Supported Internships

Supported Internships provide an opportunity for young people aged 16-24 with an education, health and care plan to gain real world work experience with an employer, supported by a job coach.

The aim of the programme is to equip young people with the skills they need to access paid employment on completion. The intern will remain in full-time education during the programme, whilst spending significant time with an employer to gain vital work experience.

The Liverpool City Region (LCR) Supported Employment Forum is looking to establish a subgroup to capture the views of parents/carers across the LCR relating to the Supported Internships programme. The aim is that the group will help shape and improve future internship opportunities for our young people. **Their first meeting will take place on Microsoft Teams on Tuesday 17th September 2024 at 6pm.**

It is envisaged that the group will meet online on a termly basis. At the initial meeting, we will have representation from the DWP to outline support available and answer any questions. We will also consider how we ensure that the parent/carer voice is heard in the future development of the SI programme.
