

EXTDAY@LN is an after-school program offered to all day students in Year 5 to 8.

It operates from 3:15pm until 8:00pm each Monday to Thursday during term time. Students may be collected at any time during the afternoon, apart from 5:00pm-5:30pm when the group is having dinner in the Boarders' Dining Room.

Staff involved in this program are from various faculties including English, Maths, PDHPE, Geography, History and Drama.

Afternoon tea and dinner are included in the \$60 daily charge.

- · Supervised recreational activities.
- Guided study supported by teachers from different faculties.
- Access to a wide range of on-campus extra-curricular activities.
- Social interaction with peers from different year groups.

Schedule

3:15pm

Sign-in with teachers in GBC 1.02 when school day concludes. Head to extracurricular activities, if applicable.

3:15pm-3:45pm

Students may change into more comfortable clothing.
Afternoon tea – provided.

3:45pm-4:30pm

Supervised recreation or extra-curricular activities. Some students may choose to begin their study/homework at this time.

Year 5-6 Sport ends at 4:30pm – students return to GBC 1.02 (and have their afternoon tea).

4:30pm-5:00pm

Year 7-8 Study Session 1: Homework help and guided study OR extra-curricular activities.

5:00pm-5:30pm

Dinner in the Boarders' Dining Room. No pick-ups can occur during this time.

5:30pm-5:45pm

Flexible time: Board games, quiet reading, and other hobbies.

5:45pm-8:00pm

Study Session 2: Homework help and quided study.

Year 5-6 students may choose to read or engage in other independent activities.

8:00pm

Final pick up time.









EXTDAY FAQ

What is the cost of the EXTDAY@LN Program?

The program is \$60 per afternoon. This is billed to student accounts in the following term. Enrolment is for an entire term.

How will EXTDAY@LN be staffed?

EXTDAY@LN is overseen by a variety of members of the teaching staff.

Where does the program take place?

Students meet in the Mary Ward Quad and move to GBC 1.02. At times we may need to move to GBC 2.01-2.03.

Will my daughter need to attend every afternoon or every week?

Parents select the day(s) of the week on which their daughter will attend. She may attend those days each week for the term. Enrolment is for a whole term so you will be charged regardless of your daughter's attendance (exceptions are outlined below).

If my daughter is absent, will I still be charged? Are make-up days available?

Your account will be charged for a whole term regardless of attendance. At this stage, makeup days are not available. However, if you know in advance and would like to swap a day, this may be accommodated as long as ample prior notice is provided.

What happens if a Public Holiday falls on my daughter's EXTDAY@LN day?

EXTDAY@LN will not operate on a non-school day, and you will not be billed for that afternoon. The total cost for the term will take into account public holidays or pupil free days falling within the term. Any absence due to school camps or other school business will be taken into consideration. These days will not be charged.

How will EXTDAY@LN accommodate my daughter's extra-curricular commitments?

Students often have sport training or other extra-curricular commitments until 4:30pm or 5:00pm.

Students involved in these should let the EXTDAY teachers know they are present and then join the EXTDAY group at the conclusion of their commitment. Please note, that you will still be charged the full fee for those afternoons.

For any student involved in extra-curricular activities afternoon tea will be kept aside for them to have when they return. If any student is involved in extra-curricular activities over dinner time (5:00pm-5:30pm) their meal will be brought to them by supervising staff when they return.

Are we able to use the Service NSW voucher for Before and After School Care or make use of the Child Care Subsidy (CCS) for EXTDAY@ I N?

No, EXTDAY@LN is not registered for Service NSW benefits.

Do students need to wear the school uniform?

Uniform is not required. Many students choose to bring a change of clothing for the afternoon.

Will the School facilitate transport home?

We ask parents to make all arrangements to collect their daughters. You will be asked to provide the details of the person who will be collecting your daughter (if it is not one of the parents outlined in the enrolment form).

Where do I collect my daughter at the end of the evening?

For pick up, please make your way to the Oval PUDO (Gate 4 off Osborn Road) and contact supervising staff on <u>0400 385 144</u>. Once contacted, staff will bring your daughter to you at the Oval PUDO.

Am I able to pick up my daughter before 8:00pm?

Of course! You may collect your daughter at any time in the afternoon – except while the group is in the Boarders' Dining Room for dinner (between 5:00pm-5:30pm). Families are invoiced the full cost of the program for each afternoon regardless of the pick-up time.
