On Christmas Eve 2024, Pope Francis opened the Holy Door of Saint Peter's Basilica to start the Jubilee Year 2025, following the tradition of celebrating such years every 25 years.

Participants in the Holy Year pilgrimage can receive a plenary indulgence, while those unable to attend are encouraged to participate spiritually.

"Tonight, the door of hope has opened wide to the world" and "God speaks to each of us and says: 'there is hope also for you!'" he said.

Pope Francis encourages the faithful to embrace the 2025 jubilee theme "Pilgrims of Hope," significant amid ongoing global conflicts.

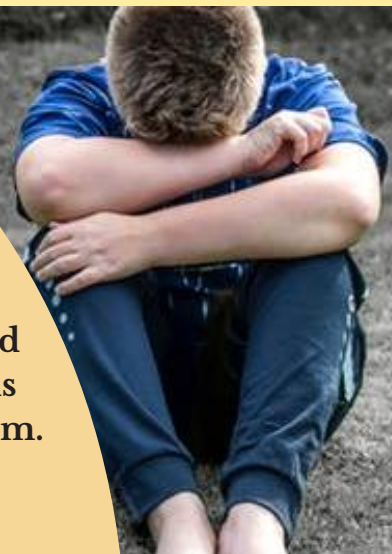
May your grace transform us into tireless cultivators of the seeds of the Gospel.

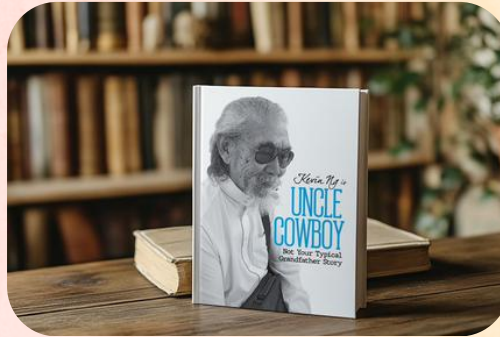

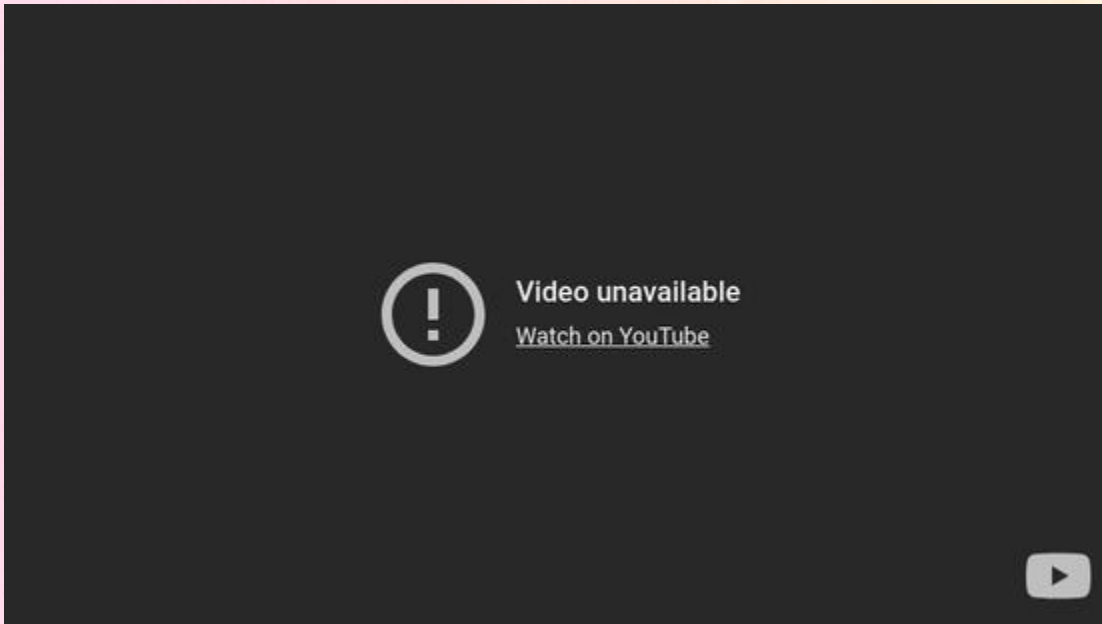

RAYMOND CHOO

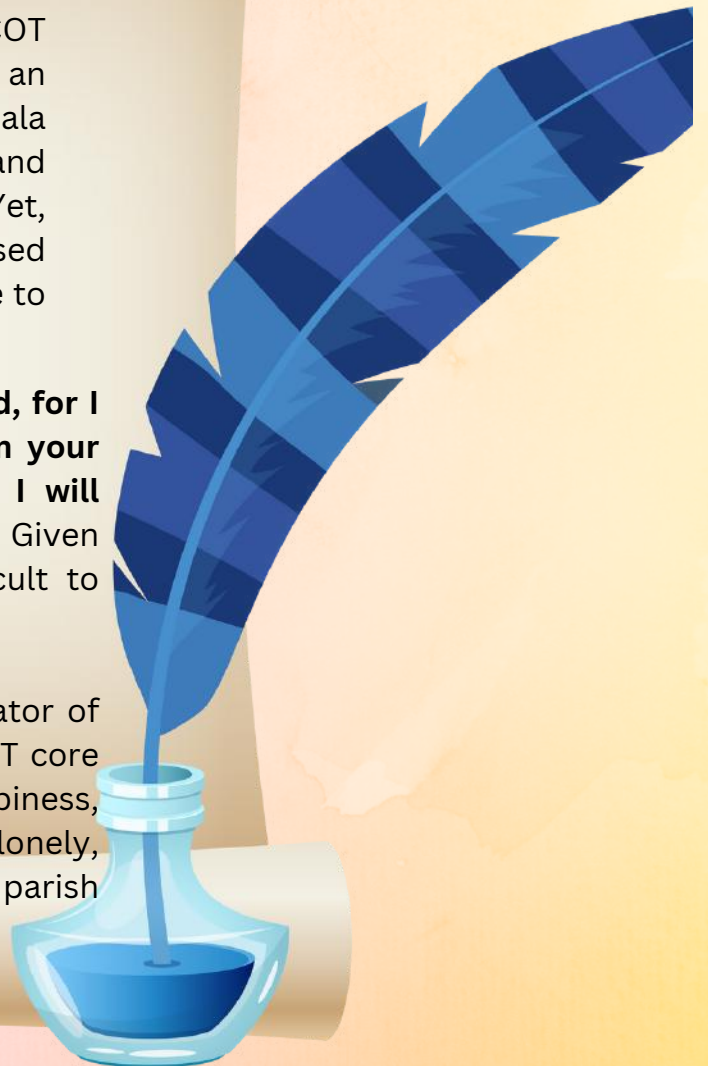
