VISION

TAKING GROUND OVER THE LAST YEAR

Our God is faithful! He's proven it time and time again. Here is a brief overview of what we've seen the Lord do this year through His Church!

From July 2018–June 2019 . . .

- » **1,166** people gave their lives to the Lord.
- » **1,310** believers rededicated their lives to Jesus.
- » **539** people publicly declared their faith through baptism.
- » **16,283** (average) people gathered each week to worship at Calvary.
- » **268** active groups met regularly around South Florida, with **4,233** members!
- » **72** new groups formed.
- » **242** people attended the group leader and discipleship training.

In our Family Ministry, serving kids (Calvary Kids), middle school (Six78) and high school students (HSM) . . .

- » Over **2,100 kids** and **1,000 middle and high schoolers** gathered weekly to worship across all of our campuses.
- » **300 special needs children** were loved on and served through King's Kids each week across various campuses.
- » Six78 and HSM (our middle and high school ministries) averaged a combined **25 first-time guests per week**, while Calvary Kids averaged over **60-first timers!**
- » Over **400 student volunteers** and **660 adult volunteers** actively serve.
- » **26** HSM (High School Ministry) small groups, while Six78 (middle school) has **12**.
- » **343** kids and youth were baptized.
- » **440** parents went through a parenting class.

Reaching Our Community | Calvary West Boca

Every August, at Calvary West Boca's VBS, kids explore God's goodness and celebrate a contagious faith that empowers them to share it with others—mainly, their families and friends.

Last year, it hosted 120 kids, ages 6 to 11, treating them to a five-day fun fair that included music, crafts, and sports, all the while empowering them to know Jesus and to share His story. That "learn it to share it" tactic soon gained momentum.

During VBS week, Campus Pastor Joe Ferraro, along with his staff and a team of volunteers, led 27 kids to receive Christ into their hearts.

On the last day, every kid received a backpack as part of Calvary's Backpack outreach. The kids were thrilled. It was like Christmas in August! And because of VBS, three families joined Calvary West Boca, and since then they have become rooted into the church.

Reaching Our Schools | Calvary Plantation

Most Americans agree that our children are not being adequately prepared for life. So, how is our church responding?

Since Vision 2023's Education team started, Calvary Plantation has reached out to assist five local public schools. The work done has been so transformative that one of Plantation's staff members was invited by the Broward School Board to participate in an exclusive training that was reserved primarily for Broward School teachers.

After seeing the value in having our volunteers in their schools, the Board invited Calvary Plantation to participate in an Interfaith Recovery and Resilience group, which empowers people in need to stabilize and improve their lives through comprehensive programs in partnership with diverse faith communities and people of compassion. A representative from Calvary Plantation spoke at the event, helping to get the school community networking, working together with the schools, and actively formulating solutions to prepare students for success in life.

Education Vision Team Mission: To help students thrive while also making an impact in both public and private education.

300 SPECIAL NEEDS FAMILIES

Special Needs Ministry

Being a parent of a child with a disability is a blessing. Is it hard? Yes. Are there days when parents want to give up? Yes. Are there days that feel like years? Yes. But many will share that He brings perspective and purpose.

Every quarter, Calvary Plantation hosts a special needs family breakfast, where anyone who is connected to someone with a special need is welcome to attend and share their story. To date, they've held two amazing events, serving over 100 families. Baptisms for people with special needs are also offered at all our campuses. During the last baptism in Plantation, 10 individuals were baptized. It is a privilege to be an "indispensable" part of Jesus' family where we do not have to walk this journey alone.

HELPING MARRIED COUPLES THRIVE

The strength of a community lies in the homes of its people. Unfortunately, you don't need to look too far to see that one of the greatest threats to American society is the breakdown of the family. More and more children in America are growing up in broken homes and in a culture of toxic stress and violence.

As part of Vision 2023, Calvary Chapel Boynton Beach has empowered the Marriage Ministry to take a bold step into their city, reaching married couples with the life-changing message of Jesus Christ. And they're gaining ground.

How? By strengthening married couples and equipping them to build their homes according to God's design. And by fortifying their marriages against divorce, separation, loneliness, and spiritual complacency.

A committee of seven couples at Calvary Chapel Boynton Beach, led by volunteers Jim and Donna English, provide premarital and marriage counseling as part of the ministry and offer Christian marriage training such as Adventures in Marriage, Love and Respect, and the Art of Marriage to demonstrate to couples God's plan for a successful marriage.

The group meets every third Saturday of each month to encourage older couples, well-grounded in their faith, to walk alongside, love, and encourage younger, less experienced couples. The ministry has already helped three couples change the direction of their marriage by walking away from divorce.

