





## Simple Assembly




The Panel is supplied pre-drilled with your selection of storage rod options.



Using the fixings provided – assemble the rods, tightening behind.




Screw the 2no. panel Split battens the rear of the panel.




## Installation of the panels.




Install the 2no. split battens back to the wall using suitable fixings.




Standard configuration with Brown Oak Panels
