## AMBERS ASCEND

**H**andsworth, Dearne & District, and Stocksbridge Park Steels all hit top gear in a goal-packed week.

Handsworth extended their red-hot streak to five straight wins in all competitions—three in the league—bagging 15 goals along the way.

Their latest scalp came at Frickley Athletic, where a 3-0 win lifted the Ambers to 7th in the NCEL Premier Division, just two spots shy of the play-offs. Jodan Hines opened the scoring before Joshua Nodder (pictured) sealed the deal with a stoppage-time double. No game for Handsworth this weekend due to FA Vase commitments.

Meanwhile, Dearne & District are tearing up Division One, scoring for fun and sitting four points clear at the summit. After last week's 7-0 demolition of Nostell Miners, they crushed Athersley Recreation 4-0 on Saturday and thrashed Armthorpe Welfare 7-1 on Tuesday. Five different scorers shared the spoils, with Jamie Austin netting four across the two games, including a hat-trick midweek.

Stocksbridge Park Steels made it four wins on the bounce, edging Warrington Town 2-1 in a crucial NPL Premier clash. The result opens up a four-point cushion over Town, who sit in the final relegation spot.

It was a frustrating week for Hallam, who were held to back-to-back 1-1 draws at home by Consett and Grimsby Borough in the NPL East Division.

## Edge of Glory

**R**otherham Titans retained their grip on the summit of National League 1 with a heart-stopping 27-26 win over Rosslyn Park in a match that lived up to its top-of-the-table billing.

On a sunlit afternoon at Clifton Lane, the Titans delivered a performance full of grit, flair, and resilience, while Rosslyn Park pushed them to the very edge in a contest that could have gone either way.

The Titans' four-try haul came courtesy of Jackson Barling, Morgan Veness, Harry Newborn, and Travis Gordon, with Lloyd Hayes—marking his 150th appearance—adding seven points from the tee, including a crucial late penalty. The game was a showcase of high-level rugby, with both sides demonstrating why they're among the division's elite.

Rotherham dominated early territory and possession, but it took 22 minutes before Barling powered over in the corner to break the deadlock. Rosslyn Park responded almost immediately through Luke Mehson, who sliced through the defence to

Aycliffe this Saturday.

Worsbrough Bridge  
Athletic are making a  
habit of late drama. In  
front of Park Road's  
biggest crowd in years  
(317), Keelan Grist sal-  
vaged a point with a  
last-gasp header  
against 3rd-placed ri-  
vals. Then on Tuesday,  
after conceding a late  
equaliser at Leeds  
UFCA, Juninho Blake  
popped up in injury  
time to snatch a 3-2  
win and keep Wors-  
brough in 3rd, just two  
points off the top.

Elsewhere in the  
NCEL, Maltby Main  
cruised to a 4-1 win at  
Goole, while Doncaster  
City grabbed a 2-1 away  
win at South Leeds.  
Sheffield and Club  
Thorne Colliery were  
the only other sides to  
pick up points, both  
drawing.

In the UCL, Dron-  
field Town shared a  
thrilling 3-3 draw at  
Radford, while Swal-  
lownest were held 1-1 at  
home by bottom club  
Rainworth Miners Wel-  
fare. Dronfield bounced  
back on Tuesday with a  
comfortable 3-0 win  
over Pinxton.

Tuesday's NCEL  
derby day delivered  
fireworks. Rossington  
Main thumped Park-  
gate 5-2 to climb away  
from danger, while  
Parkgate's defensive  
woes continue—15  
goals conceded in three  
games. Wombwell  
Town and Penistone  
Church played out a 1-1  
draw, with Edward  
Agnew cancelling out  
Keiran Ryan's opener.

Club Thorne Colliery  
edged Glasshoughton  
Welfare 1-0 to sit just  
outside the Division  
One play-offs on goal  
difference. In the Pre-  
mier Division, Sheffield  
were unlucky in a 2-0  
defeat at Pickering,  
who leapfrogged them  
into fourth, pushing  
Sheffield down to sixth.

