
The children in Rowandale Community Playgroup have been having lots of Autumn fun. They have been exploring the sights, smells, colours, textures and tastes of Autumn.






Maths Week












The whole school celebrated Maths Week in October, taking part in lots of fun activities and proving that Maths really is fun!

There was lots of measuring, counting, playing, fun challenges and much more.



Spooky, scary skeletons send shivers down your spine!


Moira Presbyterian Hall was the venue. Hallowe'en was the theme. It was the end of term disco!
