Ikigai is a Japanese term that blends two words: “iki” meaning “to live,” and “gai” meaning “reason,” which translates to “a reason to live.”

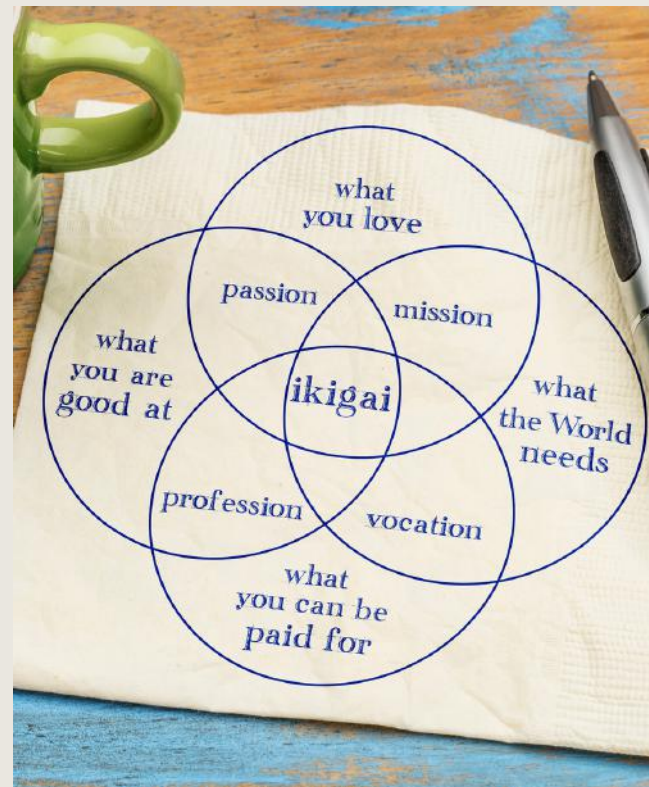
It's a concept that encourages people to discover what truly matters to them and to live a life filled with purpose and joy.

The hinge (to young and old alike) is a gadget that systematically allows ideas in the head (visual or conceptual) to simply and efficiently take on life in the hand as an interactive, 'puppet-like' media: “Arty-Facts”. This ability to take conventional information and render it visually and interactively in the hand is, frankly, an extraordinary innovation by itself. Kids and teachers love the hinge; it simplifies and systematizes an often complicated art, making it a perfect fit for classroom conversation, and enabling any idea, simple or abstract, to be easily grasped and thrust into playful exchange and agency.

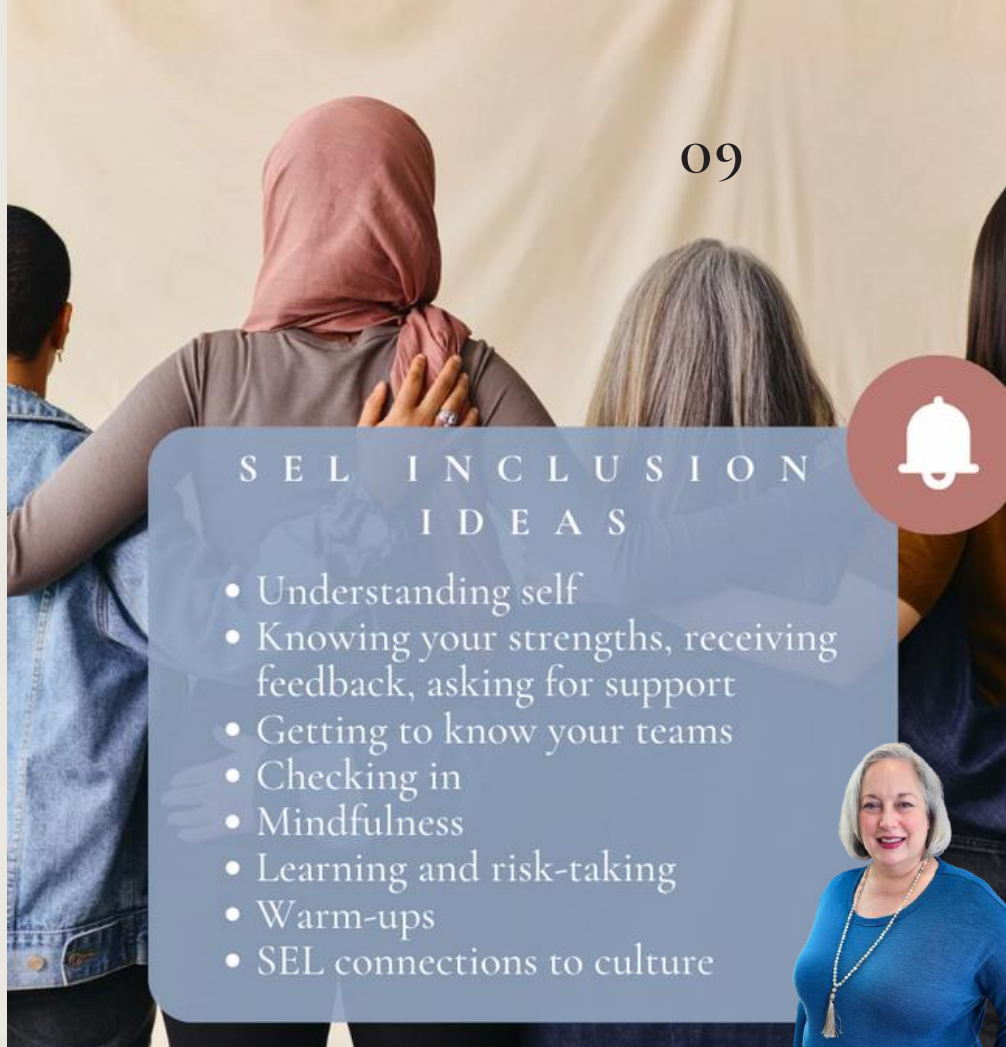

LEVERAGING SEL INCLUSIONS WITH ADULTS

Research suggests that cultivating resilience and developing emotional intelligence through adult social-emotional learning (SEL) fosters relational trust and creates psychologically safe(er) environments. This work empowers us to be better communicators and collaborators and has a positive effect on student learning (Bryk and Schneider, 2002).

How can we include adult SEL in our already full schedules? Adding inclusions to the opening of meetings is a powerful way to embed SEL without the need for additional dedicated time.
