Day ARRIVE IN BORDEAUX, FRANCE -

2 EMBARKATION (R,D) Upon arriving an Orbridge representative will be waiting to assist with your transfer to the hospitality room prior to embarkation. This evening gather for a special welcome reception and gala dinner on board.

A ROCHELLE (B,L,D) Disembark for a
panoramic tour of Île de Ré including the
UNESCO World Heritage Site of SaintMartin-de-Ré enclosed by Vauban-designed
ramparts. Stop for a fresh seafood tasting
along the coast. After lunch on the ship join
a guide to explore La Rochelle. Conclude
with a cognac tasting at Chatêau de la
Péraudière before returning to the ship.

Day SAINT-JEAN-DE-LUZ (B,L,D) After lunch visit
4 Saint-Jean-de-Luz, a diverse fishing town
with a tapestry of colorful Basque traditions.
Continue to the Church of Jean Baptiste—
where King Louis XIV (le Roi Soleil) married
Maria Theresa of Spain in 1660. This
afternoon enjoy additional time to explore
Saint-Jean-de-Luz on your own or remain
on board for a sommelier-led wine tasting.

Dav BILBAO, SPAIN (B,L,D) Tour the Guggenheim Museum—an architectural masterpiece that houses an impressive collection of contemporary and modern art including permanent works by some of the most influential artists of the 20th and 21st centuries. The museum is also known for its interactive installations that encourage guests to engage with the art through movement, sound or digital elements. After lunch set off on a guided walking tour of Casco Viejo. Key landmarks include: Santiago Cathedral, the oldest building in Bilbao; Iglesia de San Antón, an iconic Gothic church that is part of Bilbao's coat of arms; and Plaza Nueva, a neoclassical square completed in the 19th century.

Day BILBAO (B,L,D) Depart for the Basque countryside to partake in an entertaining cooking demonstration and food tasting experience. Tonight while cruising towards Gijón, delight in another gourmet dinner crafted from locally sourced ingredients.

Day GIJÓN (B,L,D) Join a guide for a walking

tour of the Cimavilla historic district, an old fishermen's quarter and cultural complex. Next visit Universidad Laboral for a guided tour. Once intended to serve as an orphanage, this important cultural center features an impressive central plaza, bell tower, church, art exhibition halls and workshop studios, and colorful gardens adorned with striking sculptures and installations. Stop into a sidrería (or traditional cider house) to sample Asturias'

famous cider.

COMPOSTELA (B,L,D) Venture to Santiago de Compostela, a UNESCO World Heritage Site that rose to prominence during the Middle Ages as a major center of pilgrimage and religious scholarship. The area's importance is tied to the Apostle Saint James the Greater, who is believed to have spread Christianity in the Iberian Peninsula. According to tradition, after his martyrdom in Jerusalem, his remains were transported by boat and buried here.

Day VIGO (B,L,D) Take advantage of a leisurely morning and lunch on board before disembarking for the Rías Baixas region—an area famous for mussel cultivation. Visit a local estuary for a guided tour followed by a mussel and wine tasting. Return to the ship for an afternoon under way. Retreat to the main lounge for snacks and beverages accompanied by live music.

Day PORTO, PORTUGAL (B,L,D) Explore the city's historic center, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, during a guided walking tour. This afternoon partake in a lively port wine tasting.

Day DAY AT SEA (B,L,R,D) Awake to a leisurely schedule on board as the ship cruises toward Lisbon. Tonight gather for a farewell reception followed by a gala dinner.





BORDEAUX (B) Meet with a local guide for a panoramic walking tour of Bordeaux—a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Notable sights include Place de la Bourse, an iconic square dominated by the stunning Palais de la Bourse and its mesmerizing Water Mirror—the world's largest reflecting pool; the Gothic cathedral of Saint-André adorned with intricate carvings and stunning stained glass windows; and Bordeaux's ornate city gate—Porte Cailhau. The remainder of the day take advantage of the amenities and dining options at the hotel.

BORDEAUX | SAINT-ÉMILION | MAIN PROGRAM BEGINS (B,L) Following breakfast set out for a full-day excursion to Saint-Émilion—a picturesque medieval village renowned for its vineyards and vintages. Stop at a local winery for a gourmet lunch featuring exquisite delicacies paired with the finest varietals. Then descend into Saint-Émilion's fascinating network of underground passages, tunnels and chambers that played a crucial role in the region's winemaking history for centuries. Formed over time through the process of erosion, the natural caverns were expanded and modified by human hands as generations of vintners sought to harness their unique properties for wine storage and aging. Late afternoon join guests arriving at the port for the main program and embarkation.

Optional Post-Tour Lisbon Lisbon's charm lies in its hilly streets, iconic trams and vibrant neighborhoods buzzing with energy and creativity. Embrace the city's stunning panoramic views, notable historic sites and delicious food— each guaranteed to capture the imagination—during guided touring plus time to explore at your own pace.

LISBON Set off on a guided panoramic city tour. Day First make a brief photography stop at Belém Tower, 12 a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of Lisbon's most famous landmarks. Built in the early 16th century, the tower originally served as a defensive structure to protect the entrance to the Tagus River and a nearby monastery. Continue down Avenida da Liberdade, a major thoroughfare featuring an architectural mix of 19th-century buildings and contemporary glass structures. Next explore Lisbon's oldest historic district. Alfama, on foot, Alfama's origins date back to Moorish times, and much of the architecture within this labyrinthine neighborhood reflects the area's rich Islamic heritage. Stop into a local bakery to sample pastel de nata—one of Portugal's most iconic and beloved pastries. Conclude today's touring with an inside visit to the National Coach Museum, a facility featuring one of the finest collections of historic carriages in the world. Continue to the hotel for check-in. LISBON I SINTRA (B) Meet a local guide for a halfday excursion to Sintra. This picturesque village and
UNESCO World Heritage Site is renowned for its
stunning landscapes, fairy-tale-like palaces and rich
history. See Pena Palace, pass by Sintra National
Palace and stroll Sintra's charming old town—a
delightful maze of narrow cobblestone streets
lined with quaint shops, cafés and bakeries. Take
advantage of the hotel amenities during free time
this afternoon.
