Valentine's Day Recipe



LOVE BUGS BISCUITS



These chocolate cookies are great fun to make and are delicious!

INGREDIENTS:

- 50g Soft Butter
- 50g Caster Sugar
- 15g Beaten Egg
- 85g Plain Flour
- 15g Cocoa Powder

FILLING

- 15g Chocolate Chips
- 25g Soft Butter
- 40g Icing Sugar
- 15g Soft Brown Sugar
- 5g Cocoa Powder

DECORATION

- 50g Icing Sugar
- Red Food Colour

Sugar Eyes & Sprinkles

TUTORIAL:

1. Put butter and caster sugar in a bowl & beat together until just creamy.
2. Pour in the beaten egg and combine. Then add the flour & cocoa powder and mix into a ball of dough.
3. Wrap in cling-film and refrigerate for 1 hour.
4. Gently knead on a floured surface. Using a rolling pin, roll out the dough to an even thickness of about 5-7mm.
5. Use a heart shape cutter to cut out 12-14 biscuits.
6. Place your biscuits on a baking tray lined with greaseproof paper. Chill in the fridge for 30 mins. Preheat the oven to 180°C/160°C fan/gas 4.
7. Bake for 12-15 minutes, turning halfway. Leave to cool.
8. Meanwhile, make the chocolate filling. Melt the chocolate chips in sealed bag in a mug of hot water. Put the butter in a bowl and beat until soft and creamy. Add the icing sugar and brown sugar, mixing until fluffy. Add the cocoa powder and melted chocolate & stir.
9. Spread the filling on a heart. Pop a heart on top. Repeat.
10. Mix icing sugar with cold water until toothpaste consistency. Add red colouring to desired shade. Pipe onto each cookie to make wings. Stick on eyes with icing, add sprinkles. Leave to harden and enjoy!

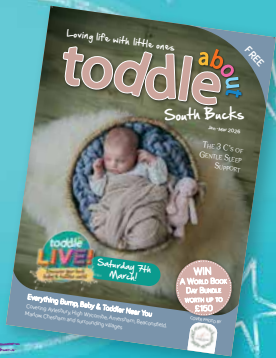

BRAINSTORM HALFTOYS WORLD SET

The Halftoys World Set is a hands-on, educational playset featuring magnetic 3D sea animal puzzles and a buildable ocean habitat – perfect for imaginative, STEM-inspired play. £50 from good toy shops.

The Brainstorm Halftoys World Set is an imaginative, educational, hands-on activity for children – and we absolutely loved it! From the moment we opened the box, we were drawn in by the vibrant colours and detailed 'Ocean World' design. With five 3D sea animal puzzles to build, my 4-year-old eagerly matched the magnetic skeleton pieces to their animal bodies – no reading needed!

We then tackled the main feature: the Ocean Habitat. A little fiddly for small hands, we built the base together. My son then took the lead, enthusiastically assembling the underwater plants and doing a brilliant job.

Once complete, we spent ages role-playing with the scene, taking turns as different animals and creating underwater adventures.

My favourite part is the animal models – simple yet cleverly designed, they click together with magnets, are sturdy, and safe for younger children.

An unexpected bonus? The whole scene folds in half to store the pieces neatly inside – ideal for travel and tidy play.

Overall, this is a fantastic set that encourages creativity, storytelling, and quality time. Some adult help may be needed, but I secretly enjoyed that part!

WHEN YOUR CHILD HASN'T READ THE PARENTING MANUALS

"Who does 'this' belong to?"

"This" was my two-year-old, who was rolling around the floor of Costco having the mother of all meltdowns. "She's mine," I replied. "Well, you'll have to move it – it's a health and safety hazard." Was that the low point in my toddler parenting journey?

Or was it that time we had a stand-off in the street? "Goodbye, then," I said, and set off home, expecting her to relent and follow me. Nope, not my toddler! She sped off in the opposite direction, towards a busy road.

My child was beautiful, joyful, determined. When she was happy, her smile lit up the room. When she wasn't happy, though, everybody knew about it.

I felt like the worst parent ever. Five years later, she was diagnosed with autism and PDA, and everything began to make sense.

My son's journey was challenging in different ways. But both journeys had one thing in common: **no**

roadmap to follow. My lifeline was other parents of children with special needs. We shared information as we figured things out. We mopped each other's tears, and celebrated small wins together.

The 'HUGS' part of **SEND HUGS** stands for Help, Understanding, Guidance and Support – all the things I needed, which were often in short supply.

SEND HUGS aims to:

- **help** you to navigate the system and understand how to help your children;
- offer you the **understanding** that is often lacking as professionals and other parents blame you for your children's problems;
- **guide** you through the process of applying for SEND support in school; and
- **support** you as you adjust to the reality of your situation and sometimes just need a shoulder to cry on.