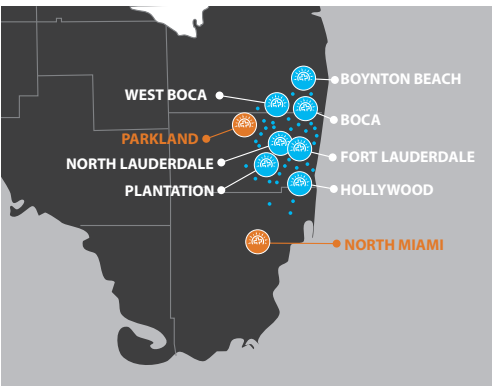

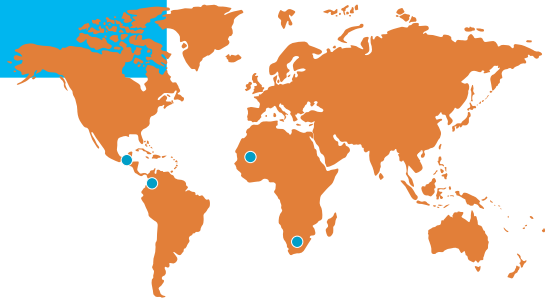

This year, **Youth Encounter 2019: Abandon** was bigger and better than ever! Here's a snapshot of the outcomes from an unforgettable three-day experience . . .

1,290

middle and high school students attended YE this year.

- **683 girls** and **593 boys**
- **632** middle schoolers
- **626** high schoolers

and organizations from various parts of Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, and Missouri sent students to YE.

- **72 students** were baptized.

CELEBRATING RECOVERY WITH YOU

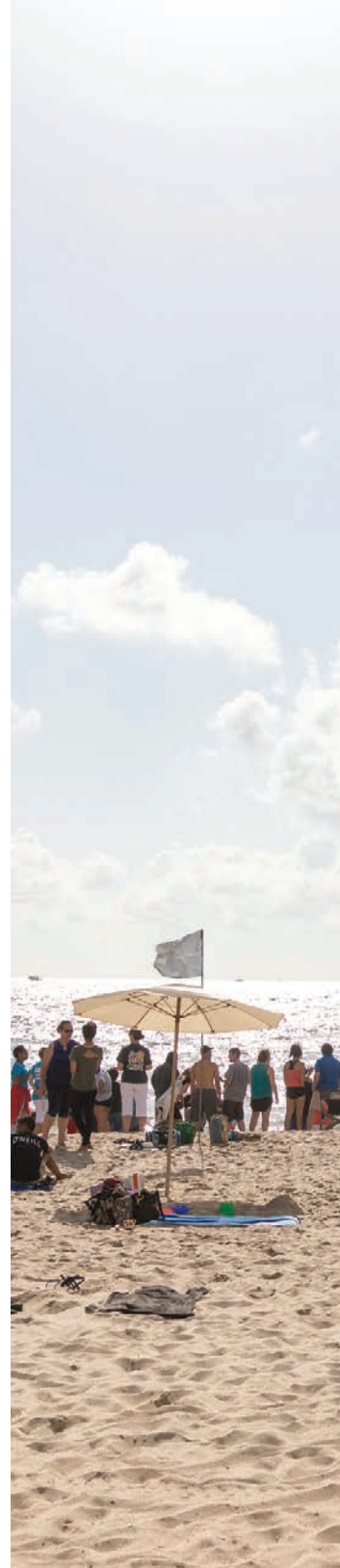
- Celebrate Recovery averaged **160 people in attendance** each week at our Friday evening sessions, with an average of **80 people in support groups**.
- The Recovery Ministry is impacting people in **8 facilities** with **11 groups**. We also minister in **1 community center** for those who are struggling with mental health and/or substance abuse.
- **83 new leaders** were trained.

This year, approximately **50 people** attended Celebrate Recovery step groups.

At Calvary House and Redeeming Love Home (RLH), our residential discipleship programs for men and women struggling with a stronghold . . .

- Men spend a minimum of 12 months in Calvary House, and then move over to the transition side for about 6 months.
- **25 men** graduated Calvary House.
- **20 women** enrolled in RLH.
- **6 women** graduated RLH, **8 baptisms** took place, **10 salvations**, and over **50 women served**.

Over the last year, approximately **80 new men** entered Calvary House.

Eikon: Building a Community with Kingdom Impact

As young men and women move into college and careers, leaving the nest, going out on their own, experiencing the biggest milestones, the harsh realities, and everything in between that comes with being an adult, the need for a strong, tight-knit community and intentional discipleship is undeniable. That's why Eikon exists! Eikon is a front door for young adults to the family of God. It's an on-ramp to discovering their fit as part of the body of Christ and flourishing in it.

Erika's story:

When I started attending Eikon, it was one of the scariest and best things I'd ever done. Now I thank God every day for leading me to Eikon. I've found a family that loves me and supports me. I strongly believe I wouldn't have been able to become who I am today if it weren't for this ministry.



- » This year, Eikon in Fort Lauderdale saw an average of **157 college students and young adults** gather together each week, with **30 active volunteers** currently serving.
- » At Plantation, the average weekly attendance was **38** with **16 active volunteers**.





