Victor Frankenstein has created a living being out of dead flesh and bone! A gruesome horror story.




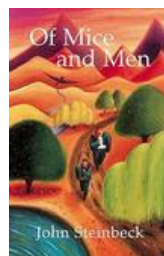
**Dracula - Bram Stoker**
