that spans the full suite of cards.

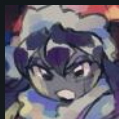
Each artist put their hearts into their

Reading Guide

The Major Arcana consist of 22 cards - beginning with 00, The Fool and ending with XXI, The World - and the Minor Arcana consist of 54 cards separated into 4 suits of 14 cards each; the Suit of Cups, the Suit of Wands, the Suit of Swords, and the Suit of Pentacles. The Major Arcana are all unique, individual cards that represent significant parts of your life.

However, the Suits - while consisting of definitions for each card - have specific traits that they each abide to, all of which are applied to a person's daily life. The Suit of Cups is meant to represent intuition and emotions, the inner feelings of a person. Similarly, the Suit of Wands represents passion and creativity. The Suit of Swords represents decision and conflict, and the Suit of Pentacles represents money and health. Each card has its own meaning, but it is important to look at them through the lenses of the suit in its entirety.

There are several ways to read a Tarot spread, however the most common and most simple way is the 3 card spread. It is meant to give insight to your past, your present, and your future. It is most commonly used for mundane, day to day readings, and for insight and awareness of specific situations or events. Your past, present, and future will be what guide you, so it is important to pay attention and understand what your cards are trying to tell you. Pay attention to the entire spread, and piece together your reading as you look at the whole picture ahead of you.

0 | The Fool

EUDEN – BEARER OF DRAGONLIGHT

"If you find yourself in trouble, just reach out. I'll help however I can."

Upright

Innocence | New Beginnings | Potential

The Fool represents vulnerability, naivety, innocence—yet also the joys, wonder, and the potential of a new beginning. He is encouraging you to be open, willing, and embrace all that lies ahead without worry. You have likely yet to experience the ups and downs of the journey ahead, which leaves you unaware of the challenges that await you, and the strength that you hold. He is telling you to take a leap of faith, and trust where your heart guides you.



REVERSE

Naivety | Vulnerability | Recklessness

In reverse, a new journey lies ahead, but you may be unsure of the path you must take. He is telling you to have faith— regardless of whether you are ready, the future stops for no one. You must open your heart and trust in the strength you possess. What you need to continue your journey lies within you— be courageous, and have faith.

