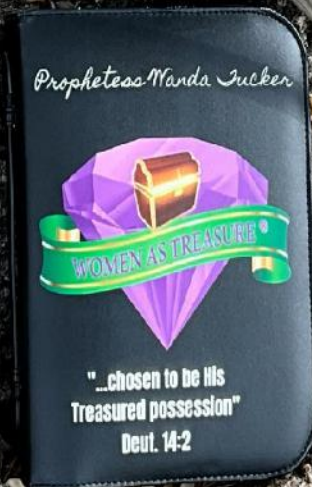

104 Through Your precepts I get understanding; therefore I hate every false way.



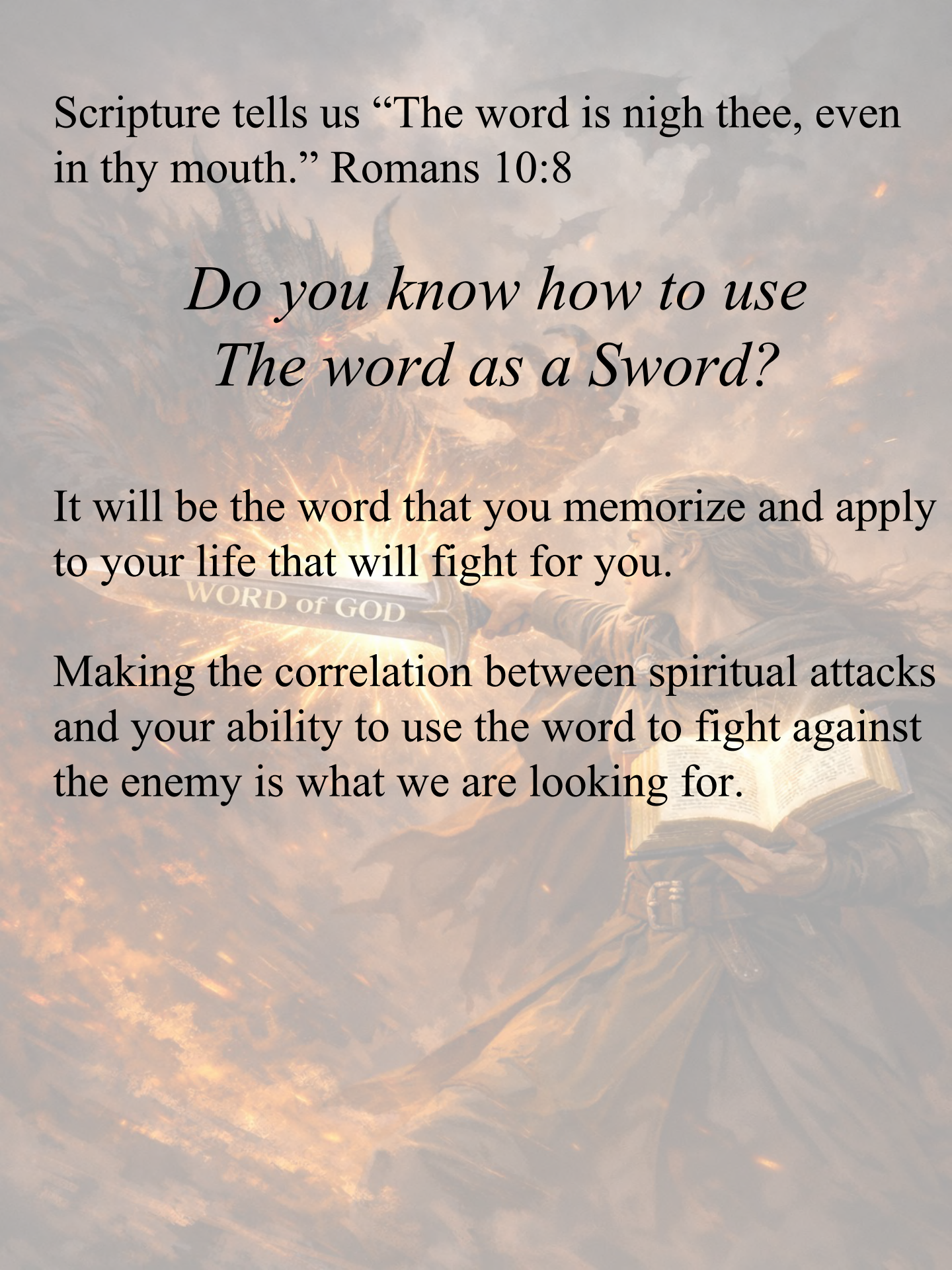
I encourage you to journey through the Word of God, for there you will find comfort, joy, hope, love, mysteries, as well as many other enlightenments!


Scripture tells us “The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth.” Romans 10:8

*Do you know how to use
The word as a Sword?*

It will be the word that you memorize and apply to your life that will fight for you.

Making the correlation between spiritual attacks and your ability to use the word to fight against the enemy is what we are looking for.

Be sure to be on the lookout for the subtle ways the enemy will try to attack you.

1. The quiet approach - through lies, distractions, or negative thoughts.
2. Forms of doubt about who you are.
3. Feelings of pride that try to pull you away from humility.
4. Be on guard against jealousy, anger, or comparison that will seek to steal your peace.

Remember these are not random attacks; they are part of a deeper fight.

Answers To Last Month's Quiz

*Although many answers will differ
I offer suggested answers.*

1. When I face a situation that feels bigger than me, turning my attention to God means I pause, pray, and choose not to react out of fear. I remind myself that God is in control and that I do not have to carry everything on my own.

2. An area where I may need to shift my focus back to God is any place where I feel worried, overwhelmed, or unsure. Instead of trying to figure everything out, I can choose to trust that God already has a plan and is working things out for my good.

3. When God asks me to wait, it can feel uncomfortable but waiting means I trust His timing. Instead of rushing ahead, I stay patient, continue to pray, and believe that God is working even when I cannot see it.

4. Worshiping and thanking God before I see the outcome means I choose to believe His promise is already secure. I can practice this by speaking words of gratitude, praising Him in prayer, and keeping a thankful heart even when things have not changed yet.

5. I can remember times when things worked out in ways I did not expect, and I know it was God. Those moments remind me that I can trust Him again. When I reflect on what He has already done, it strengthens my faith to believe Him for what He will do next.
