### **Short breaks for children and young people with disabilities**

The Mallard is a welcoming, purpose-built service where every child's needs, preferences, and happiness come first. We provide short breaks for children and young people, aged 5-21, with additional or complex needs. Our warm, family-focused approach means every stay is carefully planned to be enjoyable, safe, and tailored to each child.

Our short breaks give children and young people the chance to:


- Relax in a nurturing environment
- Try new activities and experiences
- Build independence, confidence and social skills



Every child has a key worker who works with the family to plan activities around their likes, interests, and goals. Staff are highly trained in specialist areas including PEG feeding, moving and handling, epilepsy awareness, medication administration, autism awareness, safeguarding and behaviour support.

**During their stay, children can enjoy:**

- Sensory room – calming, engaging sensory play
- Hydrotherapy spa pool – gentle relaxation and therapy
- Art and craft room – creative, hands-on fun
- Enclosed garden – safe outdoor play and exploration
- Giant ball pit – sensory movement and laughter
- Home-cooked meals – fresh, tasty, and tailored to dietary needs

#### **Young Adults Transition Service**

GO2 is a bespoke service designed to support young adults with disabilities in accessing a wide range of activities in the community and from our purpose-built hub. Our aim is to enable each person to build essential life skills, grow in independence and achieve their own goals and aspirations.

Our service has extensive experience in providing 1:1 support for young adults as they move from school to adulthood, helping them prepare for a transition to adult support services.

Every young person is matched with a qualified and trained key worker who works closely with them and their family to create a personalised outcome focussed care plan.

Alongside a wide range of community activities, our fully accessible building includes:

- Cinema Room
- Sensory Room
- Hydrotherapy Pool
- Large Garden
- Arts & Crafts Room
- Music Room
- Accessible Kitchen
- Soft Play Space
- Gym





## After-school Club (Ages 7-18)

Our after-school club provides a safe, welcoming space for children and young people with additional support needs. Sessions are carefully structured to promote social interaction, confidence, and fun through engaging sessions such as art, music, sports, and other creative or sensory activities. Our groups have a maximum of four young people supported by two experienced staff.


## Holiday Club (Ages 7-18)

Running during the Easter, Summer and October holidays, our holiday club offers school-aged children with additional support needs the chance to enjoy everything GO2 has to offer. Each child is supported on a 1:1 basis by our experienced team, ensuring they can take part in a wide variety of exciting activities and use our excellent facilities. Every child will have a dedicated keyworker who will work with them and their family to ensure they get the most out of their experience. The Holiday Club will help young people build confidence, make friends, and most importantly have lots of fun! Places for our holiday club are very limited.