Intelligence | Power | Skill

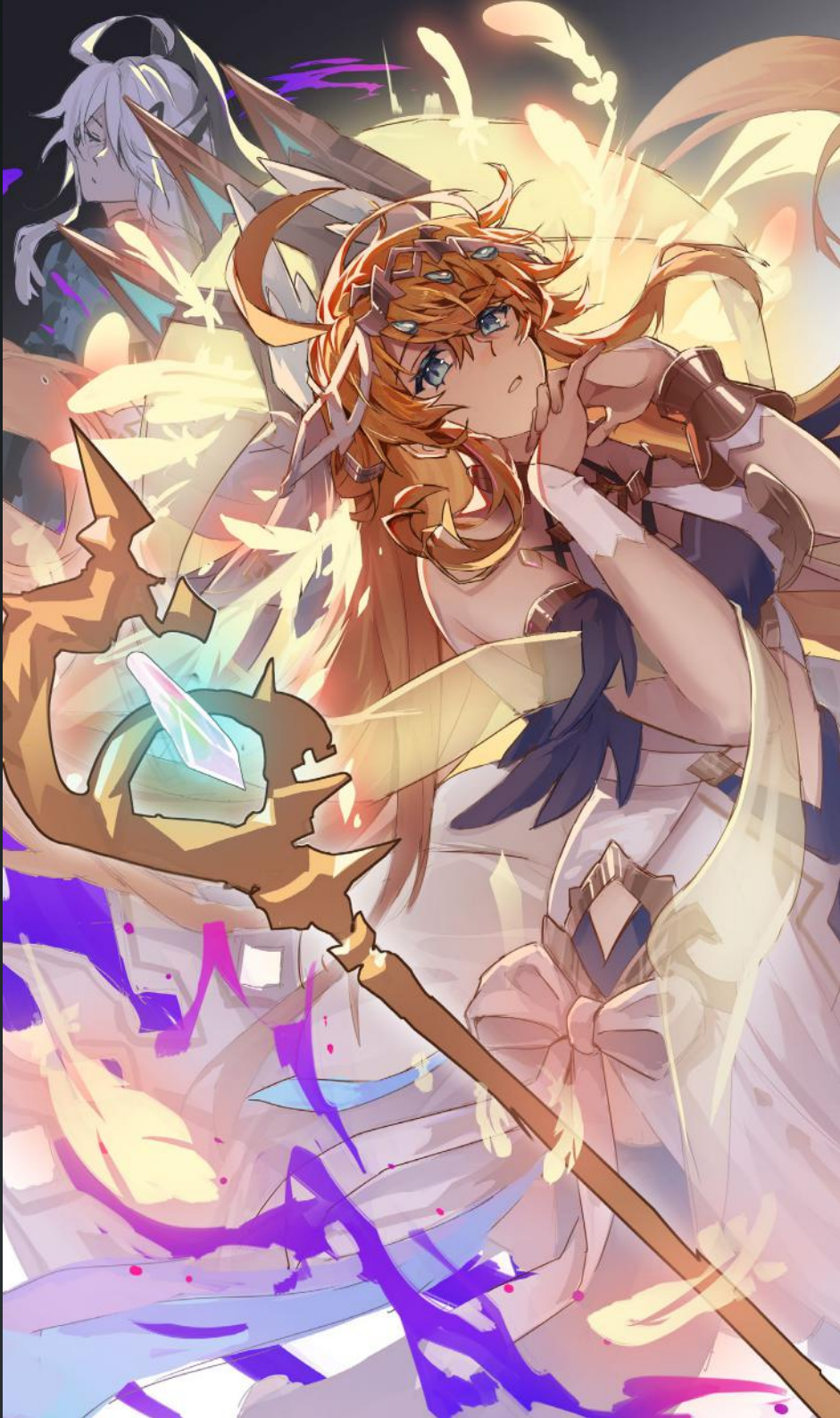

UPRIGHT

Spirituality | Wisdom | Reflection

REVERSE

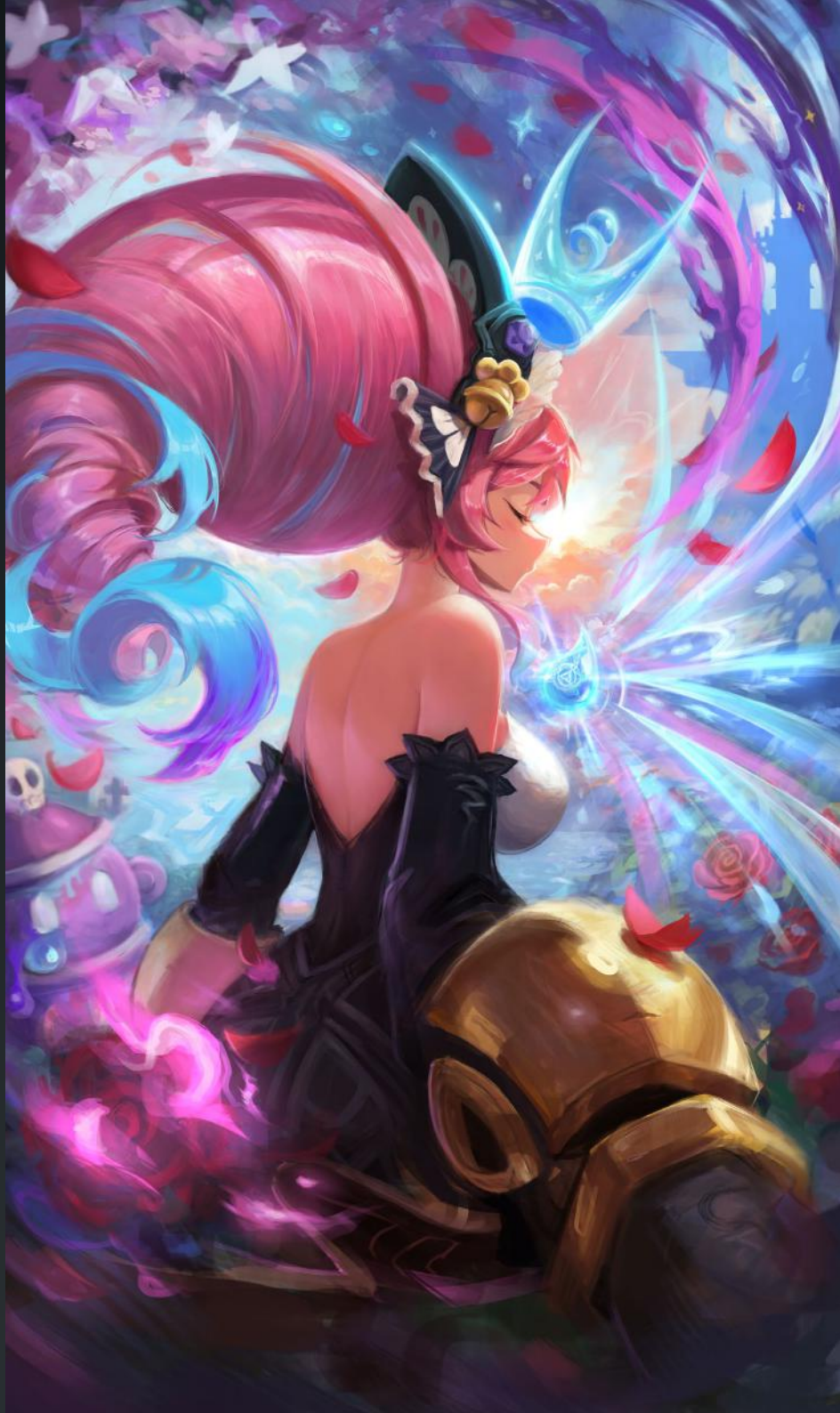

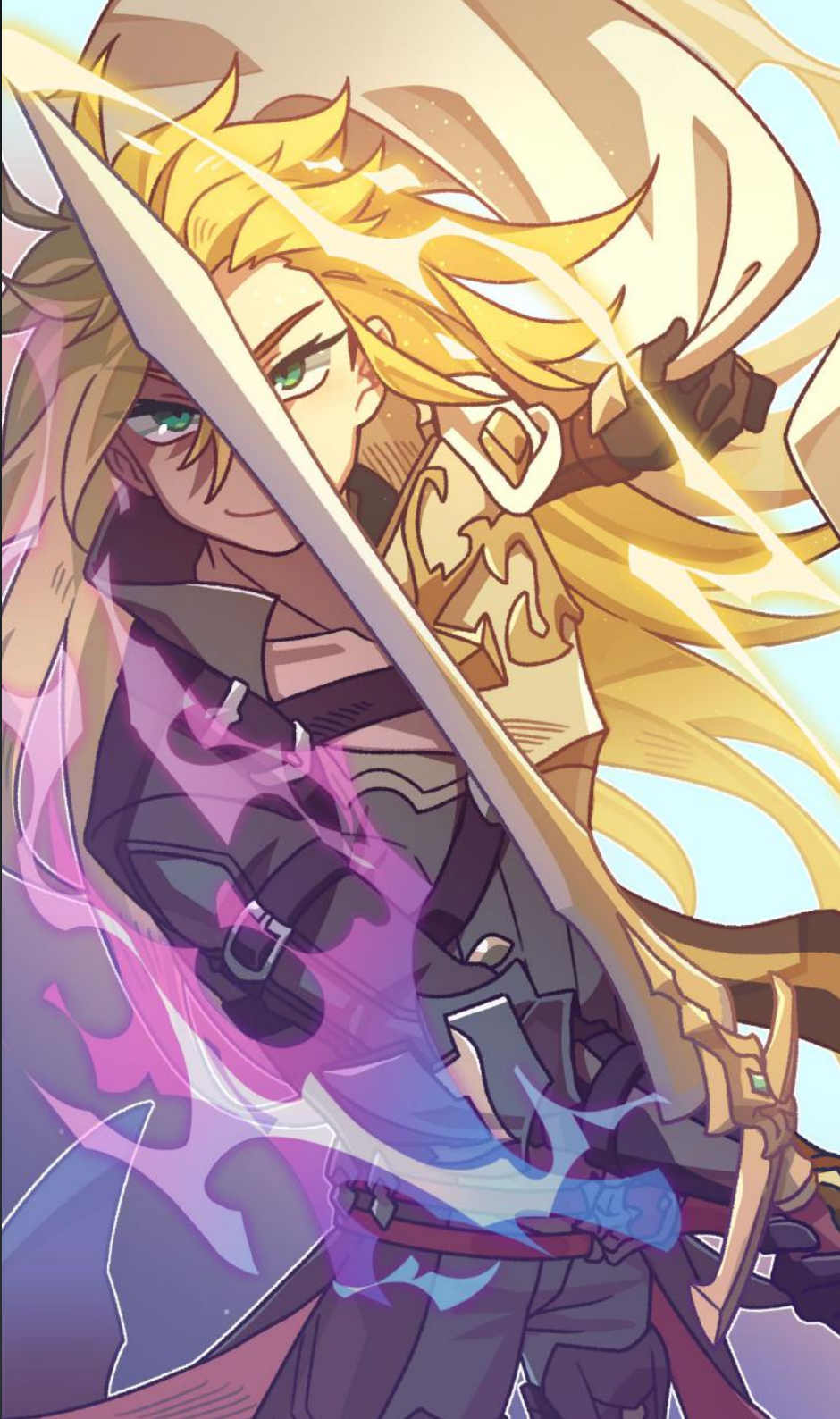
REVERSE

Authority | Stability | Ambition

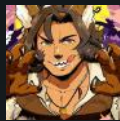
The Emperor represents authority, stability, and ambition. He is a great leader, with great power, upholding strong, just, and dependable values. Upright, He symbolizes an important man in your life, and asks you to listen to his wisdom. You may be making an important decision soon, and He is telling you to listen to your mind— you will need to be strong and think with logic rather than emotion when that decision appears.



REVERSE

Cruelty | Obsession with Control

Reversed, He may be representing a man in your life who is abusing his power over you, and is being needlessly cruel. Do not be afraid to stand up for yourself and fight back, but keep a calm head. He may even be telling you that your emotions are overruling your decisions, and you need to take a step back to think clearly. Revisit whatever it is that plagues you. You hold immense power over your life and what happens to you— do not forget this.

REVERSE

REVERSE

In reverse, you may be losing your way and are uncertain about the future before you. If you are feeling powerless, it may be time to regain control of your life. Your uncertainty and lack of power may be making you feel aggressive or defensive— do not let others walk over you, and remember to set aside time for yourself. Your greatest success will not come through limited thinking.



