

# Itinerary and Highlights (subject to change)

Day 1: EN ROUTE FROM U.S.

Day 2: ARRIVE IN CAIRO, EGYPT Settle into your luxurious accommodations with time to refresh and unwind at leisure.  
Overnight: Marriott Mena House

Day 3: CAIRO | GIZA Following breakfast view the iconic Great Pyramid and the Great Sphinx. Standing before these marvels for the first time is awe-inspiring. Afterward explore the newly opened Grand Egyptian Museum.  
Overnight: Marriott Mena House (B,L,D)

Day 4: CAIRO Visit the Egyptian village of Sakkara and its necropolis. Ascend to the top of Mokattam Hill for lunch at the Citadel of Cairo overlooking the city. In the late afternoon stroll through Khan El-Khalili, one of the largest bazaars in the Middle East.  
Overnight: Marriott Mena House (B,L)

Day 5: CAIRO | FLIGHT TO LUXOR Enjoy guided touring of the sprawling Karnak Temple Complex and Luxor Temple. This evening is at leisure to enjoy the hotel's five-star amenities.  
Overnight: Sofitel Winter Palace Luxor (B,L)

Day 6: LUXOR | ESNA – EMBARKATION | NILE RIVER Venture to the hallowed grounds of the Valley of the Kings followed by the Mortuary Temple of Hatshepsut. This afternoon embark upon your private dahabiya to sail the Nile.  
Overnight: Dahabiya (B,L,D)

Day 7: EDFU | NILE Join your Egyptologist for a guided tour to the necropolis at El Kab. Continue to Edfu for a guided tour of the Ptolemaic Temple of Horus. The remainder of the day is at leisure aboard the dahabiya.  
Overnight: Dahabiya (B,L,D)

Day 8: EDFU | NILE | KOM OMBO See the ancient quarry at Gebel el-Silsila. This evening enjoy a special barbecue dinner on a nearby island.  
Overnight: Dahabiya (B,L,D)

Day 9: KOM OMBO | NILE Explore the fascinating temple of Kom Ombo. Return to the dahabiya for a final night of sailing, and partake in a special gala dinner on board.  
Overnight: Dahabiya (B,L,D)



Day 10: NILE – DISEMBARKATION | ASWAN Tour Aswan High Dam. Later, take a motorboat ride to Agilkia, site of the temples of Philae. Enjoy time at the hotel to refresh before setting out for Aswan's famous market, Sharia as-Souq.  
Overnight: Sofitel Legend Cataract (B,L)

Day 11: ASWAN Visit Elephantine Island to explore its UNESCO World Heritage archaeological sites. The remainder of today is at leisure.  
Overnight: Sofitel Legend Cataract (B,D)

Day 12: ASWAN | OPTIONAL ABU SIMBEL EXCURSION | FLIGHT TO CAIRO Optional excursion guests fly round-trip between Aswan and Abu Simbel. Other guests enjoy a morning at leisure before the afternoon return flight to Cairo. Gather for a special farewell dinner.  
Overnight: Le Méridien Cairo Airport (B,L,D)

Day 13: CAIRO | DEPART FOR U.S. (B)  
(B = Breakfast, L = Lunch, D = Dinner)

## What's Included

- 7 nights luxury hotel accommodations plus 4 nights aboard a stately dahabiya

- All excursions listed on the 13-day itinerary including admission to sites and venues

**Activity Level:** Activities are generally not very strenuous. Guests should be able to climb stairs, stand for long periods of time, and be able to walk 1.5 miles over uneven surfaces, sometimes on gravel, sand or stone.

## Hotel Accommodations *(subject to change)*

### MARRIOTT MENA HOUSE – CAIRO

Originally built as a hunting lodge in 1869, Mena House served as a private residence until 1886, when it was opened to the public as a hotel. The property features 40 acres of lavish gardens, four restaurants and lounges, outdoor pool, heated indoor pool, health club and full service spa (additional fees for services).



