LEVELS

Focuses on stroke mechanics for the 4 competitive strokes (butterfly, freestyle, BEGINNER backstroke and breast stroke. This group will be introduced to starts and turns.

Focus for this group will be to improve technique. Strokes should start to look INTERMEDIATE natural and have a fluid motion. Instruction will work on improving starts and turns.

> Focus will be on refining strokes, building up endurance and speed. This group will work on efficiency of starts and turns.



SENIOR FARMER'S MARKET NUTRITION PROGRAM

2025 Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program brought to you by the State of Missouri Department of Agriculture and SeniorAge. Eligible Seniors will receive \$50.00 to use at any participating farmer's market. One set of vouchers per address. Eligible senior must be present at sign-up. For those seniors designating a proxy, the proxy should come as well so they understand the process of shopping.

If you qualify, you will receive your vouchers that day. If you have questions, call 417-862-0762.

To qualify, bring:

- Proof of Income (current bank statement, 2024 tax return)
- 2. Proof of Identity (drivers license or Missouri ID)
- Proof of Residency (current utility bill or current bank statement)
- Proof of Age (must be 60 or older) drivers license or birth certificate
- Designated Proxy (if you want someone to do the shopping for you)