# Yorkshire Grit Meets Vase Glory!

**The Isuzu FA  
Vase First  
Round Proper  
takes centre stage  
this Saturday, and  
four South Yorkshire  
sides are ready to test  
their mettle against  
tough opposition as  
the dream of Wem-  
bley looms large.**

Penistone Church wel-  
come Droylsden to the  
Parker Roofing Mem-  
orial Ground in what  
promises to be a heavy-  
weight clash. Church,  
currently mid-table in  
the Northern Counties  
East League Premier  
Division, have endured a  
mixed start to the sea-  
son, including a heavy  
defeat to Parkgate, but  
showed resilience to  
edge Ashville 2-1 in the  
previous Vase round  
thanks to a decisive  
strike from Sam  
Scrivens. Droylsden,  
meanwhile, are flying  
high at the top of the  
North West Counties  
First Division North,  
boasting 26 goals from 11  
games and a reputation  
for attacking football  
under veteran boss Dave  
Pace. Their route to this  
stage was emphatic,  
hammering Nostell  
Miners Welfare 4-0.  
Penistone will lean on  
talisman Kieran Ryan to  
unsettle a Droylsden side  
spearheaded by free-  
scoring Harry Cain. Co-  
boss Brett Lovell  
summed up the mood  
after their last Vase win:  
“We’ve shown character  
to get here. Droylsden  
are a big name, but we’ll  
make the Memorial  
Ground a fortress.”

Maltby Main face a  
tricky trip to Prestwich  
Heys, who sit 15th in the  
North West Counties  
Premier Division but  
have found form with  
four wins in their last six.  
Main, 10th in NCEL  
Division One, have been  
inconsistent but danger-  
ous when it matters.  
Their passage to Round  
One came courtesy of a



dramatic 97th-minute  
winner from Curtis Mor-  
rison against Stockport  
Georgians, and Morrison  
remains the Miners' key  
threat. Prestwich will  
look to skipper Paul Con-  
nor for leadership in  
what could be a bruising  
encounter. Main boss  
Joe Austin struck a de-  
fiant tone on social  
media: “We’re under-  
dogs, but that suits us.  
The lads love a battle.”

Rossington Main host  
Crowle Colts in an all-  
Yorkshire affair that pits  
experience against ambi-  
tion. Rossington,  
another NCEL Premier  
side, have had a patchy  
league run but showed  
nerve to progress via pe-  
nalties at FC St Helens.  
Crowle, newcomers to  
NCEL Division One,  
have impressed early,  
sitting sixth with 27  
points from 15 games  
after promotion. They  
edged past Dearne &  
District in a local derby  
thriller to reach this  
stage and boast prolific  
forward Declan Bacon,  
whose pedigree could  
trouble Rossington's  
back line. Tyler Bradley  
will be Rossington's  
danger man as they aim  
to assert their higher-tier

status.

Wombwell Town,  
exempt until this stage  
after last season's strong  
campaign, travel to  
Winsford United in what  
looks their sternest test  
yet. Winsford, a Midland  
Football League Premier  
side, are unbeaten in five  
and scoring freely, mak-  
ing them one of the form  
teams in the competi-  
tion. Wombwell's recent  
league form has been  
shaky, with no wins in  
five, but they have Vase  
pedigree and a squad ca-  
pable of springing a sur-  
prise. Brad Kerr's  
physical presence up  
front will be crucial,  
while Winsford rely on  
Jordan Johnson's goals  
to keep their momentum  
rolling.

For these South York-  
shire clubs, the FA Vase  
is more than a knockout  
competition—it's a shot  
at glory, prize money,  
and the ultimate dream  
of a Wembley final. Ex-  
pect drama, goals, and  
maybe a giant-killing or  
two as Yorkshire grit  
meets Vase glory this  
weekend.

## Steels Sink Warrington in Crucial Six-Pointer

If you are in a relegation battle, the most important matches are the ones against the teams also fighting against it.

That's why so called 'six-pointers' are so crucial. And maybe in October it's too early to describe any game as one, but there's definitely a good case for Stocksbridge Park Steels Vs Warrington Town.

While Stocksbridge would have expected to be in the relegation dogfight, Warrington Town certainly didn't. They were relegated from the National League North last year and with a squad of players experienced at a higher level, they were expecting to bounce back. However, the hangover has continued into this season and they find themselves in the relegation zone, fearing the same fate of double relegation that happened to Bradford Park Avenue and Blyth Spartans in the last two years.

