Sitting relaxed in a restaurant enjoying delicious food, unique ambiance and lively conversation is something most everyone took for granted before the outbreak of COVID-19.

"Restaurants represent the all-important 'third place' (after home and work) where people can congregate, socialize and break bread (or fresh, local seafood!) together," said Grant Jones, the director of business development for Greater Grays Harbor, Inc.

"The cultural, communal and mental health benefits are real and this pandemic is shining a light on the critical role these establishments play in our community," he said.

While now allowed to be open at 50 percent capacity (as of press time), eating establishments are still struggling financially here, threatening the cultural richness and diversity of living in Grays Harbor.

The restaurant industry has been hit particularly hard by the pandemic, Jones said, citing a recent survey Greater Grays Harbor Inc., conducted that indicated 92 percent of restaurants in Grays Harbor reported revenue decreases and 32 percent predict significant long-term staff reductions. "This sector is also reporting the highest likelihood

of permanent closure due to the pandemic, with 29 percent reporting they are at least 'somewhat likely' to close permanently," Jones said.

"We've seen closures, but we've also seen restaurants find success in embracing the new reality and making take-out service a core part of their business. We've also seen some business take some time to step back and reevaluate their businesses more broadly in order to make some difficult decisions and emerge stronger and more competitive upon reopening," Jones said.

So, just like other creative folks, many in the restaurant business on the Harbor have used ingenuity to survive – and sometimes even thrive – during this time. In addition, the good news is that it may not be too late to help save many of the struggling restaurants on the Harbor – and enjoy doing it!

"Grab take-out and meet up with your friends for a socially distanced al fresco meal," suggested Jones. "If restaurants offer gift cards, buy them. This helps them with their cash flow and helps you get your holiday shopping done early!" he said.





ive entertainment may have been on hold during the past five months, but many of Grays Harbor's theater groups have found ways to perform anyway. In addition, plans are in the works for the curtain to rise once again on local theater.

One group that forged ahead is the new Aberdeen Shakespearean Theatre company. This summer the troupe performed "Fun with Shakespeare in the Park," in McCleary. Unfortunately, just at press time, the performances set for late July and August in Elma, Aberdeen and Westport had to be cancelled because of new coronavirus guidelines.

In the show earlier this summer, the

considering a remote musical revue, with individual performers singing mostly solos, pre-recorded. It's far from the ideal scenario, but I hope we can find redeeming moments of humanity, hope and connection within and across the digital divide."

While the 7th Street Kids' performance of Stephen Sondheim's musical "Into the Woods" had to be postponed until the summer of 2021, director Julayne Fleury recently began "Zoomsicals" through the new 7th Street Online format using Zoom, a web-based video conferencing tool. She says that the online venture is keeping kids connected and going even better than she thought it would: "I'm pleasantly surprised with that!"


The Driftwood Players in Aberdeen are delaying their production of "The Wedding Singer" until next year, according to director Alex

Eddy. Meanwhile, he says the board is considering what they might offer online.

And all over Grays Harbor, creatives are making plans for real curtains to rise again. Throughout the state, theaters, in cooperation with the Washington State Arts Commission and other arts organizations, have drafted and approved a Reopening Plan. The plan, which was approved in June, takes into account the Governor's current phase criteria and allows for theaters located in counties that are in Phase 3 or 4 to reopen at 50 percent capacity under stringent guidelines. # Many Harbor artists find time in quarantine

Time spent in quarantine because of the novel coronavirus has affected Grays Harbor artists in a variety of ways. Many have become profusely productive, using the extra solitude to experiment with new mediums or create art at an unprecedented rate. For others, the resulting economics have been a hardship, with loss of income and even closure of some area galleries.

"January and February were the best two months we've ever had," said Douglas Orr, director of the Aberdeen Art Center, in which his 2,500-square-foot Alder Grove Gallery is the anchor tenant. "Then we were closed and had the worst two months we've ever had. We opened up again in June and kind of got back to even better than before. However, it did adversely affect other tenants in the building. One artist studio folded and a video company also left."

With 168 different Grays Harbor artists represented in the gallery, Orr said he's aware of some who were too depressed to work during this time, and others – such as oil painter Lora Malakoff – whose productivity and sales are "going through

the roof."The gallery is now open noon to 6 p.m. Thursday through Monday.

At Opal Art Glass in Cosmopolis, the temporary shutdown of the gallery caused stress to owners Johnny and Darlene Camp. "We were worried about how we were going to pay our bills. It has been a real struggle because there is really no help for micro business," said Johnny Camp.

On the positive side, they've spent time working on a website that will include a new shopping feature. They have also blown glass for commissioned and memorial orders. The gallery is back open from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday and 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturdays.

For renowned mosaic artist, Jennifer

Kuhns of Porter, the extra time to work was a blessing, but unfortunately the timing forced the cancellation of a fundraising event that Westport businesses had organized to help finance a 5- by 7-foot community mural to be installed on the outside of Stitches by the Beach, a quilt shop overlooking the marina.

