

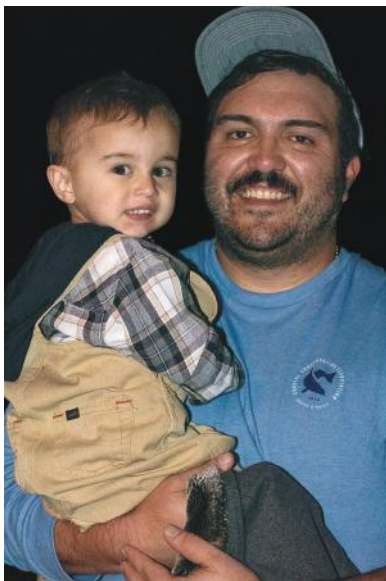

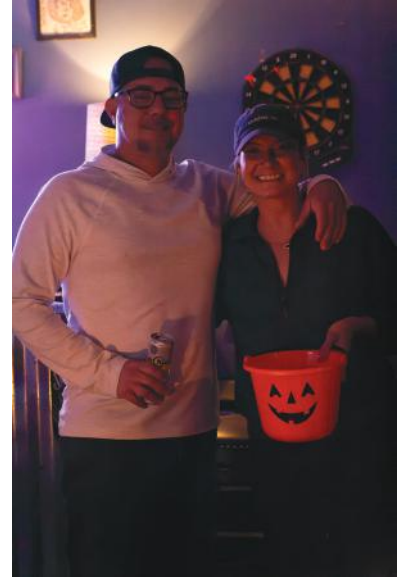

The Robotics Club uses the LEGO Mindstorms EV3 and LEGO Spike Prime platforms for its projects, which are interoperable with standard LEGO bricks. If you have any LEGO sets (or parts) that you no longer want and would be willing to donate to the NIS Robotics Club, we welcome your contributions! These components will help us as we are building our robots and the various environments that they will operate in when performing their assigned challenges.

If you have a student at NIS, they (or you) can drop off LEGO donations during the school day in the bucket at the Main Office.