At first, Warrington were the better side but they struggled to hit the back of the net. Balls would go into the six-yard area, but none of the forwards could put anything on it, meaning the combination of Elliot Owen and Ben Jordison were able to clear.

And with Warrington not taking their chances, Stocksbridge were able to make one, and duly use it effectively. Luke Rawson, returning to the starting line-up, won the ball high up the pitch before getting it to James Morris. He got the ball out of his feet and his curling shot would be well saved by Liam Isherwood. However, Oliwier Grzelak played poacher and was able to shoot from the parry, scoring and getting the opener.

From there, it was all Stocksbridge. They were full of confidence, Warrington didn't have any. And so it was no surprise that the Steels were able to double their lead before the break. Morris on the right wing was able to lift the ball to the edge of the box. Alex O'Connor then hit his volley first time and his shot powered onto the post and in. It was unstoppable and Stocksbridge were well on their way to victory in this six pointer.

It seemed like Stocksbridge had a nightmare start to the second half. Pretty quickly, Warrington worked the ball down the left and when the cross wasn't cleared, Reece Daly was able to slam a shot home. But to the relief of the home fans, just before Daly's shot she blew up for a foul

that happened in the build-up. Warrington's cheers were cut short and turned into anger over the decision.

Stocksbridge were able to hold off the Warrington pressure and because of the way the Yellows were pushing forward, they had chances to truly finish the game off. A brilliant Danny Deakin ball found the surging run of Oliwier Grzelak but he never got his touches right so when he went into the box, the Polish forward was off balance and steered the ball harmlessly wide of goal. Rawson was playing creator again later as he unselfishly played the ball across to Morris, but the Steels leading scorer was only able to find the hands of Isherwood.

Warrington had shown most of their threat from set pieces and so it was inevitable that any goal they scored would be

from a corner. It felt like a simple one too, a looped ball into the six-yard area and with Ben Townsend penned in by a mass of players, Troy Bourne was there to head in.

This should have set up a grandstand finish but Warrington really didn't muster anything in return. They didn't even get another corner to pile on the nerves. Instead, Stocksbridge were the closest to scoring next, with Tomas Poole's improvised shot on the turn hitting the side netting.

After some time wasting from Poole, the full time whistle went and Stocksbridge won their first six pointer of the season. The other two relegation threatened teams Morpeth Town and Workington are coming up in the next month as a true test of if Stocksbridge can stay in the Northern Premier League Premier.

# Hallam Battle Hard But Wins Elude Them

**H**allam FC endured a demanding week at Sandygate, producing two spirited performances but ultimately settling for draws against Consett and Grimsby Borough. While the Countrymen showed resilience and flashes of quality, they left frustrated after failing to turn dominance into victories.

On Saturday, a fantastic crowd of 1,004 packed the world's oldest football ground to

see Hallam take on Consett. Manager Craig Denton made four changes following the midweek defeat to Matlock Town, bringing in Warhurst, Aguas, South and Cadman. The hosts started brightly and nearly struck first when Jamie Sharman flicked on a dangerous ball into the box, only for captain Danny South to miscue his effort.

Moments later, Hallam were ahead thanks to Brodie Litchfield's relentless pressing. Consett keeper Harry Moss hesitated on a clearance, and Litchfield charged it

down, the rebound rolling straight into the net for 1-0.

Litchfield almost doubled the lead soon after, forcing Moss into a fine save following good work from South, who unfortunately limped off injured on his return from suspension.

That miss proved costly as Consett equalised on 34 minutes. Hugo Warhurst parried a shot, and Matty Todd pounced to tap home into an empty net.

The second half was tense, with Warhurst producing a superb double save to deny Consett while Hallam threatened on the break. James Cadman and Litchfield tested Moss, and substitute Harrison Poulter fired wide late

on. Then came the drama: deep into stoppage time, Calum Ward headed home what looked like a winner, only for the flag to go up for offside.

A 1-1 draw felt fair, but Hallam were left ruing missed chances.

Three days later, Hallam returned to Sandygate to face Grimsby Borough, who arrived in good form despite a heavy defeat to Redcar Athletic.

The visitors struck first on 23 minutes through Reece York, punishing Hallam's failure to clear their lines.

