The Mentone Campus Development Committee invites you to an open discussion regarding the future of our church facilities.

We will be exploring several options for our church campus and how we can best utilize our facilities until Jesus returns. We have prepared a poll with five construction options for your consideration. Following a brief presentation and open discussion, we will ask you to complete the poll to help guide the future development of our church.

Church Construction Options:

- New Campus Construction: Demolish the existing sanctuary, classrooms, fellowship hall, and kitchen, replacing them with new structures. This option would require temporary relocation during construction.
- 2. **Multi-Purpose Building Construction:** Build a new multipurpose building on the vacant lot, including a fellowship space, kitchen, and classrooms.
- 3. **Fellowship Hall Renovation & Parking Lot Expansion:** Renovate the existing fellowship hall, kitchen, and Pathfinder room into a multi-purpose building. This option also includes developing the vacant lot into a parking area.
- 4. **Maintain Existing Property:** Maintain and upgrade the existing property with no major additions or renovations to the buildings.
- 5. **Relocation to a New Campus:** Sell the existing campus and purchase property to build a new church.
