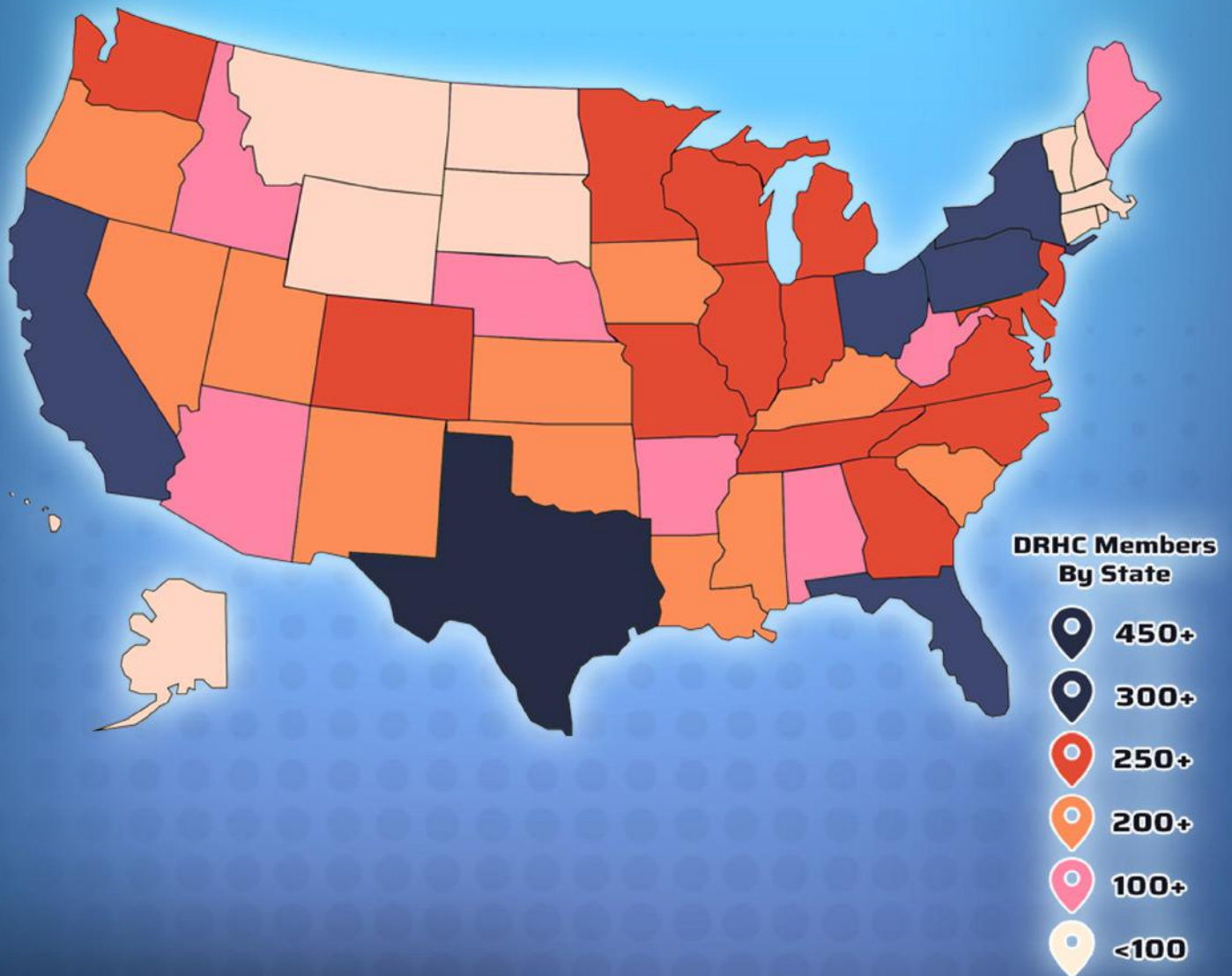

I can't thank you enough for being who you are and doing what you do **to make this world a better place for dogs.**