The Countrymen responded after the break, dominating possession and finally breaking through on 66 minutes when persistence paid

off. A well-worked move ended with Janusz Lipka levelling the score, sparking hopes of a winner.

Despite controlling much of the game and creating the better chances, Hallam couldn't find a winner. Poulter again came close, and Litchfield remained a constant menace, but Borough's defence held firm. The 1-1 result keeps Hallam 14th in the standings with 12 points from 12 games, while Grimsby stay in the playoff mix.

Two draws in four days underline Hallam's grit but also their lack of cutting edge. They've now drawn seven of their 13 league games, scoring just 15 goals while conceding 20.

Denton's men are averaging a point per game—enough to keep them clear of immediate danger, but not enough to climb the table. The positives? Litchfield's pressing game continues to unsettle defences, Warhurst looks assured between the sticks, and the squad showed character to fight back against Grimsby. But injuries to key men like South and the inability to convert late chances remain concerns.

Next up for Hallam is a trip to struggling Newton Aycliffe, followed by a home clash with Brighouse Town—two fixtures that could define whether they push toward mid-table security or remain stuck in the lower reaches.

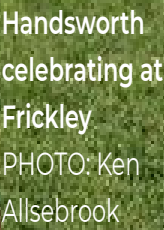

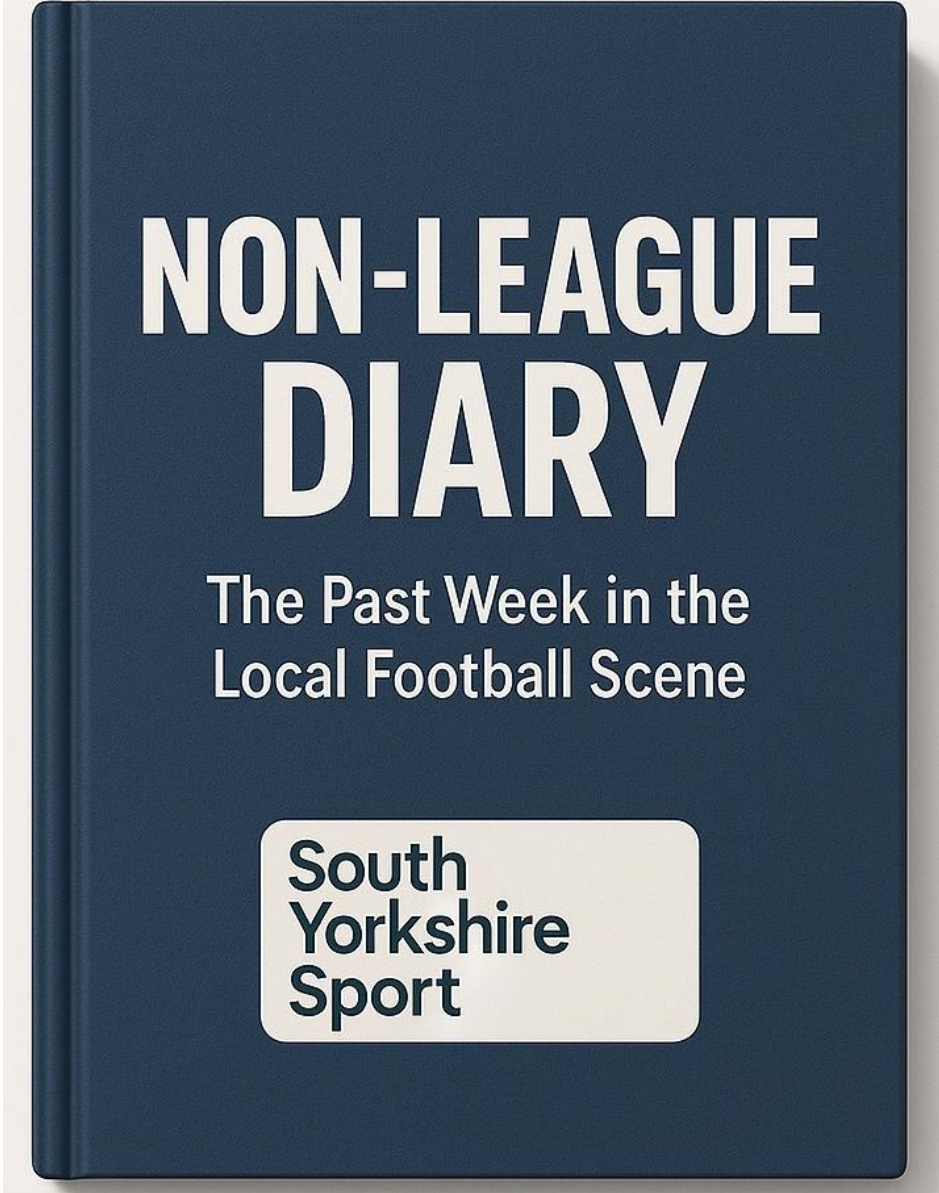

# Shelbourne Saves Town in Thrilling Double

**Dronfield Town’s roller-coaster week in the United Counties League Division One delivered drama, redemption, and a surge up the table as Chris Millington’s men followed a last-gasp 3-3 draw at Radford with a commanding 3-0 home win over Pinxton.**

For the second week-end running, Town left it late to snatch a point, this time in Nottingham against a lively Radford side. Wearing the hosts’ away kit due to a colour clash, Dronfield started sluggishly and paid the price inside eight minutes when debutant Nashiem Isman rifled home from the edge of the box past a helpless Lewis Naylor.

Parity was restored almost immediately. Arran Bovill was bundled over in the area, leaving the referee with an easy decision. Sam Bebbington coolly slotted the penalty low to the keeper’s right for 1-1. But defensive frailties haunted Town again as Harrison Mellors rose unmarked to nod home a corner two minutes later. When Latrelle Patterson added a third on 25 minutes—another free header after Town failed to clear—the visitors looked dead and buried.

