Today, we turn the spotlight on three of our own to celebrate several truly fantastic club milestones: Kyran McManus's 100th appearance for Barnstaple which began 9 years ago, making his debut with the Chiefs on October 21st, 2017, in a 15-6 victory against London Irish Wild Geese.

Josh Hill also celebrates his centenary with his first game at the beginning of the 2019 season at Cullompton. As for Luke Knight well he has been a picture of consistency notching up a century and a half following his first appearance for Barnstaple against Crediton in 2015.

On behalf of everyone at Barnstaple Rugby Club—players, coaches, staff, and supporters—we say a massive Congratulations, Kyran, Josh and Luke! Well done on this incredible achievement. Here's to the next tackle, the next carry, and to **many, many more appearances to come!

It has been too long since Athletic last graced our main pitch, especially with the last fortnight games against Newton Abbot and St. Ives Postponed due to the pitch conditions, That absence hasn't helped their cause, as they come into today without a win in their last four outings—agonisingly losing three of those by three points or less, and a fortnight ago battling to a draw on the less forgiving second pitch.

Today, however, offers Athletic the perfect opportunity to right those wrongs. Stepping out onto the main stage, they are ready to reignite their season.

Today's opponents, Newton Abbot, arrive just ahead of Athletic

in 7th place, a mere three points separating the sides. The visitors have six wins to Athletic's four, but their recent form has also been patchy, with just two wins in five. Notably, Newton Abbot are yet to win on the road this season—a statistic that will give Athletic genuine belief as they seek to get their campaign back on track.

Athletic can also draw confidence from having already won at Newton Abbot back in October, scoring five tries in a spirited 24-30 victory. That said, now is the moment for this side to rediscover how to close games out. The memory their last game, a home draw with Torquay, where a commanding 17-0 lead was squandered to finish 17-17, will still be fresh, and today presents the chance to apply those hard-learned lessons.

This is a crucial fixture for both clubs. In a tightly packed bottom half of the table, six points separate 6th from 10th place and every point is precious. Both teams will be desperate to establish a stronger footing and build momentum for the run-in.

Young Chiefs' Valiant Effort Undone as Cinderford's Late Surge Secures Victory



Without a win in 2026 and facing a daunting trip up the M5, the enormity of the task was clear for the Barnstaple Chiefs. Their destination was Cinderford, a fortress where the hosts had only lost to Camborne and Taunton this season. Compounding the challenge, the Chiefs fielded their youngest side of the campaign, ravaged by injuries and featuring a bold injection of youth. Five players were under 20, including senior Colts Oscar Lambert and Noah Bazley, who made their Barnstaple Chiefs and National League debuts alongside fellow Colt Jack Sparrow in only his third game for the Chiefs. They were joined by 19-year-old regulars like last season's Colts captain Max Moore and the ever-present Henry Sellick. Only the experienced Ben Hilton provided a contrast to the youthful lineup, as the injury crisis biting deep into the Chiefs' reserves accelerated the emergence of promising talent from the Colts system.

Defying their recent slow starts, Barnstaple exploded from the blocks with a vibrant, youth-driven energy, scoring twice within seven breathtaking minutes. First, swift hands created space, and from a ruck near the Cinderford 22, JP popped to Cam Johnson, who sliced through a sliver of a gap to race clear under the posts. Shortly after, Johnson again pierced the defence on the left, speeding into the home half before drawing his man and offloading to Henry Sellick for a simple run-in. Jake Murphy's ⁴ conversion made it 0-12, stunning the home support.

The scoreline served as a sharp wake-up call for Cinderford, who responded with characteristic power, scoring three tries in just five minutes to seize a 19-12 lead. For those following on the supporters' WhatsApp group, it was a frenetic and chaotic opening quarter.

