THE PATH TO BE PRESENT OUR FOUNDING STORY





Our story began in 2015 with a single devastating experience - the diagnosis and subsequent loss of young adult Kirsten Westerman to leukemia at the age of 20. During treatment, Kirsten didn't always receive the support she needed. She was left to endure this uncertain time feeling isolated and alone, negatively impacting her mental health and quality of life. She knew her friends wanted to be present, but unfortunately, the young adult social network often lacks the experience to be there when they are needed most. Kirsten had a vision for how to address this challenge, but her life ended before she could begin. In 2017, one year after losing Kirsten to cancer, her Mom and three best friends established b-present to take Kirsten's vision and bring it to life.

Isolating experiences like Kirsten's are common for the nearly 90,000 Adolescents and young adults (AYAs) ages 15-39 diagnosed with cancer each year in the US. Why does this matter? According to US Surgeon General, the mortality impact of being socially disconnected is similar to that caused by smoking up to 15 cigarettes a day. Educating, equipping and empowering supporters to be present mitigates this risk and improves health outcomes.. b-present provides the education, tools and resources that empower the social network to b-present for their friends with cancer, because no one should face cancer alone.