The first half ended with little sign of a comeback, but Millington’s halftime words sparked a transformation. On 52 minutes, Connor Chapell’s inswinging corner was met by Dan Shelbourne’s thumping header to make it 3-2. Moments later, Max Rhodes thought he’d equalised after Abbas spilled Bovill’s shot, only for the assistant’s flag to deny him.

Town laid siege to the Radford goal as Shelbourne and Rhodes peppered efforts, but it was Naylor who kept them alive with a stunning late save from Dennan Morgan’s volley—an effort Gordon Banks would have been proud of.

Then came the grandstand finish. Seven minutes into stoppage time, Chapell’s curling corner looked destined for the net before Shelbourne bundled it over the line for his second of the

game. Cue wild celebrations and a hard-earned point that felt like a victory.

Back at Stonelow Stadium, Town produced a polished display to claim three vital points against Pinxton. The visitors started brightly, Ben Jones rattling the post early on, but Dronfield grew into the contest. Max Rhodes forced Warren Squires into a smart save before injury struck Chris Simpkins, paving the way for Callum Mawbey’s introduction—a change that would prove decisive.

After a flurry of half-chances, Town struck in first-half stoppage time. Bovill surged forward and drilled a low shot into the bottom corner for his sixth of the season. Within two minutes of the restart, Mawbey doubled the lead, rising to meet Charlie Stewart’s deep free kick with a looping header. The substitute then sealed the win on 53 minutes, calmly stroking home with his weaker right foot after Pinxton failed to clear.

With a three-goal cushion, Town briefly eased off, allowing Pinxton a spell of pressure. Naylor was alert to deny Jay Cooper low to his left, while Sion Green’s deflected strike whistled wide. But Dronfield finished strongly, Rhodes teeing up Bovill for a late effort that Squires blocked with his feet.

The victory lifts Town to tenth, just two points off eighth, and sets up a mouth-watering clash with high-flying Stapleford Town on Saturday. With eight home games in the next eleven, Millington knows this run could define their season.

Two games, two contrasting stories—but both underline Dronfield’s resilience and growing confidence. At Radford, they showed grit to fight back from 3-1 down; against Pinxton, they displayed control and clinical finishing. Shelbourne’s brace and Mawbey’s impact will dominate headlines, but the collective spirit is what Millington will cherish most.

If Town can tighten up defensively and maintain their attacking verve, the climb from mid-table

mediocrity to playoff contention might just be on.