Undaunted, the Chiefs displayed their resilience to draw level in the 25th minute through individual brilliance. After a barnstorming carry from Dominic Robson broke into Cinderford territory, Jordan Petherbridge spotted a gap, sprinted through it, and then deftly chipped over the advancing defence, regathering to score. The half closed at 19-19, a fair reflection of a thrilling and unpredictable opening period.

The second half began this time with Cinderford striking quickly to retake the lead. Yet again, Barnstaple hit back; Ben Parsons, replicating his heroics from the previous weekend, intercepted a wayward pass on the halfway line and raced away to score, narrowing the gap to 26-24. A similarly tense and tight finish seemed inevitable.

However, the Chiefs could not add to their tally in the final quarter. As the game stretched, Cinderford's experience and bench strength told, as they ran in three further tries in the last 20 minutes to secure a 41-24 victory, ultimately taking full control of the contest's decisive phase.

Despite the defeat, the performance was a hugely promising effort from a patched-up, youthful Chiefs side. The sheer scale of the injury crisis is stark, with the entire pack almost completely changed from the regular starters of the season's first three

months, including absent front-row stalwarts Callum Davies and Bertie Stretch. While the backline has seen more stability, the disruption has been significant.

The positives, however, shine brightly. The debutant Colts, Oscar Lambert and Noah Bazley, who entered the fray on the hour mark, acquitted themselves superbly, as did Jack Sparrow and Max Moore. Their successful step-up speaks volumes about the health of the club's pathway and bodes well for the future.

The Chiefs now gratefully welcome a weekend of rest before the visit of second-placed Luctonians on the 14th. The break offers a crucial chance for recovery, with hopes high that several key players will return to fitness. This performance, in the face of such adversity, proves the depth of spirit and talent at Pottington Road, offering genuine optimism for the challenges ahead.

A Tale of Two Halves: Barnstaple Athletic Let Slip Commanding Lead in Last-Second Heartbreaker



Barnstaple Athletic were left to endure a hauntingly familiar nightmare last time out, surrendering a dominant 17-0 half-time advantage to a resilient Torquay side, who snatched a 17-17 draw with the final play of the game—a devastating script that has become all too common for the Athletic faithful this season.

The first half was a masterclass in control and execution. From the opening whistle, Athletic played with an intensity and precision that Torquay simply couldn't match. The forwards laid a formidable platform, and the backs capitalised with ruthless efficiency. A blistering opening twenty minutes saw tries from Max Campbell, Max Moore, and Josh Hill, with Kyran McManus adding the extras on the third. At 17-0, Athletic didn't just lead; they had comprehensively dismantled their opponents, heading into the break with the game seemingly in the bag.

However, the second half unfolded as a painful echo of recent weeks, exposing a critical vulnerability in closing out matches. The fluidity and aggression that defined the first 40 minutes evaporated. Torquay, with their pride stung, grew in belief as Athletic's play became increasingly passive and error-prone. The visitors gradually wrestled away momentum, crossing for two tries to claw their way back to within a single score.

As the clock ticked into the final minute with Athletic clinging to a precarious 17-12 lead, the spectre of previous collapses loomed large. And, in a moment of crushing déjà vu, it materialised. Torquay launched one last desperate assault, and with the final play of the contest, they breached the exhausted Athletic defence to score in the corner. The subsequent missed conversion offered only the coldest of comforts, sparing Athletic a total defeat but doing little to soothe the sting of another opportunity catastrophically squandered.

The result leaves more than just two points on the table; it leaves profound psychological questions. While the first-half performance proved the squad's undeniable quality and attacking potency, the second-half capitulation revealed a troubling pattern of game management and defensive resilience under pressure. For Athletic transforming commanding positions into secure victories is the non-negotiable next step.

The challenge for Athletic now is to convert this bitter frustration into a decisive lesson. They must learn to marry their undoubted attacking flair with the ruthless, game-killing mentality of champions. Until they solve this second-half puzzle, they risk seeing a promising season defined by near misses and last-gasp heartbreak.