"I had led two 'mosaic party' events where participants made quilt-style squares (but with stained glass and tile) and I had completed a large Mariner's Compass for the center panel, so we were halfway done with the fabrication," Kuhns said.

"The mural has been stored in my studio and some volunteers have continued work on the outside squares, each of which features an element that represents Westport, such as a lighthouse, anchor, whale, etc. But to complete and install the mural and make a donor plaque we need to raise at least another \$2,500," she said.

During this time she was also working on a project for Tigard, Oregon. "I had just transported basalt boulders to my driveway and found a stone carver from Tenino to collaborate with me when the pandemic hit. Ed Salerno spent a couple of weeks carving inlays into the seven boulders, and I filled them with stained glass mosaic over the next few months. Since all of my classes were cancelled, I was able to relax and focus on that project, along with three concrete benches I was

working on for the City of Auburn.

The cancellation of her spring workshops caused her to become creative with her teaching methods. "I decided to offer them as online classes. I learned to use Zoom, invested in some software and equipment, and had e-commerce added to my website where students can easily enroll in the workshops. This turned out to be an amazing new experience! Even when

online classes will still be part of my practice," Kuhns said.

Artists Ken and Vicki Mitchell of Cosmopolis, have responded to this time a bit differently. While Ken, a retired art teacher from Aberdeen's Harbor High School, pursued some artistic endeavors and conducted research for historical paintings, his focus has been more on the couple's flowers and garden.

Vicki, however, has produced a plethora of art. Her work included finishing 20 illustrations for essays she's written, painting postcards, completing a coloring book for Harpers Ferry National Historic Park, and creating miniature papier-mâché hats from different historical periods using materials she found at home. She also painted pictures on hymnal pages to give to her mother, who has dementia and lives in a nursing home but can still recall the old hymns.

"One of the reasons I've done so much is that I had an opportunity of time that I haven't had for forever. The other part was to keep my brain active and to thwart my grief of not being able to see my family."

Both Ken and Vicki took on a special

request during this time - each creating a coloring page depicting a fairy riding a unicorn for their 4-year-old granddaughter, who promises more similar commissions.

When the quarantine began, Abe Singer, a Montesano artist who specializes in metal sculpture, was in the middle of a large commission, "Metamorphosis" for the City of Covington.

even beyond the Harbor. We even made it on the King 5 News," she said.



For Ian and Joy Dorsch, directors of the **Grays Harbor College Opera Workshop**, the coronavirus quarantine meant they had to cancel their spring show. However, the couple used their time well, planning a series of three video performances, which are available on the Grays Harbor College's Bishop Center's YouTube channel as well as the GHCOW Facebook page.

"The video is a roughly six-minute chunk of the opening of 'The Gondoliers,' " said Ian Dorsch. "It features Kira Theine on piano, a chorus of around 20 singers, and quite a few soloists from the group (in order of appearance: Carlos Cruz, Emma Dorsch, Aliss Barre, Eric Beard, Jeff Beard, McKenna Hansen, Evan Weidman and Jax Eaton). Everyone is singing by themselves in their own homes, so it's not staged in any traditional sense, but I think we're all pleased with how it's come out."

So even while music may not be live in Grays Harbor during these unprecedented times, the creative spirit is still very much alive!

#### Finding Native American Public Art in Grays Harbor Area

The Native American heritage is alive and well in our area. That rich history of local tribes can be enjoyed for free if you know where to look. These seven pieces are spread throughout the area so just about anywhere you want to explore you can discover fine works of Native American art.

**"Kape Jiluupak" mural,** Morck Building, 215 South K Street, Aberdeen — Painted by Guy Capoeman and his son Cecil, the mural shows the Thunderbird grabbing a whale under an arch, depicting a famous legend. The sun design on top shows the face of Iskwalusis, or "Bright Sun," an ancient name from oral tribal history.

# **The Chehalis River Bridge Totems,** Aberdeen — Across from Swanson's grocery store in South

Aberdeen along the side of the Chehalis River are two vibrant totems with an equally colorful past. The original carver was a member of the Quinault Tribe named "Circus Jimmy," who died in 1929. In addition to his carving, Circus Jimmy was well known around the Harbor as a weather forecaster, invoking native signs to make his very accurate predictions. These totems were carved to tell the story of tribal gods. The totems have been restored in recent years by Bob Torgerson.

Carved Sign, Memorial Park, Taholah — This sign carved by Joe DeLaCruz, who was the Quinault Tribe's president for 22 years, celebrates the treaty signed July 1, 1855, between the U.S. and the Quinault, Quileute, Queets and Hoh tribes. Tootie James from the Quinault Tribal Museum writes, "Every year the week of the 4th of July we have a celebration called Chief Taholah Days. On the date of the picture on July 4, 2005, we held a big ceremony to commemorate 150 years." This sign is a beautiful example of the "Coast Salish" style of figurative art in which shamanic and spirit figures are often depicted.