MAKE POO-DOH!

Crack Potty Training the Fun Way

By Children's Nurse & Potty Learning Expert, Rebecca Mottram



Potty training can feel like one of the trickiest milestones of early childhood, but what if you could turn it into play? Research shows that many parents hit roadblocks such as refusal, anxiety, or difficulty adapting from nappies to the potty. The good news is, there's a playful way through: **Poo-Doh**.

This delightfully fun activity uses homemade play-doh (yes, brown if you like!) to help children explore how their bodies work and teach them the basics of how to manage poo and wee whilst building their confidence.

1. MAKE THE POO-DOH

Children love sensory play with something squishy and hand squeezing activities such as the motion of forming "poo" from dough are also beneficial for their fine motor development.

My favourite is to make it brown, but you can also make glitter poo, rainbow poo, even dinosaur poo! Making the poo gives you a chance to show them what healthy poo should look like.



2. NORMALISE AND TALK ABOUT POO

When you roll and squeeze the poo doh with a bit of humour and giggles, conversations about bodily functions become natural.

You can playfully introduce the character of Mr Poo, who always wants to find his way to Pooland, down the toilet. Using play like this allows children to explore the topic safely and provides a powerful antidote to the pressure they may feel when learning to use the toilet.

Sensory activities like rolling and squeezing dough help children with emotional regulation, helping to create a beneficial learning environment for your child.

3. ROLE-PLAY TO PRACTICE AND BUILD SKILLS

Once you've made your Poo-Doh, you can use it to act out what happens at toilet time: plop poo in the potty, tip it into the loo, flush, and wash hands. Let dolly or teddy have a go too.

Modelling each step gives children structure and predictability; two key ingredients for toileting success. At this stage of development, children live in their imagination so delivering information through play meets them where they are in a child-centred way.

4. A HANDS-ON BIOLOGY LESSON

Make your hand into a fist and gently push the dough through to show how poo moves through the body. Children can see and feel what's happening, helping them recognise those "tummy tickles" as signals to go. Understanding the process reduces fear and builds trust in their bodies.

ANDY'S READING ADVENTURES

by Andy Day



Andy Day, much-loved CBeebies presenter, frontman of *Andy & The Odd Socks* and author of the *Dino Dad* book series, shares how becoming a father has shaped his storytelling, what television taught him about writing for children and why sparking a love of reading is more important than ever.

HOW HAS FATHERHOOD INSPIRED YOUR WRITING?

Becoming a dad has been one of, if not the most, important jobs of my life. I've always loved entertaining children – on screen, on stage and in person – but it's an entirely new level when those children call you 'dad'. My three kids have really inspired me as I've gone on my writing journey, first with the *Dino Dad* series, then with *Dylan the Dino Boy Saves Christmas*, and now with my next few projects.

Of course, I try to encourage my own little ones to love reading as much as I did when I was younger so, when I write, I am keeping them in mind. I always want to write something that they will really enjoy reading. I don't want it to feel like a slog or a chore for any of my young readers (or parents reading to their little ones) to get through my books – I want the stories to be engaging and entertaining, make them laugh out loud if possible and make reading fun.

Having young children definitely impacts the stories I choose to write and the way I write them as well. When writing the *Dino Dad* books for example, I could hear my eldest daughter's voice in my head (and my youngest's, with her cheeky ways!) Those

books are for five to eight year-olds and my own daughter fell within that age range while I was working on that project. So I tried to see the world through her eyes and to capture that world-view in my writing.

Not only that, but I based the characters in *Dino Dad* on my own children. Ruby – the protagonist of the *Dino Dad* series – is also the name of my eldest daughter. Both my daughter and the Ruby in the books are sweet, sensitive souls, but with huge appetites for adventure. Little Indie is based on my younger daughter, also called Indie, with heaps of energy and a knack for getting up to mischief. My little boy Luca is only a baby still, but even he made it into the *Dino Dad* series, with an appearance in *Dino Dad: Mystery of the Missing Egg* – I couldn't leave him out!

HAS YOUR WORK IN CHILDREN'S TV INFLUENCED YOUR WRITING?

People often ask whether working as a children's television presenter helps with writing for children and I think it must. When you spend years creating content aimed at children through a camera lens, you get a pretty good idea of what appeals to them.

TV presenting trains you to think about energy and engagement. Children tune out if something doesn't grab them, and they're not shy about letting you know. That's the great thing about them – they are brutally honest with you all the time: they can't be any different. So I think by now, I've developed a fairly strong sense of what will keep their attention and what won't.

In my job as a presenter, I have to ask myself: Is this fun enough? Is it too complicated? Or not complicated enough? Does it encourage them to join in? Am I teaching them something? Will this spark their imagination? And these are all questions that I apply to my writing too. If you imagine you are reading aloud to a room full of children, it's not all that different from presenting TV for them.

