

DEAR FRIENDS

Thank you for another wonderful year in conservation!

This past year brought some big changes to the Land Trust, as we welcomed two fantastic new staff members: Aaron Rusak and Eleanor Proctor. Eleanor jumped into her role as Land Procurement Assistant with great enthusiasm, going above and beyond in her outreach to new land donors, ecosystem mapping, and assistance with our summer fieldwork. Aaron's passion for Georgian Bay's flora and fauna has been evident in all aspects of his work as Protected Areas Manager, as he has revamped species inventories across our properties, led fascinating nature walks, and spearheaded new bird research projects.

We were delighted to add five new protected places to our network in 2022, totalling 142 acres of habitat that is now conserved forever. The owners of these properties deserve our utmost thanks for choosing conservation and leaving this natural legacy for the entire Georgian Bay community.

We were also happy to continue several important partnerships and projects this past year. Our work on the Maamwi Anjiakiziwin initiative alongside the Georgian Bay Biosphere, Shawanaga and Magnetawan First Nations, and others is making significant strides on a community-wide approach to species at risk conservation. We had another busy year of our research partnership with scientists from Western

University, studying the movement ecology of songbirds using our Motus telemetry stations. Our Executive Director Bill Lougheed has been diligently working with partners behind the scenes on several important large-scale land protection projects, which we hope will come to fruition at some point in 2023. And we were pleased to begin work on a significant grant from the Ontario Trillium Foundation, which is expanding our outreach capacity to landowners, and will hopefully result in increased conservation of ecologically significant land.

We are so grateful to all of you whose support makes this work possible. The Land Trust is a community of volunteers, advocates, donors, and nature lovers, and we could not do our work without you.

Here's to another fantastic summer on Georgian Bay!

PLAN

Using science to identify and prioritize key habitats for conservation so that species are protected and our coastal ecosystem remains resilient

SPECIES HABITAT AND THREAT MAPPING

After two years of work mapping our new Natural Area Conservation Plan, we are now working on mapping the preferred habitats for our area's 50 species at risk. When complete, these maps are intended to show the specific locations of each species' preferred habitat across the Georgian Bay landscape. This modelling uses certain assumptions that will need ground-truthing to confirm the accuracy and reliability of the model for each species. This on-the-ground verification will be incorporated as feedback into the model. Eventually this approach may allow accurate mapping of the location of habitats crucial to the conservation of each species at risk.



LANDOWNER OUTREACH

We were happy to enter year two of our Ontario Trillium Foundation grant, which has allowed us to enhance our outreach to priority landowners. This is an ongoing effort to accelerate the permanent protection of large and ecologically significant tracts of land, including forests and wetlands. We have reached out to several hundred property owners who own lands ranked high in our Natural Area Conservation Plan, based on a series of targets including biodiversity, habitat quality and connectivity, and at-risk species. The Trillium Foundation grant has also enabled staff support for our large landscape corridor project which we hope to announce in 2023.


ALLIANCE OF CANADIAN LAND TRUSTS

The new Alliance of Canadian Land Trusts is off to a wonderful start, helping to assist land trusts across Canada in securing more funding for conservation planning and the creation of new protected areas. Our Executive Director Bill Lougheed played a key role in establishing the Alliance, and now sits on the board as an advisor. This national body will be invaluable to our land trust in providing funding for our big landscape projects and our work in planning those projects. We were delighted to attend the first national summit hosted by the Alliance this past October.



PROTECT

Securing ecologically significant lands to protect habitats and species and to create open spaces for community enjoyment

3,500 feet of natural shoreline are protected by this wonderful easement, Otter Lake's first protected area. Inland, the property contains a wide variety of large old trees, three streams, and a one-acre swamp.

6.5 ACRES SANS SOUCI

This easement protects part of an island in Sans Souci that consists mainly of treed rock barren. It provides critical habitat for several at-risk species, which would suffer greatly were the property to be developed.

The Kennedy Islands are classic Georgian Bay rock and pine, beloved not only by humans but by birds, turtles, and snakes as well. Conserving them helps protect the ecological integrity of the 50-island archipelago of which they are a part.

STEWARD

Working alongside communities to monitor and maintain wilderness lands forever



VOLUNTEER STEWARDS & CONSERVATION INTERNS

The backbone of our stewardship program is our Volunteer Stewards and Summer Conservation Interns. Last year they completed 181 monitoring visits to our protected properties, and conducted stewardship tasks including invasive species removal, garbage cleanup, sign and Motus tower repair, species at risk reporting, and public outreach.





PHRAGMITES REMOVAL

Our efforts to keep our protected properties and surrounding areas free of invasive Phragmites continued in 2022. This is a project that requires annual monitoring and effort, as new patches spring up, and some existing patches regrow. However, we are pleased to see progress in terms of reduced or eliminated growth at multiple sites, and to have contained the spread to within manageable levels.

PROPERTY INVENTORIES

2022's biggest stewardship task was the systematic re-inventorying of our properties initiated by our new Protected Areas Manager, Aaron Rusak. Throughout the spring, summer, and fall, Aaron visited the majority of our conservation areas and made detailed lists of all the plant and animal species found on each one. These lists give us a snapshot of the current state of each property, which we can compare with past and future lists to track changes over time. They answer questions like: are invasive species spreading? Are at-risk species appearing or disappearing on particular properties? How are habitats changing, and what impact does this have on animal life? All of this information will help us make the best possible stewardship plans for each property, and identify any problems that need addressing.

LEARN

Advancing scientific knowledge by collaborating with academic partners and using our properties to support research in the biosphere



BIRD MOVEMENT RESEARCH WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF WESTERN ONTARIO

This was our second year welcoming scientists from the University of Western Ontario to study bird behaviour on our properties. The scientists tagged and banded a number of species, and tracked their movements in order to determine which Georgian Bay habitats they make use of during the post-nesting season.



MOTUS WILDLIFE TRACKING PROGRAM WITH BIRD STUDIES CANADA AND COMMUNITY PARTNERS

Our nine Motus wildlife tracking stations continued to collect important data on bird movements from Port Severn to Pointe au Baril. These towers have tracked birds tagged by scientists on the western and southern sides of the continent, contributing to international research.



BAT MONITORING WITH ONTARIO LAND TRUST ALLIANCE (OLTA)

We continued our collaboration with OLTA to track the abundance of bats on our properties by recording their calls through automated passive recorders. Four of Georgian Bay's bat species are designated at-risk, and understanding their distribution and habitat use is an important part of conservation.



JEFFERSON SALAMANDER RESEARCH WITH MCMASTER UNIVERSITY

For the first time, we welcomed students from McMaster to our properties to conduct research on water quality and salamander populations. The students took water samples from wetlands and vernal pools, which they then analyzed for Jefferson salamander DNA. This is part of region-wide research to determine where this endangered salamander is breeding, and thus identify key sites for conservation.

INSPIRE

Bringing communities together and cultivating the next generation of conservationists that will protect our land and species




We loved welcoming people to our protected properties for staff-led **NATURE WALKS**, where we could together explore the amazing flora and fauna around us.

We were delighted to host a screening of **THREE WATERS**, an inspiring documentary about a father-daughter paddling and microplastic sampling expedition along the coast of Georgian Bay, which was supported by our **KING FAMILY BURSARY**.



2000+ visitors enjoyed our conservation properties in the ways they love best: picnicking, hiking, swimming, paddling, and more.