OCEAN'S EDGE: TRAINING NEXT GENERATION WORSHIP LEADERS

- » Ocean's Edge raised up and discipled **23 dynamic leaders.**
- » Throughout the year, our students provided worship in over **30 local churches and ministries throughout South Florida**, as well as our own Calvary campuses and ministries.
- » More than **300 graduates** from the past **12 years** are making an impact for God's kingdom throughout the United States and abroad.
- » Over the years **40 graduates** have been employed at Calvary Chapel, bringing an influx of next generation leaders into our staff culture.
- » Ocean's Edge has written and produced **13 worship albums.**

Trinity University: A Partnership for the Future

As we seek to invest in the current and next generations, Calvary has partnered with Trinity International University to offer classes and degree programs at our Fort Lauderdale campus and provide a 25% tuition discount. We believe this partnership will not only impact the lives of students, but also the countless lives they'll encounter throughout their journey. And we're already seeing it! No one in my family has graduated college, and now God has opened the door for me to be the first! Since March 2009, when Calvary Chapel Fort Lauderdale launched its online campus, we've been bringing the entire service to people on their phones, tablets, and computers. Aside from connecting, encouraging, and providing resources for a seeker or a person looking to find God, it shows our online visitors what life might look like if they were part of our community.

Through Calvary Chapel Online, we show and share the love of Jesus Christ in the digital space. Locally, strategic consideration has been put into our website and social media design. Every avenue of digital communication has received an overhaul—e-mail, website, mobile app, SMS—to provide a personalized platform recommending activities, groups, classes,

events, etc. for people to consider as their best next steps in their walk with Christ and to reach more people than ever before with the gospel.

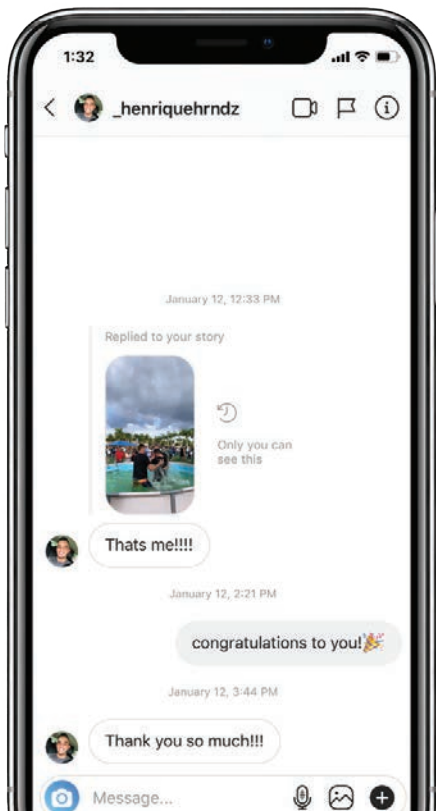

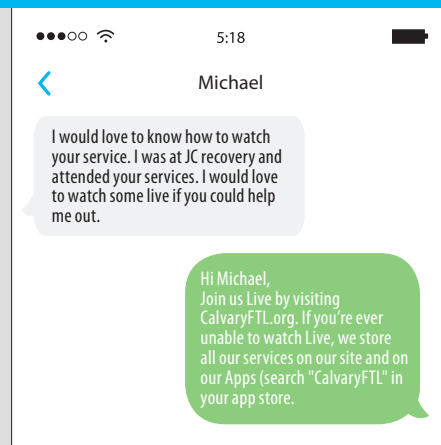

THAT'S WHAT RAMP48 IS ALL ABOUT!

We help people to discover faith in Jesus, to feel they belong to a family, and to develop their

skating skills. Through Ramp48, skaters have access to a challenging, yet fun individual sport in an awesome environment.

Ramp48 is a fun place that gets kids and young adults off the streets and into a safe space, where ministry happens throughout this 15,707 square foot skatepark. To enhance that experience, renovations are needed. This includes updating the main lobby, where kids and their families come to hear God's Word, play games, and drink refreshments, and improving the skatepark's courses. Updating the courses will highly impact the growth of this ministry, as skaters are often looking for ways to level up their game.

Elias' Story:

After completing Alpha, a 13-week video series program offered on Wednesday nights where kids can explore their beliefs, ask questions, and get a better understanding of Christianity, Elias, 21, said, "This was my first time ever reading the Bible and it seems like some really good stuff. I'm just not sure if it's all true." Brandon Herbert, Ramp48 manager explained to Elias that the only way to get a better understanding of the truth of the Bible is through faith. Elias then responded, "I'm not sure if I have that yet."

Elias is still seeking answers. He reads the Bible on his own and comes to Ramp48 where he asks questions about his findings. He's attending Ramp48's second session of Alpha as a volunteer, while Herbert and his team pray with him, looking forward to what God will do with Elias on this journey.

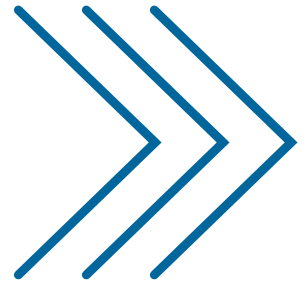