Swallownest, meanwhile, endured a week of mixed emotions. Saturday’s clash with Rainworth Miners Welfare looked set to deliver three points when Callum Brookes fired home on 55 minutes after a cagey first half. The hosts defended stoutly until deep into stoppage time when Asher Banner broke hearts with a 95th-minute equaliser. A cruel blow for a side that had worked tirelessly to protect their lead.

If that was frustrating, Wednesday’s trip to Clipstone was pure chaos. Swallownest found themselves 3-1 down at the

break after Declan Brown, Lemar Carlin and Tomas Fleet struck for the home side, with Swallownest replying through an early equaliser. But the visitors showed remarkable character in the second half. A goal on 70 minutes gave them hope, and when the clock ticked into the 90th minute, pandemonium ensued as Swallownest snatched a dramatic leveler to make it 3-3. The scorers may not grab headlines, but the spirit will. Four points slipped through their fingers in five days, yet the fight-back at Clipstone suggests this team has steel—and with fixtures coming thick and fast, that resilience could prove priceless.

**Barnsley Women moved up to second in the FA Women’s National League Division One Midlands following their 2-1 win at second bottom Stourbridge. Jodie Snelson netted both for Barnsley who went ahead early on but were pegged back to 1-1 at the interval.**

Barnsley are now on 15 points from six games, sandwiched between leaders Peterborough United and third place Boldmere St Michaels, both of whom have a 100% record from five games. Neither of the pair was in League action due to the need to accommodate various cup ties.

Sheffield United Under-21s lost 2-0 at Durham Cestria in FAWNL’s Plate competition first round. Sheffield efforts to remain unbeaten in the league did not get off to an electric start, when a series of penalties pushed them from being close to Fylde's try line to near our own. At the scrum where we have been dominant all season and incurred very few penalties, we were being refereed out of the match.

Once again, Elliot Fisher was the happy recipient of the ball and went in for his and Sheffield's second try. The conversion was missed, but the visitors now led by 12 points to 3 after twenty-two minutes.

However, Fylde were



not going to lie down and let Sheffield walk all over them, and again the penalty count began to mount in Fylde's favour. Hence, with Fylde attacking close in and under warning another penalty close in saw Cam Catleugh despatched to the sin-bin on Thirty-five minutes.

Two minutes later,

The start of the second half again saw Fylde in the ascendancy, and their endeavours were soon rewarded when from another penalty, they manufactured a second try, wide out, for winger, Ben Turner.

Again, Will Hunt could not add the conversion, but Fylde had dragged the lead back to 19 points to 13 with just five minutes of the half gone.

Then again, and with Matty Drennan about to return to the fray, Fylde burst away and with some heavy work from their pack, were rewarded with second row, Matt Ashcroft going over wide out again.

The kicking duties went to Danny Cassidy, but the conversion was missed and the lead was left at 33 points to 18 on sixty-five minutes.

The final flourish would again come from the visitors, when prop forward Alex Reid broke off a driving maul to burrow his way over wide out on the left. score on their first meaningful attack. Thurnscoe Gooseacre also impressed, travelling to Mexborough Montagu and returning with a 5-0 victory. Tommy Sambrook was the hero of the hour, netting four goals with clinical precision. Rueben Tonge added the fifth, capping off a confident

team performance. Carrfield Primary Academy continued their strong run with a 6-2 win over Brampton Ellis. Tyrese Perry and Stanley Parks each bagged a brace, supported by goals from Zani Powell and Freddie Gollick. Despite the defeat, Brampton's Minnie Christon earned praise for her tireless efforts and skillful play. In the tightest clash of the round, Wath C of E edged past Mex-

borough Windhill 1-0 thanks to a decisive strike from Archie Adams. Windhill's goalkeeper Ben Frost was in inspired form, pulling off a string of saves to keep his team in contention until the final whistle. Now in its 102nd year, the Totty Cup remains a cherished tradition in the Don and Dearne area. First contested in 1923, the competition has helped shape generations of young foot-

ballers and continues to celebrate the spirit of school sport. Legendary players such as George Robledo and Alan Sunderland once graced its pitches, and today's stars are writing their own stories. With the semi-finals looming, excitement builds. Will Carrfield add to their record 19 titles, or will a new champion emerge to lift one of South Yorkshire's most historic school trophies?