I think that working in kids' TV has also helped to keep me young-minded. There is a wonder in the way that young people view the world that we can lose as we get older, and I think that it's really important to try to reconnect with that hopeful way of viewing the world, where everything is exciting and everything is an opportunity to learn.

And, of course, my role as a TV presenter has helped to launch the opportunity to write children's books for a built-in audience that I love and to reach new audiences as well. For that, I'm very grateful.

DO YOU HAVE ANY TIPS FOR GETTING RELUCTANT READERS INTO BOOKS?

I know that for a lot of parents today, it feels harder and harder to encourage children to pick up a book over an iPad or a tablet. We are living in a period that is so oversaturated by technology – which of course also has its benefits – that it can be surprising to see the power that a good old-fashioned book can still hold.

The fight to encourage a love of reading is a cause which is close to my heart, both as an author and as a father. The statistics on reading for pleasure are shocking and can be discouraging, but I firmly believe there's a book for every child, and a way to help even the most reluctant readers discover the joy of stories.



Hello! Andy here. If you've enjoyed reading about my storytelling adventures, you might enjoy my books too – the *Dino Dad* series and *Dylan the Dino Boy Saves Christmas* are available to purchase now and are chock full of adventure, energy, and dino-fun! Creating stories is one of my greatest joys, and I hope that my books bring plenty of joy to you too!

I'm no expert, but a couple of tips I've learned are:

1 Lean into their interests

If your child is obsessed with trains, fairies, sharks, outer space, dogs or DINOSAURS – there is a book for that! Start with those books. When children see themselves or their passions in a story, they're more likely to go back to books for more, in my experience.

2 Get them involved

Nobody likes being talked AT! When reading with your children, give them the chance to really get involved, to immerse themselves in the story. Give characters silly voices to bring them to life. Add sound effects. Pause dramatically. Invite your child to join in by asking them questions about the story or having them take on the role of one of the characters. The more interactive, the better!

3 Don't make it a chore

If reading turns into a battle, take a step back. It's important to keep the fun alive! Not everyone comes to reading at the same pace. Offer up a book as a fun alternative to other modes of entertainment, rather than something they *have* to do. If they feel forced, chances are they will resist the wonder that is reading! Let them choose the book (even if it's the same book for the twentieth night in a row) and let them come to it in their own time.

THE THREE CS OF GENTLE SLEEP SUPPORT

by Melanie Hastings



When helping little ones sleep better, most people focus on routines, timings, and wake windows. But how we support children matters just as much as what we do. That's where the Three Cs come in: *Consistency, Comfort, and Confidence*. Together, they create a calmer, more connected sleep experience for the whole family.

Consistency

Babies and toddlers thrive on predictability. When their world feels familiar, they feel safe and begin to settle easily. Consistency isn't about rigid timings; it's about repeatable rhythms. A predictable wind-down, a clear response to wake-ups, and a familiar bedtime phrase all help your child understand what's coming next. When sleep steps unfold in the same order each night, their brain starts preparing for rest before they're even in the cot.

Comfort

Sleep can feel vulnerable, especially for young children. Comfort means supporting your little one emotionally as well as physically. That might look

like staying nearby as they fall asleep, offering a hand to hold, or using gentle reassurance. It's about providing calm presence while making changes at a pace that feels manageable.

Confidence

Children pick up on the energy around them. When parents feel grounded and clear, little ones naturally relax more easily. Confidence isn't about having every answer; it's about trusting that your approach is safe, responsive, and right for your family. Even the best sleep plan only works when it feels good to the parents using it.

I recently supported a family whose one-year-old was waking every couple of hours. Instead of traditional "training," we used the Three Cs. Within a week, their daughter was settling more peacefully, and her parents felt calmer and more capable.

These aren't a quick fix, they're a framework for nurturing sleep in a way that strengthens connection as well as rest.

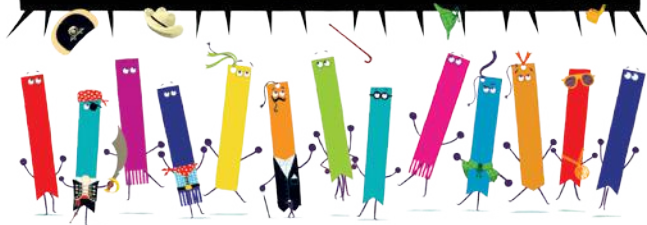

WHEN POSTNATAL RECOVERY MEETS PERIMENOPAUSE

The Overlooked Overlap

Since the 1990s, the number of women having babies in their 40s has more than doubled. Whilst there are many benefits to having children later in life, including potentially living to a greater age, it can create a doubling up effect where a woman is navigating postnatal recovery alongside the onset of perimenopause.