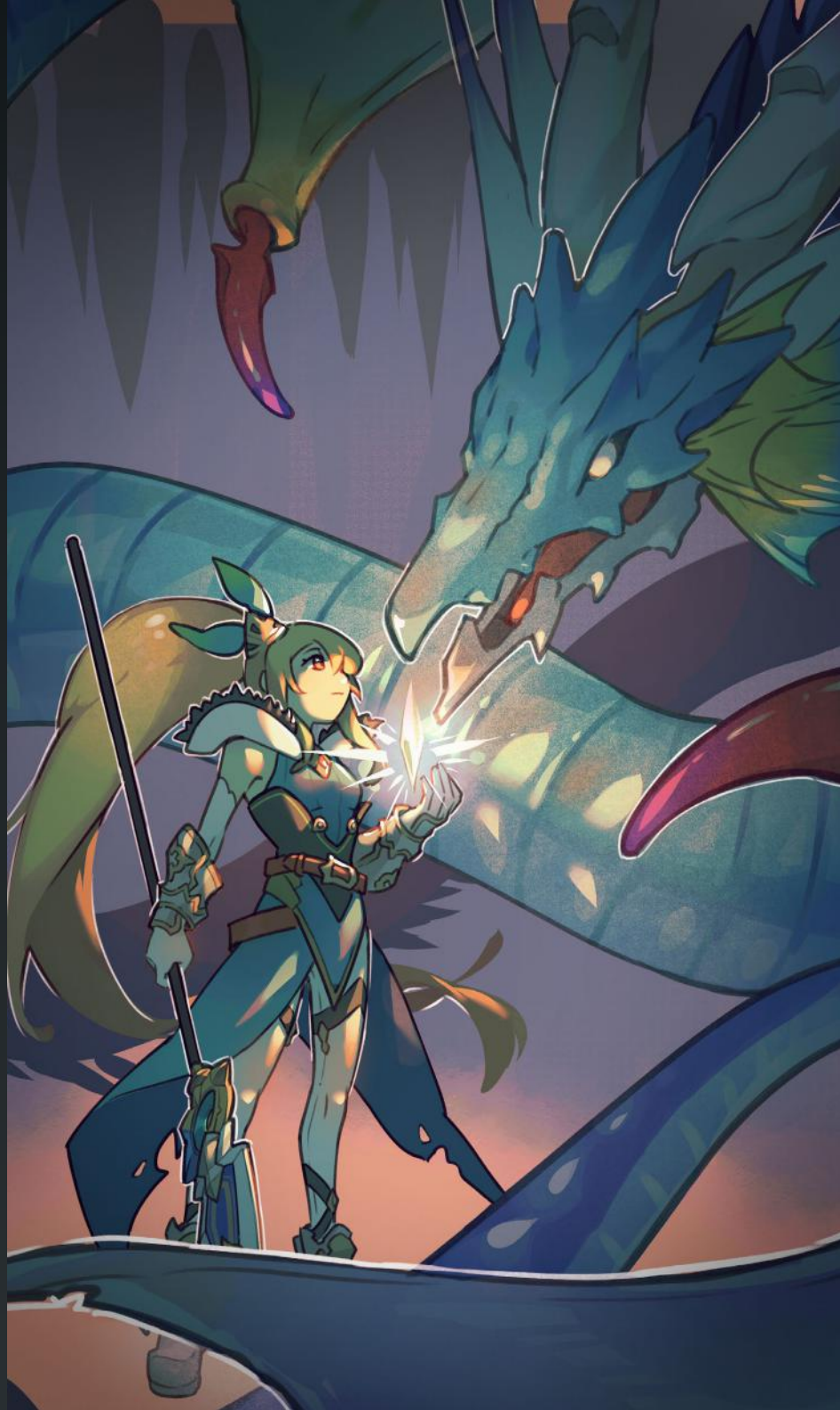

You are letting fear guide you. Remember, you can handle whatever it is you are facing, and you will come out of it stronger than before.

