### What do people get out of going to the zoo?

Apart from the exercise, research has shown that visits to zoos can have some very important benefits for people. First, there are health benefits for getting out in nature; it can lower stress levels and the fresh air is of course good for you. For people who live in urban areas without easy access to "getting way out into nature" this can be a critical activity for them.

Second, over the last few decades zoos have shifted their emphasis away from showing animals in isolation to showing them in the context of their larger habitat: other animals who live in the same biome, as well as the plants that make up that environment as well and without which the animals couldn't survive. This teaches important lessons about the importance of protecting entire habitats, and not just individual animals that we've come to adore.



Third, studies have shown that people are far more likely to act on conservation and environmental protection when they have made a personal connection with nature (flora and/or fauna). So, going to the zoo, seeing animals up close, and hopefully having some chance to interact with them is critically important to driving not just an awareness of conservation issues but also concrete

Finally, it's important to note that zoos are constantly changing: babies are born, exhibits get added and improved, and the educational materials get better. Even though I spend lots of time at my local zoo, I'm never bored when I go there.

### 8 facts you probably forgot about 8-tracks

Vinul is back, and cassettes are common, too. Heck, even reel-to-reel has a cult following amongst audiophiles. Yet one of the earliest and (briefly) most popular tape formats remains a relic of the past. The 8-track is associated with lava lamps, bell-bottoms, long-haired rock bands and funk. The chunky tape cartridges were perfect for slotting into the broad dashboard of a boat-sized Cutlass Supreme. Some of your first boomboxes were perhaps portable 8-track players.

April 11th is National 8-Track Day, we thought we'd salute these plastic, analog pop antiques. Here are 8 facts about 8-tracks.

1. They were developed by a jet airplane manufacturer. William P. Lear founded the Lear Jet Corporation, giving plenty of celebrities and businesses private airplanes. The inventor gets less credit for his wonderful contributions to science. In 1964, Lear developed the 8-track as the Lear Jet Stereo 8, an improvement on the 4-track Muntz Stereo-Pak cartridge. It's no wonder that the transportation industry would help popularize the format.

- 2. In 1965 Ford first introduced players in its Mustang, Thunderbird and Lincoln models. The first commercial 8-track players became available in September 1965, as a dash-mounted stereo option in Ford's Mustang, Thunderbird and Lincoln models. Additionally, those who'd purchased a Fairlane or Mercury could add on a "hang-on tape player." At launch, RCA released 175 titles from its back catalog, artists like Henry Mancini and the Boston Pops.
- 3. The first karaoke machine was an 8-track player. Daisuke Inoue, pictured, shows off his 1971 invention, the "8-Juke," a wooden box that combined microphone, amplifier, coin box and an 8-track tape player. Inoue claims to have sold 25,000 of the Juke 8. Sadly, Inoue, the son of a pancake maker, did not patent the device. Today, karaoke is a household word and Inoue hardly sees a dime.
- AP Photo/Koii Sasahara 4. There were four "programs" on each tape. Unlike the more common cassette tape, and the bifurcated vinyl LP, the 8-track featured four "programs," not two sides. A listener would toggle from program to program, which required the tape player to physically move its reading head. This quirky segmentation was part of the format's downfall.



- 5. ...which meant album sequences were usually shuffled and songs were split in two. The four-program arrangement meant that album track listings had to be shuffled from their intended sequence. Take Magical Mystery Tour, pictured, for example. "Strawberry Fields Forever," typically the second cut on Side B, kicks off the second program (to name just one of the differences). Long tracks would be split in two, as with "In-A-Gadda-Da-Vida." It wasn't all bad news, however. In some cases, music had to be added, as with the Rolling Stones' Some Girls, which extended "Miss You" and "Beast of Burden" to fill the tape. Bonus!
- 6. You could get 13 of them for a penny thanks to Columbia House. Oh, Columbia House. How did you stay in business so long? RCA also had a mail-order record club. We can't be the only ones who got that baker's dozen right before moving houses, bailing on that commitment to purchase more.
- 7. In the 1980s, many popular titles were only available on 8-track through record clubs. As the popularly of the format took a nosedive in the 1980s, the 8-track tape was largely relegated to such mail-order record clubs. If you were an 8-track collector and wanted hit albums like John Cougar's American Fool or the Beastie Boys' Licensed to III, you had to go through a record club.
- 8. Fleetwood Mac's Greatest Hits is probably the last album commercially released on 8-Track. While it is not a certainty, most collectors claim that Fleetwood Mac's Greatest Hits compilation in 1988 was the final commercially released 8-track. There were some easy listening collections released by Readers Digest in the following year, but good luck finding another 8-track from a big-name act after Fleetwood Mac.

#### DANDELIONS!

YES, it's that time of year again - DANDELIONS! Here'a s few fun facts we gathered up on these little yellow balls of sunshine..

- 🌞 The dandelion flower wakes up and opens during the day and closes at night to sleep.
- ☀ All parts of the dandelion are beneficial root, leaves and flower can be used for food, it has medicinal properties and can be made into stains or dyes for coloring. Some edible examples are dandelion wine and salads. The roots can be used as an element in root beer or dried and ground to make a coffee substitute.
- ☀ Before the 1800's, people actually removed grass from their lawns to make room for dandelions and other useful weeds like chickweed and chamomile. Times have changed, people now consider dandelions a pest and spending millions on pesticides to have uniform lawns every year.
- ★ An average person can recognize thousands of marketing logos but only can recognize less than five plants that grow in their area. The dandelion is the most common named plant on that list.
- The name "dandelion" comes from the French word "dent de lion" which means "lion tooth", describing its coarsely toothed leaves.
- ☀ Notice how they just pop right back up when you mow over them? Dandelions have one of the longest flowering seasons of any plant.
- Remember blowing the puffs of cotton as a child making a wish? Ever hear the folk tale that the dandelion seeds will carry your thoughts and dreams to loves ones? Truth be told, those seeds are carried as far as 5 miles... but not so much help making dreams come true.

### 2018 Tax Filing Season

People have until Tuesday, April 17, 2018, to file their 2017 returns and pay any taxes due. The filing tax deadline is later this year due to several factors. The usual April 15 deadline falls on Sunday this year, which would normally give taxpayers until at least the following Monday. However, Emancipation Day, a Washington, D.C., holiday, is observed on Monday, April 16. giving taxpavers nationwide an additional day to file. By law, Washington holidays impact tax deadlines for everyone in

the same way federal holidays do. Taxpayers requesting an extension will have until Monday, Oct. 15, 2018, to file.


