


Fitrah Muhammad believes that all people are created with purpose, the right to freedom, and the pursuit of life, liberty and happiness.



At an early age of 15, she accepted the leadership of the late Honorable Elijah Muhammad (ra), a great social reformer who raised the consciousness of his people.

She continued her journey as a student of the late Imam W. Deen Mohammed (ra), often spoken of as "America's Imam", who led the largest conversion of African Americans in history from a hybrid form of Islam to universal Al-Islam, consistent with the Holy Qur'an and the prophetic teachings of Prophet Muhammad (pbuh).



In 2014, Ms. Muhammad founded the Study Al-Islam Program, a weekly educational series dedicated to the advancement of knowledge, a clear understanding of the Qur'an, traditions of Prophet Muhammed (PBUH), the Arabic language, and the insightful, scriptural, and contemporary language of Imam W. Deen Mohammed (ra).
