OUR MISSION

Farming for Nature (FFN) is here to **change the narrative**—farming and nature don't have
to be at odds. We connect, support, and
inspire farmers who are leading the way in
nature positive food production. Our network
of farmers form part of a wider movement
that **prove how farming can protect, enhance and restore ecosystems for future generations**.

Why Does This Matter?

- Over 60% of Ireland's biodiversity is in decline. (NPWS)
- 40% of Ireland's waterbirds have disappeared in just 20 years. (BirdWatch Ireland)
- One-third of Ireland's bee species are threatened with extinction. (National Biodiversity Data Centre)
- Farmers need support to transition towards more sustainable practices.

That's where FFN steps in—helping farmers lead the way in protecting nature while ensuring their farms thrive.

Since 2018, Farming for Nature has been working tirelessly with farmers to integrate nature into their farming systems. We're proud of the progress we've made, with over 30 programmes already helping farmers across Ireland. These initiatives provide practical tools, funding, and support for farmers to enhance nature on their land. But we know there's much more to be done.

The connection between farming and nature is undeniable: healthy ecosystems can help reduce costs, build resilience and add value. To truly make a lasting difference, we need more support. While our six key areas of impact are helping us move in the right direction, to create real change, we need to scale up our efforts. 

Farming for Nature is proud to operate under the Burrenbeo Trust, Ireland's first landscape charity dedicated to place-based learning and community-driven conservation in the Burren and beyond.

Burrenbeo Trust provides **essential governance**, **financial oversight**, and **administrative support**, ensuring we can focus on empowering farmers to work with nature.

Diverse Farms, One Goal

- Our Ambassadors range from small family farms to large-scale operations, across 25 counties and all sectors (dairy, beef, sheep, tillage, mixed etc) all united by a commitment to biodiversity.
- Farming for Nature spans across every province of Ireland, showing that nature-friendly farming works in all landscapes.

Nature at the Heart of Farming

- Some FFN farms have over 100 different species of wildflowers thriving in their fields.
- Our Ambassadors have created **wildlife corridors** connecting natural habitats across farms.

A Movement of Shared Knowledge

- The Farming for Nature Handbook is now in its second print run, helping farmers across Ireland implement nature-friendly practices.
- An **international movement** with sister initiatives in Northern Ireland, Austria and Lithuania.