### SOFITEL WINTER PALACE LUXOR

Perched peacefully on the bank of the Nile River, Winter Palace's 5-star accommodations provide an alluring atmosphere for a regal respite. During leisure time, roam the manicured gardens, take a dip in the welcoming pool, or simply reflect on your time in Egypt while embracing the spectacular sights from your room.



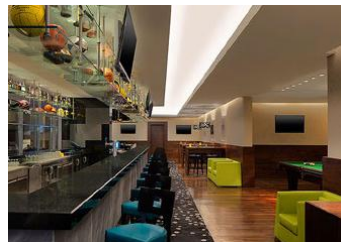
### SOFITEL LEGEND CATARACT – ASWAN

## Optional Pre-Tour Alexandria

This Mediterranean oasis was once a major intellectual center of the Greek and Roman empires, and home to the rulers of the Ptolemaic dynasty. Explore its mythic vestiges, and enjoy leisure time to experience the modern charms along the Corniche, Alexandria's waterfront promenade.

Day +1: EN ROUTE FROM U.S.

Day +2: **ARRIVE IN CAIRO, EGYPT** Settle into your five-star accommodations, and enjoy the first evening in Cairo at leisure.  
Overnight: Marriott Mena House

Day +3: **CAIRO | ALEXANDRIA** After breakfast take a pleasant three-hour drive to Alexandria. Built under the reign of Alexander the Great, Alexandria is the playground for Egypt's elite, enriched with a spirit that is more Mediterranean than Middle Eastern. During a guided tour visit the Roman Amphitheatre, the famous Catacombs, and the Citadel of Qaitbay. The remainder of the day is free to explore the city.  
Overnight: Steigenberger Cecil Hotel (B,L)

Day +4: **ALEXANDRIA** This morning visit the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization, featuring exhibits spanning from prehistoric times to the present, a vast archaeological display, and a royal mummies gallery. Afterward explore the architecturally stunning Bibliotheca Alexandrina, a recently constructed, modern interpretation of its ancient predecessor. The afternoon and evening are at leisure to relax at the property or venture into town.  
Overnight: Steigenberger Cecil Hotel (B,L)

Day +5: **ALEXANDRIA | CAIRO | MAIN PROGRAM BEGINS** After breakfast return to Cairo to join fellow travelers on the main program. (B)

# Optional Post-Tour Jordan

Journey to the ancient world of the Middle East, where impressive historic architecture towers over the present day. Discover the endless layers of spiritual and religious icons dotting this Holy Land, culminating with a once-in-a-lifetime visit to the Dead Sea.



**Day 13:** **CAIRO | FLIGHT TO AMMAN** Explore the region's history at the Jordan Museum, then ascend to the Amman Citadel for a spectacular view of the city.  
Overnight: InterContinental Amman Hotel (L,D)

**Day 14:** **AMMAN | JERASH** Travel to Jerash, the city of 1,000 Pillars. Visit the Triple Arched Gate, the Hippodrome, and the Roman Amphitheatre.  
Overnight: InterContinental Amman Hotel (B,L,D)

**Day 15:** **AMMAN | MABADA | MOUNT NEBO | PETRA** During guided church tours, view ancient floor mosaics and religious relics.  
Overnight: Mövenpick Resort Petra (B,L,D)

**Day 16:** **PETRA** Spend today touring the archaeological wonders of this UNESCO World Heritage Site.  
Overnight: Mövenpick Resort Petra (B,L,D)

**Day 17:** **PETRA | LITTLE PETRA | DANA | DEAD SEA** Visit Siq al-Barid, known as *Little Petra*, thought to have been an important "suburb" of Petra. Continue to the 15th-century stone village of Dana for lunch. The day concludes at the Dead Sea.  
Overnight: Mövenpick Resort & Spa Dead Sea (B,L,D)

**Day 18:** **DEAD SEA** Today is at leisure to relax and rejuvenate at the Dead Sea. Or take advantage of the plentiful amenities at the hotel.  
Overnight: Mövenpick Resort & Spa Dead Sea (B,L)

**Day 19:** **DEPART FOR U.S.** After breakfast take the complimentary group transfer to the airport for flights home. (B)
