



# BASIC POLICIES

Registration is happening in two waves this year:  
member-only registration beginning January 21st,  
and open registration beginning January 28th.

In order to qualify for member pricing, you must have a family membership for the YMCA of Central New York at the time of registration and sustain your membership through your summer day camp season. Youth memberships qualify for early registration, but not for member pricing.

If you have to cancel your membership before summer day camp, you will be charged the non-member rate for your summer day camp weeks, even if you rejoin before the summer.






