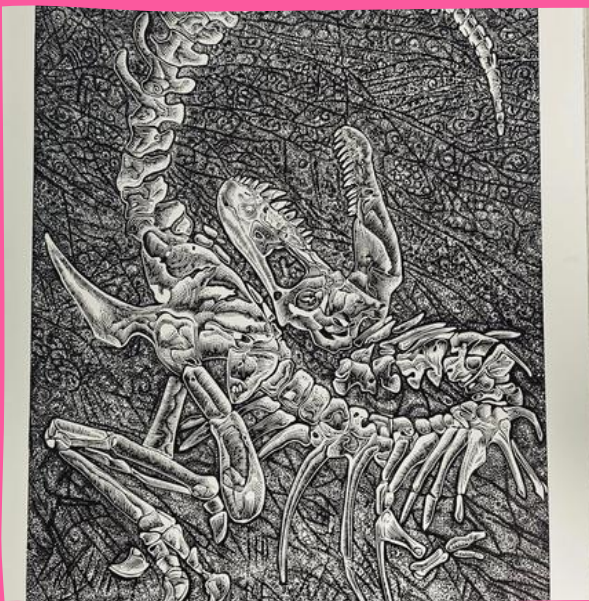
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IAN JACKSON PRINTMAKER & ARTIST

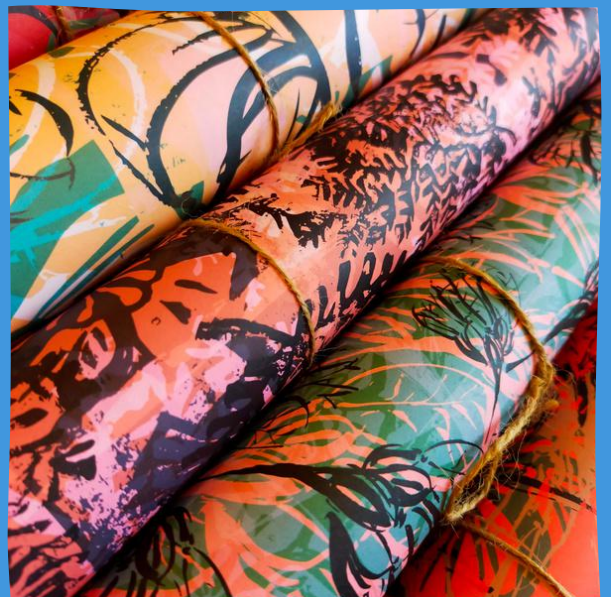


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DESIGN.PRNTS

Rooted in nature, alchemy & old-world craft – made to enchant your senses.



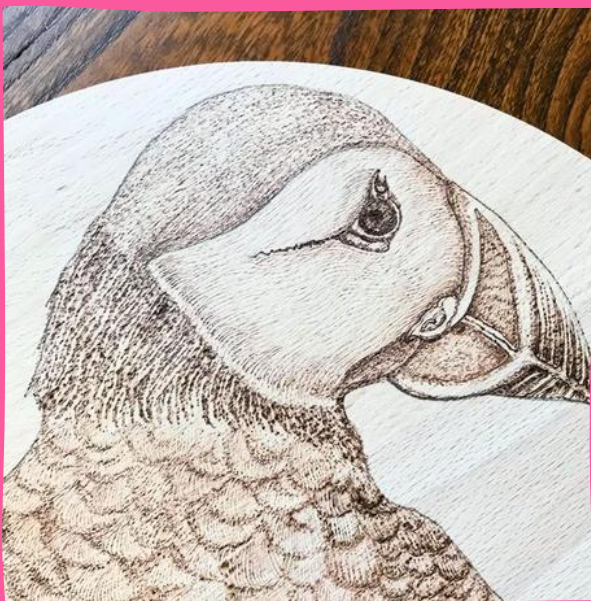
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ICARUS PYROGRAPHY

