
















DAY 5 - Thursday | 20th November 2025

After breakfast, head to Bimmah Sinkhole for a photo stop. The sinkhole is a natural limestone depression filled with turquoise water, often described as a geological wonder. It's a perfect spot for photos and a brief exploration, offering a glimpse of Oman's natural beauty.

Reach Wadi Tiwi. This lush wadi, located in the Al Sharqiyah region, is known for its emerald pools, tropical plantations and stunning rock formations, offering a refreshing escape into nature.

Upon arrival, you'll take a short hike through the banana plantations and the serene setting of the traditional falaj (water channels), surrounded by vibrant greenery. Soon, you'll reach the first of many crystal-clear pools, perfect for jumping in and swimming. The turquoise waters are both refreshing and inviting, providing the perfect playground for a few hours of fun.

Scramble over unique rock formations, swim through emerald pools, and explore hidden canyons that lead to the traditional Mibam village. Helmets and buoyancy aids will be provided for this trip. After emerging from the wadi, enjoy a well-deserved lunch at a local restaurant, where you can savor Omani flavours.









DAY 6 - Continued...

Drive down to Wahiba Sands, the golden sand dunes desert of Oman. This magnificent expanse of golden dunes stretches 200 km long and 100 km wide, extending all the way to the Arabian Sea. Steeped in history, these dunes have been home to the Bedouin people for over 7,000 years.

Experience a unique piece of driving through the iconic reddish and golden dunes until you reach your hotel for the night.

You have the option to book thrilling activities such as dune bashing, UTV buggies or camel riding on the spot (not included).

As evening falls, enjoy dinner at the 3 star hotel Golden Palm Oasis and relax in the serenity of the desert.




















DAY 9 - Monday | 24th November 2025

The trail leads to the abondoned village of Sab Bani Khamis, a hidden relic nestled in the mountainside, showcasing Oman's ancient history. For those seeking an extra challenge, you can continue hiking to discover a hidden lake, a secluded oasis amidst the rugged terrain.

After soaking in the views and tranquility, retrace your steps back along the trail to the waiting vehicles. This hike's combination of thrill and serenity, along with the stunning landscapes, makes it an unforgettable experience for outdoor enthusiasts.

Its cooler climate and fertile soil create an oasis of greenery, where pomegranates, roses, and walnuts flourish, providing a stark contrast to Oman's desert surroundings.

Make your way to 3 star Green View Hotel for check-in, where you'll unwind for the night and you can have free time to stroll around, enjoy the hotel's facilities and have dinner at a restaurant of your choice in the area.

Begin your journey back towards Muscat, stopping at another iconic village, Birkat Al Mouz. Enjoy a leisurely walk in this renowned ruined village of the Sultanate, featuring vast banana plantations and picturesque surroundings. You will admire the falaj, a traditional irrigation canal that is still in use and classified as a UNESCO World Heritage site. This brief stop will transport you back in time.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

Imigration

Citizens of EU, US, Canada nations can obtain visa on arrival free of charge for stays up to 14 days. For longer stays, online visas are available and cover one month stays, renewable for an extra month. For the complete list of visa regulations please visit: https://evisa.rop.gov.om/

Currency

The national currency of Oman is Omani Riyal (OMR.) International ATM machines are available at the airport and throughout the capital city of Muscat and minor cities.

SIM Cards & Mobile Services

Omantel, Ooredoo, and Vodafone kiosks for SIMS are available upon arrival at the airport in the arrivals section

Alcohol

Alcoholic beverages are available at the bars and restaurants of most 5 star hotels in Oman. You can also purchase up to 4 liters of alcohol upon arrival from the duty-free liquor section at the airport.

Dress Code:

You can wear a bikini at private beaches in 5 star hotels and resorts. In public places it is advised to wear clothing that covers your knees and shoulders, but short sleeves t-shirts, knee length shorts, leggings are permissible. In places of religious significance such as the mosque, women must cover all parts of their body including their hair and men must wear long pants and shirts.
