We Believe

That God is the Creator and Sustainer of all that is, and that He is loving and good. That the three Persons – God the Father, the Ancient of Days; Jesus Christ, the Son of God and the Holy Spirit and Comforter – are eternally one in character and purpose.

That God reveals Himself in nature, history, the Bible, the witness of the Holy Spirit, the ministry of prophets, and especially through the life of Jesus Christ in this world.

That man was created “in the image of God,” free to choose either to respond in faith and love to the truth about God, or to reject it. As a creature, he is fully dependent upon God for his existence and salvation.

That salvation comes through Jesus Christ when man freely accepts Christ's death on the cross as paying the penalty for his rebellion and sins, and as he cooperates with the transforming power of the Holy Spirit working inside him. In this experience, man enters into a personal faith-based relationship with Jesus for healing and restoration. This power comes through Christ's present ministry in heaven, and is evident in Christ-like interests and behavior.

That man is mortal and that in death he sleeps in the grave until the resurrection at the Second Coming of Christ. Then the gift of immortality will be given to all who have put their trust in Him, and that 1,000 years later the wicked will be resurrected to receive their reward of eternal death. Man, himself a unity of body, mind, and spirit, possesses no existence apart from his body. The body is to be treated with the respect due its Creator. The fullness of human life is achieved when, by the grace of God, all men obey His physical, mental, and moral laws.

That the Ten Commandments are grounded in love – a revelation of God's character. They are the explicit expression of His will to man, His standard of judgment.

That the Seventh-day Sabbath was made and blessed by God as a symbol of His creative power and sovereignty, and has been designated as a sign of His redeeming and sanctifying power to be kept sacred by all who claim Him as Lord and Savior.

That God's church is the major means by which He maintains His unity with His people and they with each other. This involves defined membership, symbols of commitment in baptism by immersion, participation in the Lord's supper, personal involvement in worship, study, witness, and financial support for her mission through returning of tithes and free will offerings.

That the Three Angels' Messages of Revelation 14:6-12 constitute the last warning message to the world, reminding men of the character of God.

That the redemptive process will come to its climax at the end of time with the Second Coming of Christ, which is imminent, and will be completed when the whole creation is again in perfect harmony with the Creator.
