







Shaped by a Meteorite

- defined by beauty!

AROUND 380 MILLION years ago, a four kilometre wide meteorite hit the earth and created the area which we today call The Siljan Ring. On the edge of this crater you will find the village of Tällberg, with gently rolling and fertile terrain, stretching down to the lakeshore.

The impact of the meteorite was so powerful that rocks were lifted and turned upside down and cracks were formed deep in the bedrock. Even today, you can see the upturned rock layers from the meteorite impact standing upright in Siljan Geopark – Sweden's first national geopark with unique geological phenomena and natural value.

HISTORIC TIMELINE

950

THE VIKINGS

The Lake Siljan district carries a rich Viking legacy. This inland lake was once part of ancient travel routes, and boat culture has deep roots here. Today's traditional church boats, still rowed on Siljan during festivals, are descendants of the Viking longboats that once sailed these waters.





1600s

THE TRADITION OF RAISING A MAYPOLE

The maypole, or "majstång," is a central part of midsummer celebrations in Dalarna, a tradition that dates from the 17th century. Likely rooted in older fertility rites, it became a festive symbol of summer, growth and community. Each village developed its own traditions for decorating and raising the pole – many of which live on today.

1521

GUSTAV VASA GATHERS THE TROOPS

The rebel Gustav Eriksson passing by trying to gather troops among the peasantry, who are known for being strong, competent ... and a bit stubborn. In February 1521 the troop consist of 400 men, mainly from the area around Lake Siljan. They participate in the Swedish War of Liberation against King Christian II and Gustav becomes the King of Sweden in 1523 and gets the name Gustav Vasa.





1700s

THE ORIGIN OF THE DALA HORSE

The Dala horse dates back to the 18th century, when woodworkers in villages around Mora began carving them during long winter nights. Originally simple toys, they were later painted in bright colors and traditional patterns. After being showcased at the 1939 World's Fair in New York, the Dala horse became a beloved symbol of Sweden.

1907

FROM FARMING VILLAGE TO SUMMER ESCAPE

Around 1907, Tällberg transformed from a farming village into a summer retreat for Sweden's cultural elite. As industrialisation modernized the country, artists and urban dwellers rediscovered the region's folk costumes, music and timber houses. Drawn by its authenticity, they built elegant summer homes by Lake Siljan, shaping Tällberg into the cultural haven it is today.



1936

VILLA LÅNGBERS – A HISTORIC HILLTOP RETREAT

Perched at the top of Tällberg, Villa Långbers has welcomed guests since the 1930s. Originally a private villa, it quickly became a beloved gathering place for artists, writers, and creatives seeking inspiration in the calm of Dalarna. Over the years, the hotel has grown – but the soul remains the same: a place for reflection, great food, and panoramic views over Lake Siljan.

1914

THE ARRIVAL OF THE RAILWAY

When Tällberg station was built in 1914, Tällberg became more accessible to visitors from across Sweden, especially from major cities like Stockholm. The station played a key role in transforming the village from a rural farming community into a popular summer retreat, where visitors were drawn by the fresh air and the invigorating baths in Lake Siljan. It marks the beginning of Tällberg as a popular tourist destination.





1937


KLOCKARGÅRDEN – FROM CRAFT SHOP TO CULTURAL DESTINATION

Klockargården's story began in 1937, when a couple with a passion for handicrafts and local traditions bought an abandoned farm in the village of Tällberg. What started as a small craft shop and guesthouse grew over time into a beloved hotel and cultural destination. Today, Klockargården blends Dalarna's rich heritage with warm hospitality, offering guests a unique experience shaped by history, music, and genuine Swedish charm.

1950

ASTRID LINDGREN ENJOYS TÄLLBERG

It was at Hotel Villa Långbers that
Astrid Lindgren, one of the world's most beloved
authors, spent many of her trips during the 1950s,
60s and 70s. She first arrived in the early 1950s and
returned year after year – often alone, sometimes
with her grandchildren – to write and find peace
that sparked creativity.



2005

TÄLLBERG FORUM GATHERS WORLD LEADERS

The Tällberg Forum, launched in 2005 by the Tällberg Foundation, brought global leaders, thinkers, and artists to the small village of Tällberg in Dalarna. Among its distinguished participants were His Majesty King Carl XVI Gustaf of Sweden, political figures like Kofi Annan, business leaders, and cultural voices, all meeting to discuss how humanity can live together in a sustainable future.





1951

GYLLENE HORNET – FROM POSTAL RETREAT TO FAMILY RESORT

Hotel Gyllene Hornet was originally transformed in the 1950s as a holiday retreat for Sweden's postal workers – a place for relaxation and breathing fresh air. Over the years, it has evolved into a full-service, family-friendly resort with a pool, spa, recreational areas and spacious outdoor grounds.







Villa Långbers, was originally built as a private residence in the early 1900s. Sisters Elsa and Wilma Långbers, returning from America, saw the potential in the "most beautiful place on earth" and established a health retreat and boarding house here in 1936.

Quickly gaining a reputation as a fashionable destination, Villa Långbers welcomed renowned artists, writers, and royalty, such as **Astrid Lindgren** and the young **King Carl XVI Gustaf** in 1950.

Villa Långbers remains an example of classic Dalarna architecture, with a rich history tied to the growth of tourism in Tällberg. The Långbers sisters also founded the weaving and handicraft school Sätergläntan, now a globally renowned center for Swedish crafts.







How to get to Tällberg

TÄLLBERG IS LOCATED in the heart of the Dalarna region, surrounded by forests, hills, and panoramic views over Lake Siljan. The village is easy to reach by train, car, or air – and once you arrive, you will understand why so many choose to return.

BY TRAIN

Tällberg has its own train station along the Stockholm–Mora railway line.

- The travel time from Stockholm is ~ 3.5 hours.
- The journey offers scenic views through the Swedish countryside.
- The station is situated only a few minutes from our hotels.
- All hotel guests are offered complimentary pick-up from the station upon request.

BY AIR

The nearest international airport is Stockholm Arlanda (ARN). Travel time to Tällberg from Arlanda is \sim 3 hours by car or 3–4.5 hours by train.

BY CAR OR COACH

Tällberg is easily accessible by road, with well-maintained routes from all directions:

- From Stockholm: ~4 hours
- From Oslo: ~5 hours
- From Gothenburg: ~6 hours
- From Trelleborg: ~9 hours
- From Copenhagen: ~9 hours


EQUIPMENT USE & RESPONSIBILITY

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
