### FINANCIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-26

This document provides the financial information for Verbier International School's tuition and boarding fees for the 2025/26 academic year, as well as other charges, financial conditions, and payment information relevant for those enrolled or considering admission.

Our school fees consist of three parts: annual & seasonal tuition fees, annual & seasonal boarding fees, and additional charges based on individual circumstances.
