CARE & CLEANING



RUGS VOGUE recommends only the use of Dr. Beckmanin Rug Cleaner or other compatible RUG Cleaner for the cleaning of all rugs. The cleaning process should involve applying the Dr. Beckmanin with a soft bristle brush, rinsing the water, and extracting with a vacuum or extractor. The rug should then be dried by air or low temperature hair dryer.

*If Dr. Beckmanin not available use your normal dish soup cleaner.

- *Some stains are so complex that someone with knowledge of textile chemistry should treat them. Don't wait for annual cleaning. It may be too late to remove the stain.

Note: Almost all spills are removed by either dry cleaning uid (follow manufacturer's instructions) or a simple solution of one teaspoon of mild detergent with one teaspoon of white vinegar in a quart of warm water. Always mix vinegar with warm water for best results.
