Northern Lights and the Wildlife of Northern Manitoba

SEPTEMBER 15-20, 2024

- Explore secluded inlets and stroll sweeping white coral beaches, such as Darwin Bay. See tidal pools and pass by colonies of various bird species.
- Visit the lush highlands of Santa Cruz Island, the perfect habitat to see
 the Galapagos Giant Tortoise, and Puerto Egas on Santiago Island—
 the site of a former salt mine and where you're most likely to see the
 Galapagos fur seal.


