



CARLOS BETANCOURT



Carlos Betancourt (b. 1966, San Juan, Puerto Rico) is a Miami-based multidisciplinary artist recognized for his vibrant, layered works that explore memory, identity, and cultural symbolism. His art has been exhibited worldwide and is included in the permanent collections of The Metropolitan Museum of Art, the Smithsonian National Portrait Gallery, the Pérez Art Museum Miami, and the New Orleans Museum of Art, among others. Betancourt's practice extends beyond fine art into curating, design, and collaborations with leading international brands. His partnership with Casamonte marks a new chapter in his career—translating his iconic imagery and one-line drawings into wallcovering and mural designs. Drawing inspiration from his Puerto Rican upbringing, his gardens in Miami and El Yunque rainforest, and his collaborations with architect Alberto Latorre, this collection infuses interiors with the spirit, symbolism, and magic that define his work.

At the heart of this collection is the lush tropical landscape of my Caribbean upbringing in Puerto Rico. This natural beauty has long served as a wellspring of inspiration—most notably embodied in Carlos's Garden, a creative sanctuary I have cultivated for years within the El Yunque rainforest, with the support of close friends. This living garden is a source of constant imagination and now deeply influences the designs of this wallcovering collection. Today, banana plants and malangas remain ever-present in Carlos's Garden, as well as in our beloved Careyes, Mexico and our home in Miami. Through this collection, I seek to recreate the emotion and spirit these plants evoke—a sense of being embraced by nature. This is my heartfelt tribute to their enduring symbolism, rooted in personal memory and inspired by the raw beauty and authenticity of life in the Caribbean.