REVERSE

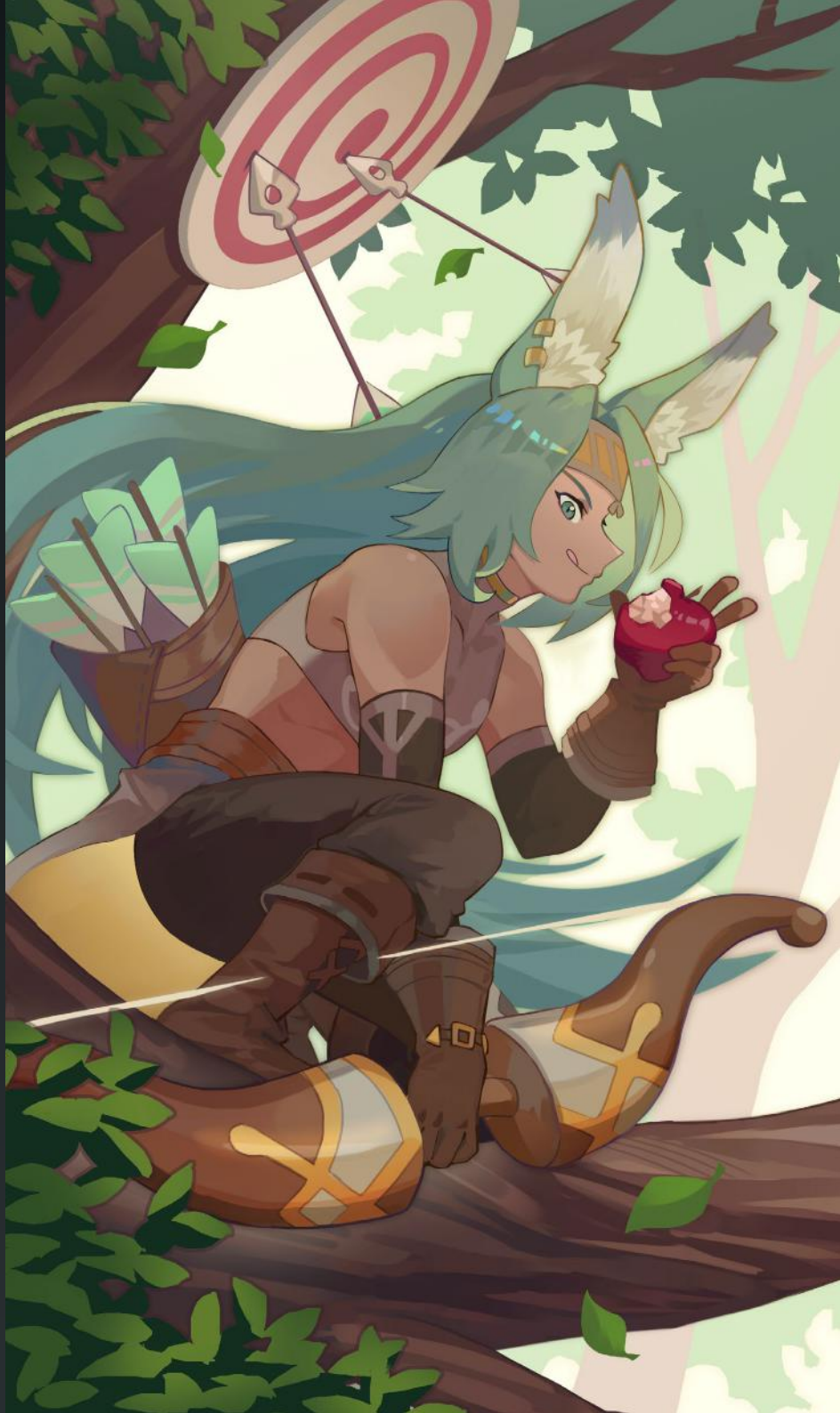

Upright, this card represents good luck and good fortune. Good things will be coming your way, but only if you put in the work to achieve them. Know what it is that you want, and cherish what you have now.



REVERSE

Misfortune | Disorder | Loss of Control

Life is in a constant state of change. In reverse, this card is telling you your good luck may be coming to an end, if it hasn't already. It may mean things have suddenly fallen apart, or that you were set on this path long before you realized what it would lead you down. But, as all things are, change is not inherently evil. As long as you find control over your life and do not resist what has come to pass, there will always be new opportunities ahead.

Justice | Truth | Law

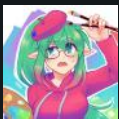

In reverse, She is telling you to face the consequences of your actions. Whether it be your own dishonesty or injustice, you must accept the results and learn from them. You may be faced with something unfair or unjust— remember to maintain peace, and face it with grace. Whatever comes your way, let it come, and let it pass.

New Beginnings | Transition | Change

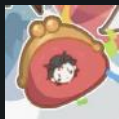

Patience | Tranquility | Balance

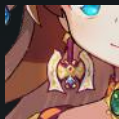

Destruction | Upheaval | Tragedy

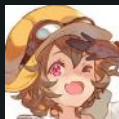

Joy | Vitality | Optimism | Life

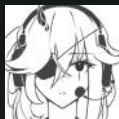

Judgement | Awakening | Clarity

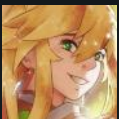
