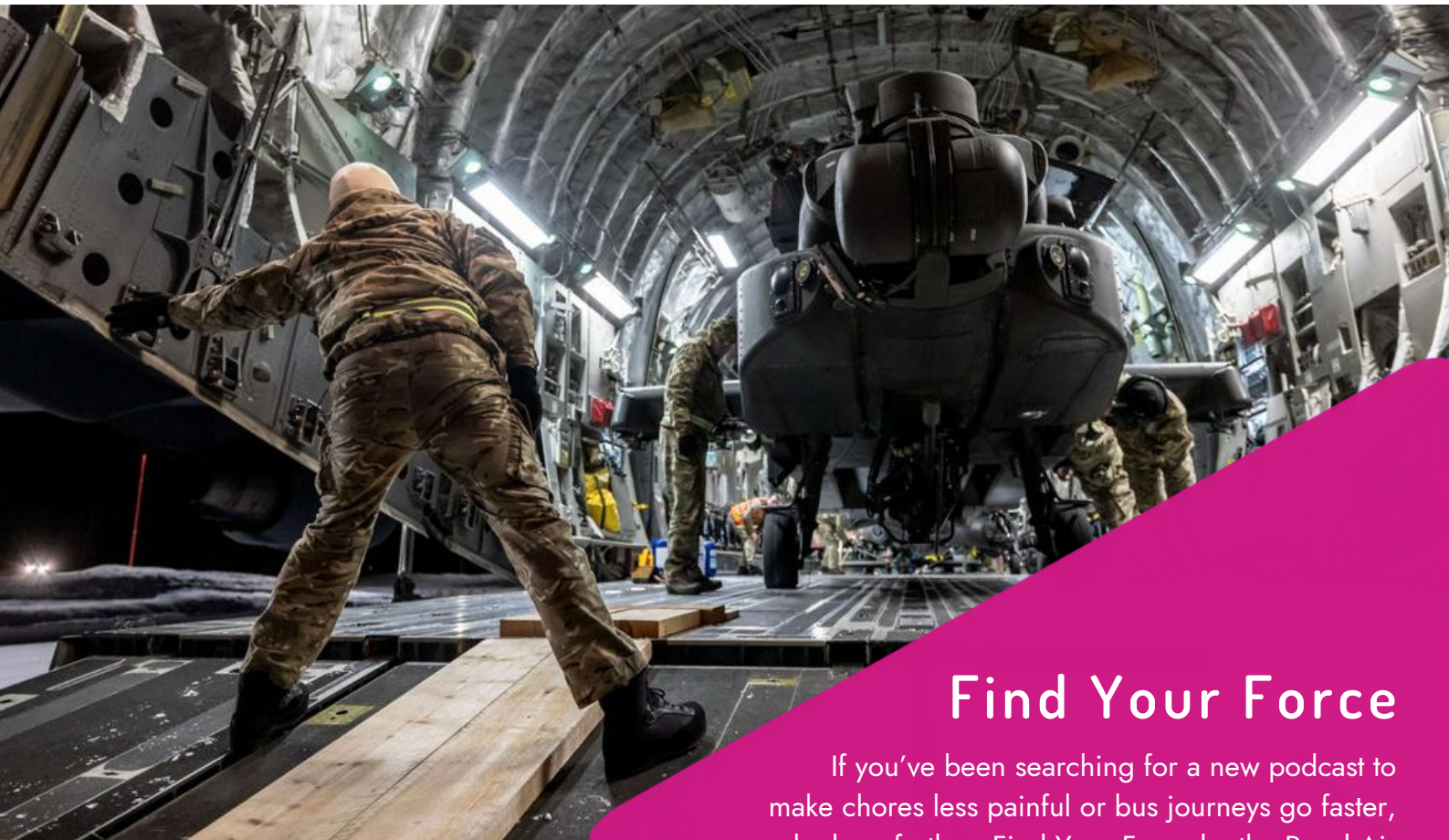
Bucks Skills Show ready?
