HOW DO I REGISTER FOR A PROGRAM?

Registration is completed in-person for any and all programs at McGuire-Dent Recreation Center and may be completed prior to starting a program or at the time of arrival. Activities and programs run year round. See following page on membership fees.

WHAT FORMS OF ID AND PROOF OF CITY OF GALVESTON RESIDENCY ARE REQUIRED?

City of Galveston residents will need to bring a valid state ID or drivers license with a current Galveston address. Residents that do not have a current address on their form of ID may bring in a copy of their utility bill, lease agreement etc. You may provide an official passport ID as long as the passport shows current address, if not bring in a copy of utility bill as stated above.

We do not accept mail showing a PO Box in Galveston and all ID's must be a hard copy, no photos on cell phones of ID's accepted.

Non-Residents bring a valid state ID or drivers license or non expired passport.

MAY I PURCHASE A DAY PASS?

Yes! You will need to bring in a valid state ID, drivers license or passport. Visit the following page for membership fees.

IF MY MEMBERSHIP EXPIRES THE DAY I COME IN MAY I USE THE FACILITY AND PAY NEXT TIME?

Unfortunately, no. All expired memberships must be renewed before participating in any program or activity.

IS THERE A DRESS CODE?

You must wear closed toe/closed heel athletic tennis shoes/sneakers when working out in the facility or playing in the gymnasium. No Crocs, flip flops, slides or sandals. The entire foot must be covered (toes and heels). The only exception to this rule is YOGA, Mindfulness Meditation and Paint class. We do not allow barefoot lifting.

We will **NOT** allow you to work out in denim of any kind, (shorts, jeans, jackets & shirts). Most denim come with rivets, sequins, or studs and tends to puncture the vinyl upholstery. See our policy brochure for more info.

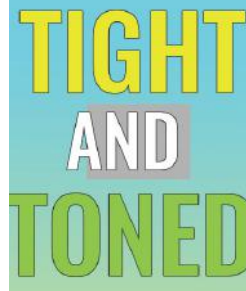

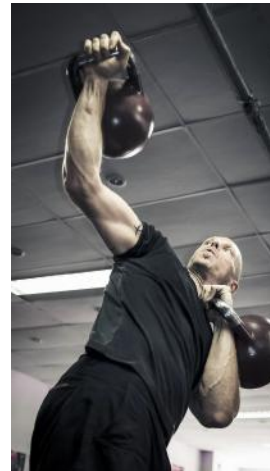

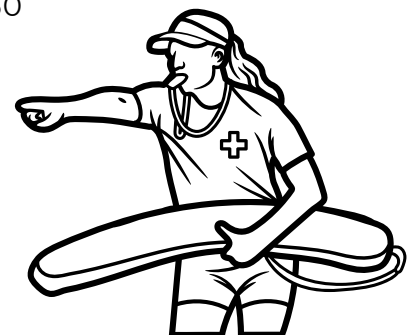

A Certified Peace Officer is required for Private Rentals and must be approved by Galveston Police Department. This is not included in your fees.

IS THERE A DRESS CODE?

All individuals entering the water are required to wear an approved swimsuit. An appropriate swimsuit is defined as a swim garment featuring an affixed or sewn inner lining and marketed specifically as a bathing suit.

The following clothing items are **NOT** permitted in our pool:

Gym and athletic shorts, leggings, cotton t-shirts, jeans/jean shorts, thong bikinis or other revealing swimwear, undergarments, non-swim diapers, and socks.

HOW OLD DO YOU NEED TO BE TO ENTER THE FACILITY WITHOUT AN ADULT?

Children 15 years of age and older may enter the pool unaccompanied, after they have been registered by their legal parent or guardian.

Any child under the age of 15 **MUST** be accompanied by an adult parent or guardian, who must be at least 18 years of age.

WHY DOES MY CHILD NEED A RED WRISTBAND?

All children aged 6 and under are required to wear a red wristband during their visit. This policy mandates that an adult, aged 18 or older, **MUST** remain within arm's reach of the child at all times, regardless of the child's swimming proficiency. This measure is implemented to ensure the child's safety.

CAN I BRING IN OUTSIDE FOOD AND DRINKS?

Outside food and beverages are not permitted within the facility, with the exception of clear plastic water bottles. Additionally, coolers and metal tumblers are also prohibited.

ARE WE ALLOWED TO BRING IN POOL INFLATABLES AND TOYS?

We strictly prohibit the use of any pool toys or equipment that require inflation within the facility. This policy encompasses, but is not limited to, items such as beach balls, loungers, ring floats, arm floaties, and infant/baby floats. Additionally, the use of basketballs, footballs, tennis balls, or any other hard material balls is not permitted. However, pool noodles, water guns, dive rings, and other soft material pool toys are allowed.

CAN I LEAVE AND RETURN AFTER I PAY?

Certainly! If you wish to leave at any point during your visit, please stop by the front office to request a wristband. This wristband will permit you to enter and exit as many times as you desire throughout that day.

WHAT IS THE WEATHER RULE?

In the event that lightning is detected within a 10-mile radius, thunder is audible, or lifeguards are unable to see the bottom of the pool due to heavy rain, the facility will be closed, and patrons must promptly exit both the pool and the premises. We will remain closed until the lightning is confirmed to be more than 10 miles away for 30 minutes before reopening.

HOW DO I REGISTER FOR SWIM LESSONS?

There are two options available for registering for swim lessons. You may visit our facility during business hours to register at the front desk, or you can conveniently register online by visiting our website at www.galvestontx.gov/letsswim and following the link to the CivicRec Portal.

WHAT FORMS OF ID AND PROOF OF CITY OF GALVESTON RESIDENCY ARE REQUIRED?

Galveston residents must show a valid state ID or driver's license with their current address. If the ID lacks an address, they can provide a utility bill, lease agreement, or similar document. An official passport is acceptable if it shows the current address; otherwise, a utility bill is needed.

Youth guests can use a Galveston Independent School District ID for residency verification.

Non-residents should bring a valid state ID, driver's license, or unexpired passport.

WHAT FORM OF PAYMENT DO YOU TAKE?

We accept cash as well as all forms of credit and debit cards. However, please note that we do not accept Apple Pay or tap-to-pay options.

Failure to adhere to our policies and regulations will result in removal from the facility, and no refund will be issued.

HOW DO I REGISTER FOR A PROGRAM?

Adults

- A. Adults will only need to complete a waiver release form to participate for pickleball.
- B. Adults will need a valid drivers license or state issued ID.
- C. If my membership expires the day I come in may I use the facility? Yes, we will update your membership that day.

Important Registration Procedure from City of Galveston's CDBD Grants Department for Parents & Legal Guardians Below:

- 1.FILL OUT REGISTRATION APPLICATION: An application should be filled out front & back by a parent or guardian. Parents/guardians registering youth must fill out the application. Do not scratch anything out, if you made an error on the registration you will need to fill out a new form. The city's CDBD Grants Dept will not accept scratch outs.
- 2.SHOW PROOF OF CITY of GALVESTON RESIDENCY: Acceptable forms of identification include a non-expired drivers' license, state i.d. and passport with a City of Galveston address. If address is not updated, a utility bill or lease will be required at the time of registration along with your ID.
- 3.TAKE A PICTURE: Everyone registering will be required to take a picture.

*NOTE: Youth registration is good from June 1st through May 31st.& must reregister your child.