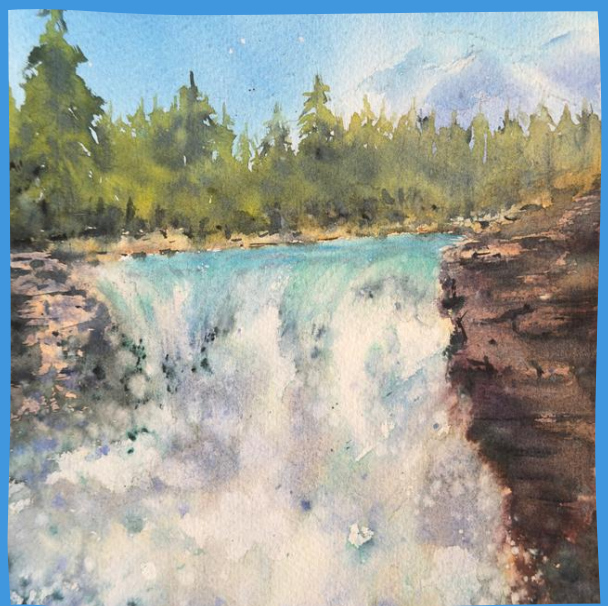
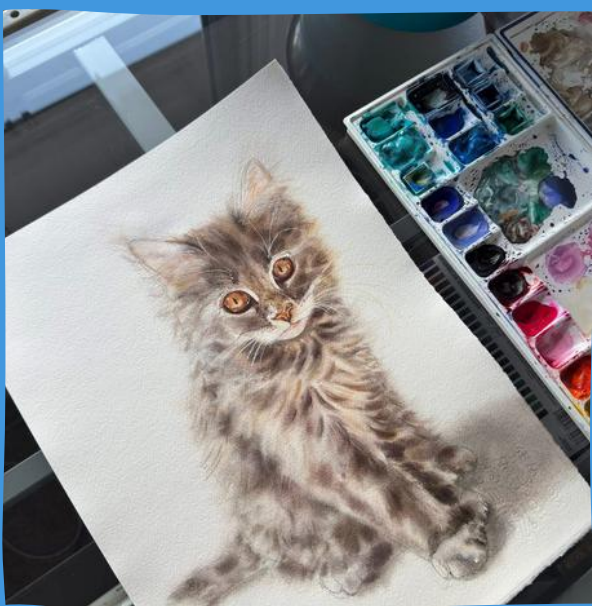
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SOFIA PALIKA ART

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TWIGGY JEMIMA

Hi I am Charlotte the brain behind Twiggy Jemima. I create original designs for my greetings cards and larger artworks through a very old craft technique called paper quilling. This involves the folding, rolling and shaping of strips of paper into (hopefully!) recognisable images which I then affix to my greetings cards or mount to make framed pieces. It means each piece is completely unique and original due to the handmade nature of my work. I look forward to meeting you at St Thomas' and am always happy and to demonstrate the techniques and processes I use in the creation of my art.



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RAVEN MANDALA

I create hand-painted mandala wall hangings and smaller items such as bookmarks, key rings, jewellery, and mandala stones using acrylic paint on circular boards starting at 20cm in diameter. Mandalas, which symbolise the universe and aid in meditation, are calming to paint and promote well-being. Each unique piece reflects a mindful and therapeutic creative process inspired by emotions, objects, or nature.

I also make smaller gift items such as crochet book marks and hand sewn pen holders. I'm a self-taught hand embroidery artist whose work explores pop culture through a nostalgic and playful lens. Inspired by Halloween, cult horror films, and music, my pieces blend traditional textile techniques with contemporary themes. Each stitch reflects a love for the eerie, the iconic, and the unexpected—celebrating the crossover between craft and culture.



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JENNI STONE DESIGNS

My artistic journey began during lockdown, crafting hand-cut collages by candlelight. As I explored workshops and creative studies, I embraced digital techniques, blending paper and pixels into gothic, otherworldly art for your home—artifacts that bridge the past and the surreal.



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FIREFLY HANDMADE CREATIONS

Laura creates an array of home fragrance items, including beautifully scented wax melts, elegantly crafted candles, stylish reed diffusers, refreshing room sprays, and decorative wax burners.



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CLARE WAINWRIGHT STAINED GLASS

I am a stained glass designer/ maker creating stained glass items using the Tiffany (copper foiled) method. This is a four step process which involves cutting, grinding, taping and soldering the glass pieces together. My work is generally small to medium sized decorative suncatchers and panels which typically hold a contemporary feel through the use of a variety of techniques and inclusions. These include fusing images onto glass , screen printing, acid etching and the addition of items such as shells and glass nuggets .



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THE CLUTTERY

Zoe from The Cluttery is a self-taught jewellery designer based in Birmingham has been running The Cluttery since 2017. The bold pieces mix acrylic, wood, and more, drawing inspiration from Art Deco and mid-century styles. This designer believes jewellery should be fun and expressive, not expensive.



