebust Ship. Later return to the ship for a relaxing afternoon cruising the fjords towards Stavanger. This evening indulge in another culinary masterpiece inspired by the flavors of Norway.

OPTIONAL EXCURSION

Kvalen and Nos Viewpoints †: Board a motor coach for a scenic drive towards the viewpoints situated 1,600 feet above sea level. This panoramic tour continues by Lake Hornidal with additional photography stops of the surrounding snow-capped mountains.

Visit Nordfjordeid at Leisure: Explore Nordfjordeid independently.

Day 9 **FLÅM (B,L,D)** Transfer to the Flåm Railway for the 60-minute ascent to the mountainous town of Myrdal. Along the route admire the panoramic vistas of snow-capped peaks, lush valleys and cascading waterfalls, including the famous Kjosfossen waterfall. Transfer to the Bergen railway towards the village of Voss. Enjoy cake and coffee at the historical Fleischer's Hotel followed by a scenic ride by bus back to Flåm. There will be time to explore Flåm independently before returning to the ship. Later cruise through UNESCO-listed Sognefjord, Norway's longest and deepest fjord. Along the route pass quaint farms perched on the hillsides, charming hamlets at the water's edge and idyllic meadows that have been shaped by generations of life along the fjord.

OPTIONAL EXCURSION

Fjord Safari †: Cruise through the Aurlandsfjord to the entrance of the spectacular Nærøyfjord—a branch of the Sognefjord, continuing to the beautiful Sagfossen waterfall. Your guide will maneuver the vessel to provide up-close views of the shoreline and potential wildlife along the way.

Day 10 **BERGEN (B,L,R,D)** Depart for Bergen by motor coach for a guided tour. Continue to Bryggen, a historic district and UNESCO World Heritage Site that encapsulates the rich maritime heritage and Hanseatic trading history of the city dating back to the 14th century. The final evening on board, gather for a lively farewell reception followed by a convivial gala dinner to commemorate this epic journey.

OPTIONAL EXCURSION

Bergen Touring †: Join a guide to see some of the city's premier highlights. Then ascend Mount Fløyen on the famous funicular. Finally stop at Fantoft Stave Church. This church gained notoriety in 1992 when it was destroyed in a suspected arson attack. The structure was painstakingly reconstructed using traditional methods and materials, ensuring that its historical and architectural integrity were preserved.

Day 11 **BERGEN – DISEMBARKATION | DEPART FOR U.S. (B)** After breakfast guests departing during the suggested times will take a complimentary transfer to the airport for flights home.

Day +2 **ARRIVE IN AMSTERDAM, NETHERLANDS** Upon arrival to Amsterdam Airport Schiphol transfer to the hotel and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.
Overnight: DoubleTree by Hilton Amsterdam Centraal Station

Day +3 **AMSTERDAM (B)** Visit the Van Gogh Museum, home to the world's largest collection of Vincent van Gogh's paintings, drawings and letters. Peruse through the museum's thoughtfully curated galleries, interactive exhibits and personal correspondences that provide an intimate glimpse into van Gogh's struggles and genius. Following lunch on your own, join a local guide for a captivating walking tour of the city's historic streets and charming canals. Conclude at Dam Square, a bustling plaza that's home to the Royal Palace, the New Church and the National Monument. Late afternoon and evening are at leisure.
Overnight: DoubleTree by Hilton Amsterdam Centraal Station

Day +4 **AMSTERDAM I MAIN PROGRAM BEGINS (B,L)** Following breakfast at the hotel board a motor coach to Zaanse Schans. This picture-perfect village is dotted with well-preserved 18th- and 19th-century windmills, wooden houses and artisan workshops. Venture inside a working windmill to discover the inner mechanics that once powered the country's economy, then enjoy leisure time in town. Rejoin the group for lunch before returning to the city for an inside visit to the Rijksmuseum. Later this afternoon take a scenic canal cruise to the embarkation point as you join guests arriving for the main program.

Set off on a journey of discovery from Bergen to Oslo highlighted by vibrant cityscapes, breathtaking mountain vistas and a captivating tapestry of past and present. Experience the true essence of Norwegian splendor where charming towns, historic rail routes and towering peaks surrounding the fjords create a picture-perfect backdrop for exploration.

Day 11 **BERGEN | STALHEIM (D)** After disembarkation board your private motor coach for the scenic two-hour drive to Stalheim. Before check-in visit the Stalheim Folk Museum—Tønneberg's collections, adjacent to your hotel. Later gather for dinner at the property. Overnight: Stalheim Hotel

Day 12 **STALHEIM | OSLO (B)** Depart by motor coach through the Nærøydalen Valley, a UNESCO World Heritage site. This route is one of the most picturesque in Norway. At Voss, board the train and settle in for one of Europe's most stunning rail journeys: the Bergensbanen to Oslo. Upon arrival transfer to the National Museum for a welcome drink and private guided tour. Overnight: Sommerro

Day 13 **OSLO (B)** Meet with a local guide for a scenic drive toward Holmenkollen—the site of the 1952 Olympic ski-jumping competition. Returning to Oslo, pass by the Norwegian Parliament, the National Theatre and the magnificent Royal Palace—official residence of the present Norwegian Monarch. Visit Vigeland Park featuring an impressive collection of more than 200 bronze, granite and wrought iron sculptures. Enjoy baked goods at Anne på landet, a charming café situated inside a beautifully restored building over a century old at the heart of Frogner Park. The remainder of the day is open to explore at leisure. Overnight: Sommerro

Day 14 **OSLO (B)** Before check-out delight in a decadent buffet breakfast featuring an assortment of delicious hot and cold options including made-to-order selections prepared by chefs at cooking stations. Guests departing during the suggested time take the complimentary transfer to the airport for flights home.