Add to this the stresses and strains of motherhood and it becomes the perfect storm for anxiety, low mood, fatigue and constant brain fog.

Sadly, these symptoms are often placed under the label “motherhood”, giving a sense of needing to just get on with it. When in actual fact, mothers are confused, frustrated and feeling broken and alone.

What no one is telling you is that **you are not broken**. Your body is carrying a huge load, such as...

- nutrient depletion from pregnancy
- sleep disruption
- breastfeeding demands
- physical healing
- the mental load of caring for a young child

All things new mums experience, plus reducing progesterone levels (your calming and sleep supporting hormone), and a greater sensitivity to everyday stress (in part due to perimenopausal hormone fluctuations).

So how can you support yourself through this phase?

This is not about bouncing back, it is about providing realistic and kind support for your body.

1 Concentrate on what to include, not avoid

Your body needs more nutrients now than at almost any other life stage, so build meals with:

- Protein to stabilise blood sugar and support hormone production
- Healthy fats for mood and brain health
- Leafy greens and colourful vegetables for minerals and antioxidants
- Whole carbohydrates (potatoes, lentils and beans) for slow-release energy.

TIP: Many women benefit from checking iron, B vitamins and magnesium, as they're commonly depleted postnatally and important in perimenopause.

2 Stabilise blood sugar

Blood sugar swings can worsen anxiety and fatigue. Eating regularly and balancing meals can make a big difference.

TIP: Eat within an hour of eating (even just a little)

3 Support your nervous system

Complete the stress cycle. Often a stress response is triggered but never switched off, leaving you in a heightened state. You can complete the cycle by:

- Shaking your body
- Taking deep breaths
- Belly laughs
- Being creative (writing, drawing or music)
- Having a positive conversation with a friend

4 Track your cycle and mood

Charting helps you spot patterns, understand symptoms and identify whether changes are postnatal, perimenopausal or both. It also helps you track where things are improving.

5 Seek support

You do not need to wait until things feel unmanageable. A women's health specialist can help you understand what is going on and what you need. The amount of information available online is overwhelming and confusing. Remember you are unique and your needs may be different to others.

But always remember: You are not broken.

CHOCOLATE PRETZEL FLOWERS



EQUIPMENT:

- Paper straws
- Oven Dish
- Spatula, fork & spoon
- Parchment paper
- Mixing bowl
- Cut-out paper leaves
- Glue

INGREDIENTS:

- 200g White chocolate
- Food colouring
- Pretzels

with a fork to coat fully, then lift and gently tap on the bowl's edge to remove excess.

- Place on the parchment and repeat until you have four pretzels. Arrange them in a circle with the tops facing out and touching, then place your yellow centre on top.
- Chill in the fridge for 5–10 minutes to set. Repeat to make more flowers, using different colours if you like.
- To add a stem, dab melted chocolate onto one end of a straw, press the flower onto it and chill again to set.
- Once dry, use a toothpick or sharp knife tip to clean holes of any excess chocolate..
- Optional: Add paper leaves to the straw.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Lay two sheets of parchment paper on your work surface and prepare your equipment.
- Place a wrapped chocolate bar in a heatproof dish, cover with boiling water and allow it to melt until smooth.
- Pour half the melted chocolate into a bowl, add yellow food colouring and mix. Spoon a small amount onto the parchment and spread into a circle (about the size of a 10p) – this will be the flower centre.
- Melt more chocolate and add your chosen colours for the petals.
- Dip a pretzel into the coloured chocolate, press it down

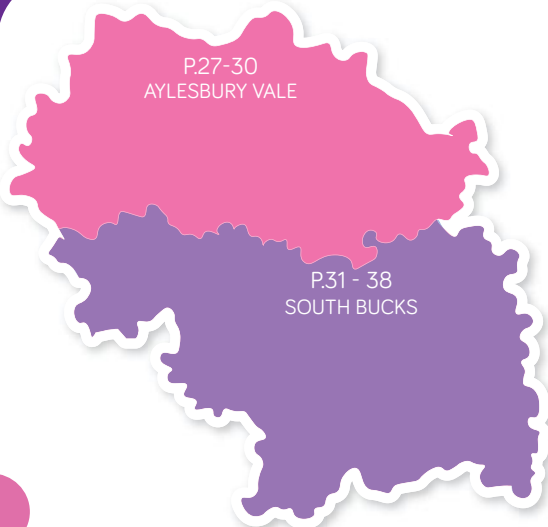

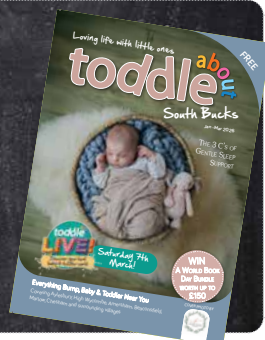
