This is an excellent outcome over the past two months, particularly given that preferred lies have been in place.


So, keep up the good work and continue to stay up with the group in front!

The 12:30pm shotgun start booking sheet for this year's Green Acres Classic is now open. Book your starting hole and enjoy a round of Gentsomes Ambrose with your favourite playing group. Please note the afternoon shotgun is strictly for Classic participants, and the \$65 entry fee will be charged to member accounts.

Gentsomes is a four-player team format. Everyone tees off, the best drive is selected, and all then play their own ball from that spot. Scoring is Stableford, with the two best scores counting each hole. Each player must contribute a minimum of three and a maximum of six drives.

Following golf, members will enjoy a two-course dinner and prize presentations. Awards will be given for the best men's, women's and mixed teams, plus nearest to pins.



## BASS STRAIT TROPHY

#### Bass Strait Trophy

The Bass Strait Trophy is one of the most enduring traditions between Green Acres Golf Club and Riverside Golf Club. Since 1962, the two clubs have faced off each year, alternating as host, in an event built on camaraderie, friendship and a healthy dose of competition. It is also a wonderful opportunity for new members to meet and bond with long-time members while sharing in the history and traditions of the event.

Across the 60 contests played, the record now stands at Riverside 33 victories, Green Acres 27, with Green Acres claiming the 2024 edition. The very first challenge took place on 1st November 1962, when 35 Green Acres members chartered an Ansett ANA flight to Launceston to take on Riverside. That match, won by Riverside, was a stroke event, and since then the format has evolved into mostly 4BBB Stableford. Green Acres generously provided the trophy itself, which remains the prize competed for today.

Other memorable chapters in the event's history include:

- 1975 A washout at Green Acres forced the match to Peninsula GC, where Riverside claimed their first win on Victorian soil.
- 2012 The 50th anniversary was celebrated at Riverside with a special dinner that honoured the friendships and traditions built over five decades.
- 2022 A thrilling contest at Green Acres saw the home team edge out Riverside by just two points, thanks to a superb 50point round from Travis Cox and Brian Wasley!

Now, attention turns to 2025, when the Bass Strait Trophy returns to Riverside Golf Club, Launceston, on Saturday, the 1st and Sunday, the 2nd of November.

#### Pre-Bass Strait Trophy

As has become tradition, the weekend will be preceded by golf at Barnbougle and Lost Farm, limited to 28 players only:

- Thursday 30th October Lost Farm, teeing off at 1.00 pm (accommodation booked for 30/10 at Lost Farm in twin share rooms with dinner at the Lost Farm Restaurant from 7.30 pm)
- Friday 31st October Barnbougle Dunes, teeing off at 9.00 am

#### Accommodation - Riverside

Accommodation has been secured for 24 players at the Riverside Hotel/Motel (Friday to Sunday nights). Rooms are payable on arrival, though players are welcome to make their own arrangements.

#### **Numbers and Traditions**

The field will be capped at 32 players per team (64 total), with priority entry for past participants. Currently, only 8 spots remain, so it will be first in, best dressed!

All players are encouraged to gather for Welcome Drinks at Riverside GC on Friday 31st October at 5.30 pm. This is a tradition we are proud to continue as it sets the tone for the weekend ahead.

#### Yarrawonga Getaway


Our golf trip to Yarrawonga was the perfect excuse to pack the clubs, escape the chaos, carpool and let your hair down, literally!!
