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In brief...

APEMS (wraparound child care centres) welcome children in classes 1P to 6P before and after school, and at lunchtime.

Where does it happen?

There are around 70 centres that welcome children close to schools and in their neighbourhoods.

Who is it for?

Places are primarily intended for families whose parents work, are taking a course or are job-seekers (registered with the Regional Employment Office – ORP).
