
#SEPSISSAVVY is our campaign to raise awareness of sepsis in organisations and communities across the country. It's a free and easy way to protect your people.

Every year, at least 48,000 people die in the UK from this "silent killer". Asking the question could save a life.

SEPSIS SYMPTOMS ADULT CHILDREN

An adult may have sepsis if they show any of these signs:

Slurred speech or confusion

Extreme shivering or muscle pain

Passing no urine (in a day)

Severe breathlessnes

t feels like you're going to die

Skin mottled or discoloured

A child may have sepsis if he or she:

- Is breathing very fast
- Has a 'fit' or convulsion
- · Looks mottled, bluish, or pale
- Has a rash that does not fade when you press it
- Is very lethargic or difficult to wake
- Feels abnormally cold to touch

Call III or contact your GP if you're worried about an infection.
Call 999 or visit A&E if someone has one of the sepsis symptoms.