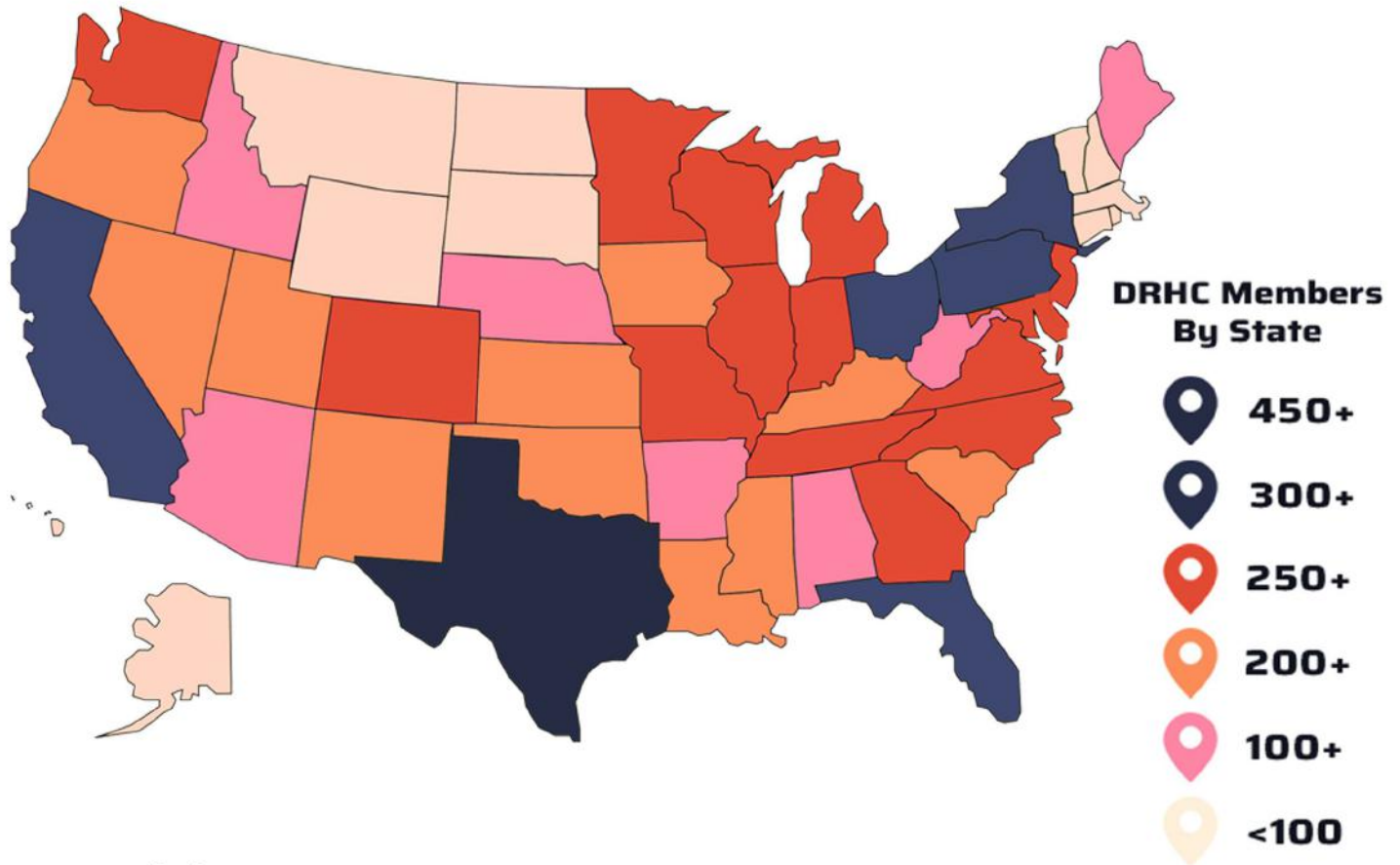

MEET THE DRHC TEAM

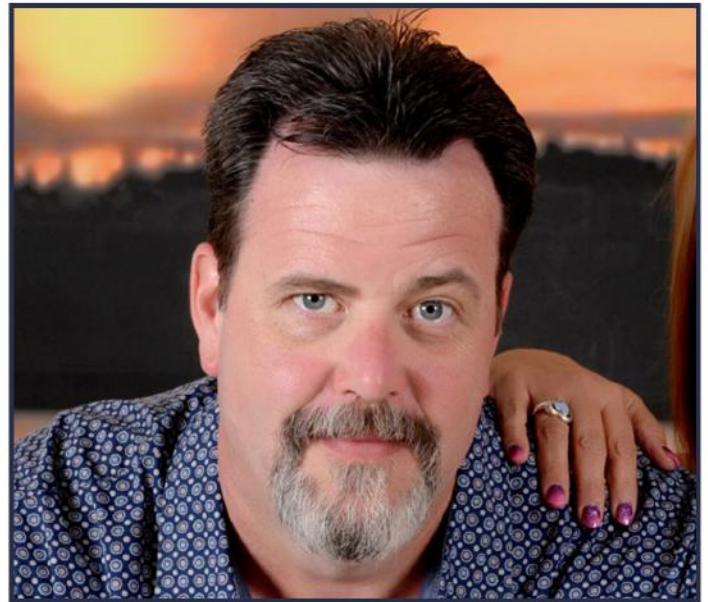

Me first saw Cara driving behind her on a rural road in Northwest Montana over 4 years ago.

She had just finished hand delivering **32 dogs taken from kill shelters in Northern California** to foster homes, no-kill shelters and fur-ever homes **in a van borrowed from the kill shelter!**

There is your proof that ONE person can make a huge difference.

Now she runs with us. We, the MIGHTY MIGHTY DRHC have her back.

The van? It belongs to The Underdog Railroad, donated by the DRHC. **We also cover 100% of the operating expenses and transport costs.**

Freedom Rides leave 2 or 3 times per month and typically carry 12 - 24 rescue dogs.