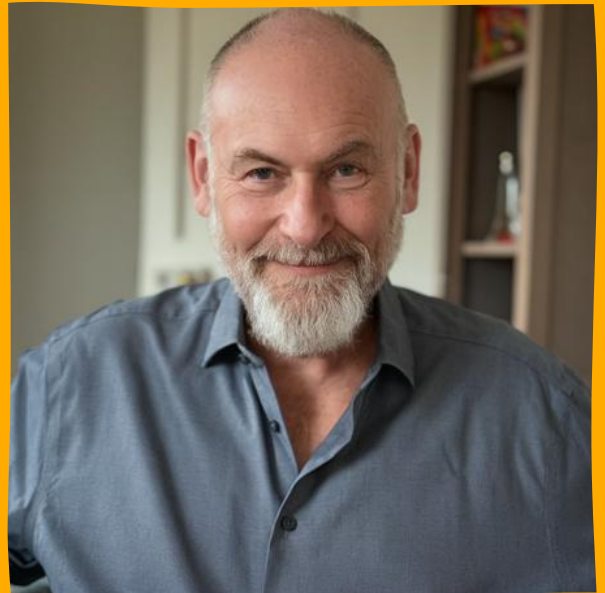
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KELMARSH WOODWORK

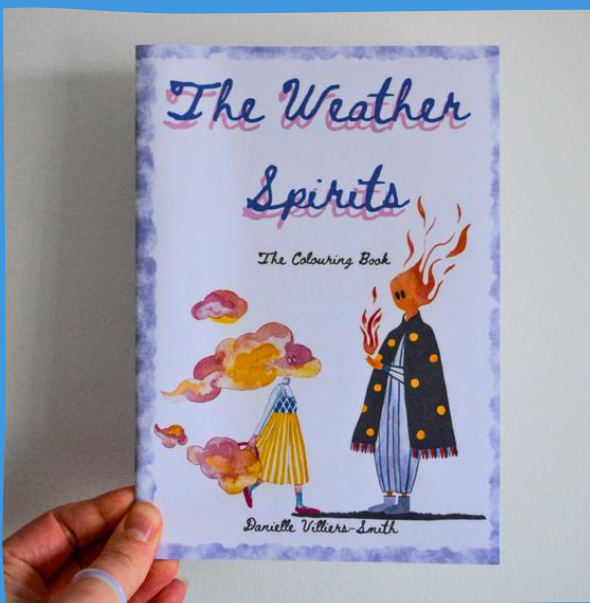
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DANIELLE VILLIERS-SMITH

Rachel's soft color palette enhances her work's connection to nature. Her handmade felt cards, originally a Christmas gift for loved ones, now bring smiles across the UK.



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STRANDED STONE DESIGNS

Vanessa is inspired by nature and childhood memories, offers handcrafted pieces from Birmingham's Jewellery Quarter. Discover necklaces echoing peacock feathers, rings with timeless gemstones, and bracelets inspired by foxes. 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WHITE CAT CERAMICS

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GRUMPY DARUMA

My prints are inspired by vintage Japanese matchbox labels. Captivated by their bold designs during my first Japan trip, I started collecting and researching them, which influenced my art. The match industry was vital in Japan in the 19th and 20th centuries, with labels as effective advertising. "Grumpy Daruma" reflects my fondness for Daruma dolls, depicting a grumpy Zen Buddhist Bodhidharma, mirroring my demeanor.



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CHRIS COWDRILL ILLUSTRATION



Chris is an illustrator from Birmingham who creates collage illustrations using hand-cut and digital techniques. He produces original artwork, prints, and applies their designs to postcards, badges, greetings cards, and artist books/zines.



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DRAGONWOODWORX

Steve from Dragonwoodworx makes handcrafted wooden gifts and home decor from reclaimed timber. Based in Hall Green, Birmingham, I create coin boxes, serving boards, trivets, Edison lamps, key hangers, wine butlers, and squirrel picnic tables, often embellished with woodburning.

I like to make a mix of ceramics from practical kitchen items like salt and pepper pots and mugs and coffee drippers, to fun, whimsical items like 'tiny beasties', hand-painted to give each a different personality. I also make small games like tic-tac-toe, for the young and young at heart.



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
